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MOST STOCKS BELOW LAST YEAR

April 1 stocks of all grains except sorghum and soybeans were below a year earlier according to the Crop Reporting Board. Stocks of the four feed grains (corn, oats, barley and sorghum) totaled 102.9 million tons, 14 percent less than holdings on April 1, 1973.

Stocks of all wheat were down 41 percent from a year earlier and the lowest since 1952. Durum supplies were down 25 percent. Soybean stocks were up sharply--47 percent larger than a year ago.

Corn stored in all positions on April 1, 1974 totaled 2,858 million bushels, down 14 percent from the 3,340 million bushels a year earlier and 15 percent less than April 1, 1972. Farm stocks, at 2,008 million bushels, were 16 percent less than a year ago while off-farm stocks, at 850 million bushels, were down 11 percent.

Disappearance from all storage positions during January-March is indicated at 1,611 million bushels, compared with 1,490 million bushels used in the same quarter a year ago.

Sorghum grain stocks in storage as of April 1, 1974 totaled 383 million bushels, representing a 5 percent increase over April 1, 1973 stocks but a 20 percent drop from 1972. Off-farm holdings at 267 million bushels on hand April 1, 1974, were down one million bushels from last year and 70 million bushels from two years ago. Farm stocks accounted for 116 million bushels this year, 21 million bushels above the previous year but 27 million bushels below 1972.

Disappearance during the January-March quarter was 265 million bushels, 3 percent more than used during the same quarter last year and 16 percent more than the January-March 1972 disappearance.

Oats stored in all positions on April 1, 1974 totaled 435 million bushels, 26 percent less than April 1, 1973 and the lowest April 1 stocks since 1948. The 148 million bushels held off farms was 59 million bushels below last April 1. Farm stocks dropped 24 percent under a year earlier--from 377 million bushels to 287 million bushels, the smallest farm holdings for this date since 1935.

January-March disappearance was 199 million bushels, compared with 192 million bushels for the same quarter in 1973.

Barley stocks in all positions on April 1, 1974 totaled 215 million bushels, representing a 17 percent decrease from a year earlier and a 24 percent decrease from April 1, 1972. Farm holdings at 122 million bushels declined 24 percent from a year earlier, while off-farm stocks at 93 million bushels declined 4 percent from last year.

Disappearance from all storage positions during the January-March 1974 quarter was 106 million bushels compared with 103 million bushels during the same quarter last year.

All wheat in storage on April 1, 1974 totaled 550 million bushels, 41 percent below a year earlier and the lowest April 1 stocks since 1952 when stocks totaled 519 million bushels. Off-farm stocks at 366 million bushels were down 40 percent from a year earlier. Farm holdings as of April 1 accounted for 184 million bushels and represented a 42 percent decline from the previous year. Disappearance of stocks from all positions during the January-March period is indicated at 386 million bushels compared with 471 million bushels disappearance for the comparable quarter last year.

Durum wheat stocks in all positions on April 1, 1974 at 53.6 million bushels represent a 25 percent decline from a year earlier and are the lowest April 1 stocks since 1968. Farm holdings of 37.3 million bushels declined 23 percent from a year earlier while off-farm holdings were down 30 percent. Disappearance for the January-March period is indicated at 17.7 million bushels, compared with 26.5 million bushels for the same quarter in 1973.

Rye holdings in all positions totaled 18.1 million bushels as of April 1, 1974. This represented a 63 percent decline from April 1, 1973 stocks and the lowest April 1 stocks since 1965. Off-farm stocks accounted for 13.6 million bushels, while farm stocks totaled 4.5 million bushels. Off-farm holdings were down 62 percent from the previous year, while farm holdings declined 65 percent. The January-March disappearance is indicated to be 3.4 million bushels compared with 5.2 million bushel disappearance during the same quarter in 1973.

Soybeans in all storage positions on April 1 totaled a record high 742 million bushels, 47 percent more than a year earlier. Farm stocks at 336 million bushels were up 131 percent. Off-farm stocks at 406 million bushels were 13 percent above a year earlier.

Stocks on April 1, 1974 indicated a September-March disappearance of 884 million bushels from a beginning supply of 1,626 million bushels (carryover of about 60 million bushels plus 1973 production of nearly 1,567 million bushels). Disappearance for this period a year earlier was 839 million bushels. During the past 7 months, approximately 470 million bushels were processed for oil and about 350 million bushels were exported.

Flaxseed stocks on April 1, 1974 totaled 6.9 million bushels, 27 percent below a year earlier and the smallest April 1 stocks since the beginning of quarterly flaxseed stocks estimates in 1948. Flaxseed stored off the farm accounted for nearly 4.3 million bushels, down 43 percent from a year ago and the lowest off-farm holdings of record for April 1. Farm stocks totaled 2.6 million bushels, up 35 percent from the record low farm holdings of a year earlier.

Indicated disappearance during January-March is 3.3 million bushels compared with 4.4 million during the same quarter a year earlier. April 1 stocks indicate a 9-month disappearance of nearly 13.1 million bushels from a supply of 19.9 million bushels. Reported disappearance during this 9-month period included about 12.9 million bushels crushed and 0.4 million bushel exported.
