JANUARY MILK PRICES AVERAGE SAME AS DECEMBER - SOME LOCAL CHANGES

PRICES TO PRODUCERS FOR CLASS I MILK AVERAGE APPROXIMATELY THE SAME FOR JANUARY AS LAST MONTH. THERE ARE, HOWEVER, SEVERAL PRICE CHANGES IN LOCAL MARKETS. IN THE MINNEAPOLIS-ST. PAUL AREA, WHICH IS FEDERALLY LICENSED, AN INCREASE OF 25 CENTS PER CWT. BECAME EFFECTIVE ON DECEMBER 26, AND RETAIL PRICES ADVANCED 1 CENT PER QUART. IN ANOTHER FEDERALLY LICENSED MARKET, MUSKOGEE, MICHIGAN, HOWEVER, A REDUCTION OF 35 CENTS PER CWT. HAS BEEN AUTHORIZED BY THE AGRICULTURAL ADJUSTMENT ADMINISTRATION, THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS CHANGE BEING JANUARY 11. NO DEFINITE INDICATION OF MILK BEING BOUGHT AT OTHER THAN THE LICENSE PRICE IS AVAILABLE FOR FT. WAYNE, INDIANA, BUT AN UNSETTLED CONDITION IN THAT MARKET IS SUGGESTED BY A 3 CENTS PER QUART REDUCTION OF RETAIL PRICES. BALTIMORE, MARYLAND PRICES HAVE BEEN AGREED UPON PENDING FINAL COURT ACTION AT THE EQUIVALENT OF \$2.35 PER CWT. FOR 3.5 PERCENT MILK, WHICH IS ONLY A SLIGHT INCREASE OVER THE PRICE REPORTED FOR DECEMBER, BUT BALTIMORE RETAIL PRICES HAVE ADVANCED 1 CENT PER QUART. IN FLORIDA, PRICE CHANGES ARE

IRREGULAR AND PART OF THE MIAMI SUPPLY IS REPORTED AS BEING PURCHASED AT A REDUCTION OF 93 CENTS PER CWT. UNDER A MONTH AGO, AND ACCOMPANYING THIS CHANGE IS A 4 CENT PER QUART RETAIL PRICE DECLINE ON SUCH MILK. JACKSONVILLE PRICES TO PRODUCERS ARE REPORTED 25 CENTS PER CWT. BELOW THE DECEMBER PRICE. INFORMATION IS NOT AVAILABLE REGARDING DEALERS BUYING PRICES AT TAMPA, BUT RETAIL PRICES THERE ARE REPORTED AS 2 CENTS PER QUART ABOVE A MONTH AGO. OTHER CITIES WHERE PRICES ARE DIFFERENT THAN THOSE PUBLISHED LAST MONTH INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING, ALL CHANGES BEING ADVANCES; CEDAR RAPIDS, IA., 62 CENTS PER CWT. ON CLASS I MILK AND 1 CENT PER QUART RETAIL; WINONA, MINN., 39 CENTS PER CWT. AND 1 CENT PER QUART RETAIL; AND PROVO, UTAH, 24 CENTS PER CWT. ON PRODUCERS PRICES ONLY. MILK MARKETS GENERALLY WILL SHARE IN THE SUPPORT BROUGHT ABOUT BY THE HIGHER BUTTER PRICE LEVEL WHICH NOW PREVAILS, FOLLOWING A PERIOD OF STEADY ADVANCES SINCE SEPTEMBER.
