WHEAT AND SOYBEAN STOCKS UP--OTHER GRAIN STOCKS BELOW YEAR EARLIER

July 1 stocks of all wheat at 8.7 million metric tons were 29 percent above a year earlier, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Soybean stocks of 9.8 million metric tons were 5 percent above July 1, 1974.

Stocks of the four feed grains (corn, oats, barley and sorghum) totaled 35.9 million metric tons, 24 percent below July 1, 1974. Decreases from a year earlier for individual feed grains ranged from 21 percent for corn to 47 percent for sorghum.

Corn in all storage positions on July 1, 1975 totaled 1,146 million bushels, 21 percent less than a year earlier and 41 percent less than July 1, 1973. This is the smallest quantity in storage on July 1 since 1952.

Farm holdings, at 801 million bushels, are down 25 percent from a year ago while off-farm holdings, at just over 345 million bushels, are down 9 percent. These are the smallest July 1 farm and off-farm holdings in more than 20 years.

Indicated disappearance from all positions during April-June was 1,062 million bushels, down 25 percent from the 1,418 million bushels for the same period of 1974. This disappearance is the lowest since 1971.

Sorghum grain stocks in all positions on July 1, 1975 totaled 95 million bushels, down sharply from the July 1, 1974 level of 178 million bushels and 52 percent below the same date in 1973. Off-farm stocks were down 47 percent from last year and accounted for 69 percent of the total stocks. Sorghum stored on farms was down 45 percent from July 1, 1974.

Total disappearance during the April-June quarter was 114 million bushels, compared with 202 million bushels during the same period last year.

Old crop oat stocks in storage on July 1, 1975 totaled 184 million bushels, compared with 255 million bushels last year and 410 million bushels on July 1, 1973. Farm stocks at 119 million bushels were down 21 percent from a year ago while off-farm stocks were down 37 percent.

Disappearance during April-June was 144 million bushels compared with 181 million during the comparable period last year.

Old crop barley stocks in storage in all positions on July 1, 1975 totaled 75 million bushels, 37 percent less than a year earlier and 54 percent less than June 1, 1973. This is the smallest July 1 stocks on hand since 1954. Farm stocks at 30 million bushels were down 46 percent from a year ago and off-farm stocks at just over 45 million bushels were down 29 percent.

Disappearance from all storage positions during April-June 1975 was 57 million bushels, 40 percent below the 96 million bushels for the comparable period of 1974. This is the smallest disappearance for this period since 1954.

Old crop carryover of all wheat on July 1, 1975 totaled 319 million bushels, 29 percent above a year earlier, but 27 percent less than 2 years ago. Except for last year, this is the smallest July 1 holdings since 1952. Farm stocks totaled 126 million bushels, 41 percent above a year ago while off-farm stocks at 193 million bushels are up 22 percent. Disappearance from all storage positions from April through June 1975 is indicated at 329 million bushels, compared with 300 million during the same period in 1974.

Old crop durum wheat stocks in all positions on July 1, 1975 totaled 20.8 million bushels, 26 percent below a year earlier and the smallest for this date since 1962. Farm holdings at 14.0 million bushels were 22 percent below a year ago and off-farm stocks showed a 32 percent decrease. Disappearance during the April-June quarter is indicated at 22.8 million bushels, nearly equal to the same quarter in 1974.

Old crop rye stocks in all positions on July 1, 1975 totaled 5.9 million bushels, down sharply from the July 1, 1974 level of 11.0 million and the lowest July 1 stocks since 1964. Stocks were about equally split between farm and off-farm positions. Farm holdings were 6 percent above a year earlier while off-farm stocks were sharply lower only about one-third of the July 1, 1974 total. The April-June disappearance is indicated at 2.4 million bushels compared with 6.9 million in the comparable quarter of 1974.

Soybean stocks in all storages on July 1, 1975 totaled 359 million bushels, 5 percent more than last year's 342 million bushels and exceeded for the date only in 1969 and 1970. Soybeans stored on farms at nearly 168 million bushels are 11 percent more than last year's 151 million bushels and exceeds the previous July 1 record of 141 million bushels established in 1969. Off-farm stocks at 192 million bushels are up less than 1 percent from last year.

The April-June disappearance was 300 million bushels, 24 percent less than the 396 million bushel disappearance during the same period last year.

Disappearance for the September-June period was 1,045 million bushels from a beginning supply of 1,404 million bushels. During the past 10 months, approximately 581 million bushels of soybeans have been processed for oil, 357 million bushels exported and 57 million bushels used to seed the 1975 crop.

Old crop flaxseed stored in all positions on July 1, 1975 totaled 2.1 million bushels, the smallest quantity since records were started in 1948. Stocks at this level compare with 2.5 million bushels on July 1 last year and 3.5 million bushels on July 1, 1973. Off-farm stocks, at 1.1 million bushels, accounted for 53 percent of the total and were down 0.8 million bushels from last July 1. Farm stocks at 980,000 bushels are 49 percent above last year's level.

July 1 stocks indicate a disappearance of 13.8 million bushels for the year ending June 30 from a total supply of 15.9 million bushels (carryover in excess of 2.5 million bushels plus 1974 production of 13.3 million bushels). Crushings and exports are expected to be near 12.6 million bushels and 0.4 million bushels respectively for the year ending June 30, 1975. About 1.4 million bushels were used to seed the 1975 crop.
