NUMEROUS MILK PRICE REDUCTIONS IN JULY

Price changes in fluid milk markets this month are, almost without exception, declines under June, the favorable production situation and the lower level of butter prices which has prevailed since the first of June being factors contributing to these changes. A number of markets affected are under Federal control and licenses have been amended to provide for price reductions. Cities included in this group are San Diego, California; Lincoln, Nebraska; Tulsa, Oklahoma; Denver, Colorado, Leavenworth and Topeka, Kansas. Reductions in Class I prices vary from 1¢ at San Diego to 4¢ at Tulsa. Four Federal licenses have been cancelled recently as follows: Southern Illinois, June 25th; Los Angeles, Philadelphia, and Fort Worth, Texas, on July 1st. One other license change of interest occurred at Kansas City, whereby the sales area is restricted to Kansas City, Missouri, instead of the greater Kansas City

area which includes Kansas City, Kansas. The Federal license covering Fort Wayne, Indiana, amended on June 19th to provide for an increase of 15¢ per cwt. in the Class I price and this is the one increase reported during the month. Class I and retail price declines averaging 1¢ per quart are reported from Cleveland and Dayton, Ohio, and a similar reduction of retail prices is reported at Akron, Ohio. These markets were under the control of the Ohio Milk Commission before that body was discontinued July 1, through failure of the State Legislature to renew the Act. Retail prices only are 1¢ per quart lower at Evansville, Indiana. On the Pacific Coast reductions have occurred at Portland and Seattle, the Class I reductions being 9¢ and 24¢ per cwt. respectively, and the retail price change being a 1¢ per quart decline in each market.
