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## WHEAT AND FEED GRAIN STOCKS SHARPLY LOWER

Stocks of all grains, except soybeans, on July 1, 1974 were below a year earlier, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Stocks of the four feed grains (corn, oats, barley, and sorghum) totaled 52.3 million tons, 26 percent less than July 1, 1973. April-June feed grain disappearance totaled a record high 50.5 million tons, 3 percent more than for the same quarter in 1973.

Stocks of all wheat were 43 percent below a year earlier. Durum wheat stocks were down one-fifth. Flaxseed stocks were down 26 percent, but soybean stocks were nearly double a year ago.

Corn in all storage positions on July 1, 1974 totaled 1,442 million bushels, 26 percent less than a year earlier, and 34 percent less than July 1, 1972.

Off-farm stocks of 381 million bushels were 33 percent less than a year earlier and farm holdings, at 1,061 million bushels, were down 23 percent.

Indicated disappearance from all positions during April-June was 1,416 million bushels compared with 1,403 million bushels during the same period a year earlier.

Sorghum grain stored in all positions on July 1, 1974 totaled 179 million bushels, 10 percent less than a year earlier and 35 percent less than July 1, 1972. Off-farm stocks were down 20 percent and accounted for 69 percent of the total stocks compared with 77 percent of the total last year. Sorghum stored on farms was 22 percent more than last year but 17 percent less than July 1, 1972. Total disappearance during the April-June quarter totaled 203 million bushels compared with 163 million bushels during the same period last year.

Old crop oat stocks in all positions on July 1, 1974 totaled 255 million bushels, 38 percent less than last July 1, and 53 percent less than July 1, 1972. Off-farm stocks at 105 million bushels were down 42 percent from a year ago and farm holdings at slightly over 150 million bushels were down 34 percent.

Disappearance during April-June was 179 million bushels, slightly higher than the 174 million-bushel disappearance during the comparable period of 1973.

Old crop barley stocks in storage on July 1, 1974 totaled 120 million bushels, 26 percent less than a year earlier and 31 percent less than July 1, 1972. Farm stocks, at 55 million bushels were down 42 percent from a year ago and off-farm stocks, at nearly 65 million bushels, were down 13 percent.

Disappearance from all storage positions during April-June 1974 was 96 million bushels, the same as in the comparable period of 1973.

Old crop carryover of all wheat on July 1, 1974 totaled 249 million bushels, 43 percent less than a year earlier, 71 percent less than 1972, and the lowest July 1 stocks since 1948. Off-farm holdings of 158 million bushels were 48 percent less than a year earlier and farm holdings, at 91 million, were down 32 percent from a year earlier. Stocks in all positions on July 1 indicate disappearance during the July 1, 1973 to June 30, 1974 crop year at 1,901 million bushels, compared with 1,970 million a year earlier and 1,486 million 2 years ago. Disappearance during April-June 1974 was 302 million bushels, sharply below the 489 million-bushel disappearance during the comparable quarter of 1973.

Old crop durum wheat stocks in all positions on July 1, 1974 totaled 29.6 million bushels, 20 percent less than a year earlier and 57 percent below 2 years ago. Farm holdings of 19.6 million bushels were 2 percent below last year, and off-farm stocks of 10.0 million were down 41 percent. Disappearance during the crop year ended June 30, 1974 is indicated at 92.2 million bushels, compared with 105.3 million a year earlier.

Old crop rye stocks in all positions on July 1, 1974 totaled 11.0 million bushels, 67 percent less than a year earlier, and 76 percent less than July 1, 1972. Farm holdings of 2.8 million bushels were down 59 percent from a year earlier while off-farm stocks of 8.2 million bushels declined 69 percent. Indicated disappearance during April-June was 7.0 million bushels compared with 15.5 million bushels during the same quarter a year earlier.

Soybeans in all storage positions on July 1, 1974 totaled 344 million bushels, 92 percent above last year's stocks and the largest July 1 stocks since 1970. Farm holdings of 153 million bushels were more than quadruple last year's 34 million bushels, while off-farm stocks of 191 million bushels were up 31 percent from the 145 million bushels on hand a year ago.

July 1 stocks indicate disappearance during September-June of 1,282 million bushels from the beginning supply of 1,626 million bushels. During the past 10 months, approximately 681 million bushels of soybeans were processed for oil, around 492 million bushels were exported, and about 58 million bushels were used to seed the 1974 crop.

The April-June disappearance was 398 million bushels, 23 percent above the 324 million-bushel disappearance for the same period last year.

Old crop flaxseed stored in all positions July 1, 1974 totaled 2.6 million bushels, the smallest quantity in 30 years. Stocks at this level compare with 3.5 million bushels on July 1 last year, and 20.1 million bushels on July 1, 1972. Off-farm stocks, at 1.9 million bushels, accounted for 74 percent of the total and were down 1.2 million bushels from last July 1.

July 1 stocks at this level indicate a disappearance of 17.3 million bushels for the year ending June 30 from a supply of 19.9 million bushels (carryover of 3.5 million bushels plus 1973 production of 16.4 million bushels). Crushings are estimated at 16.7 million bushels and exports at 0.6 million bushels for the year ending June 30, 1974. About 1.4 million bushels were used to seed the 1974 crop.
