MILK MARKETS FIRM - LESS SURPLUS MILK

Reduced production and fairly good demand have lent support to December fluid milk markets. Supplies of milk have been ample for local requirements, and apparently no serious shortages have developed, but what has happened is that surpluses have been cut down. While basic fluid milk prices are for the most part the same as in November, less milk will go into surplus classifications, and higher net returns to fluid milk producers for current production should result when December prices are finally figured. In only a few markets are December basic prices higher than in November, and these changes for the most part are not great. Reports from San Francisco show that a 35 cents per cwt. increase on Class I milk and a 1 cent per quart retail price advance are in effect. The Twin Cities Class I price has been \$1.85 instead of

\$1.75 since November 16, and an increase of 7 cents per cwt. was effective at Lincoln, Nebraska on the same date. Class I milk is 14 cents per cwt. higher than a month ago at Seattle, 22 cents higher at Lynn, Mass., and 21 cents higher at Lexington, Ky, and at Lexington, part of the local supply is being retailed at a 1 cent per quart increase. Chicago retail prices went from 10 to 11 cents per quart on December 9, and an increase in the December Class I price will result if butter and cheese prices average above November. A plan somewhat similar to the new Chicago plan is being given consideration at Indianapolis, although no approval has been announced by the State Milk Control Board. Tampa, Florida reports show a retail price increase of 1 cent per quart, and slight increases in dealers' buying prices are effective at Evansville, Ind.,
