## SOYBEAN AND WHEAT STOCKS UP SHARPLY

June 1 stocks of soybeans at 15.0 million metric tons were 30 percent above a year earlier and all wheat stocks at 18.1 million metric tons were up 55 percent.

Stocks of the four feed grains (corn, oats, barley and sorghum) totaled 56.8 million metric tons, up 22 percent from June 1, 1975. Increases from a year earlier for individual feed grains were 38 percent for barley, 24 percent for corn, and 17 percent for sorghum. Oats was 7 percent below a year earlier.

Corn in all storage positions on June 1, 1976 totaled 1,857 million bushels, 24 percent above a year earlier, but 2 percent below June 1, 1974. Farm stocks totaled 1,277 million bushels and off-farm stocks were 580 million bushels.

Disappearance from all storage positions during April and May was 955 million bushels, up 32 percent from the same period of 1975.

Sorghum grain in all storage positions June 1, 1976 totaled nearly 154 million bushels, 17 percent more than a year earlier but 37 percent below the same date in 1974. Farm stocks were at almost 50 million bushels and off-farm holdings totaled 104 million bushels.

Disappearance from all storage positions during April and May is indicated at 94 million bushels, 21 percent more than April and May disappearance a year ago.

Old crop oat stocks in storage on June 1, 1976 totaled 207 million bushels, 7 percent less than a year ago and a third less than on June 1, 1974. Farm stocks totaled nearly 162 million bushels and off-farm stocks were 46 million bushels.

Disappearance from all storage positions during April and May 1976 was 115 million bushels, 13 percent above the same period last year.

With this issue of Grain Stocks, the date of the midyear report is changed to June 1 from July 1. The start of the marketing year for wheat, oats, barley, rye and flaxseed was recently changed to June 1 from July 1. Therefore, a June 1 stocks report will reflect the carryover of old crop stocks at the start of the marketing year.

Historical comparisons for June 1 based on survey data are not available. However, the Economic Research Service of the Department has issued a series of June 1 interpolations. These interpolations for June 1, 1974 and 1975 are shown on page 3 of this report. Additional data and methodology used in arriving at the June 1 interpolations are shown in the May 1976 issues of the Feed Situation and the Wheat Situation.

Old crop barley stocks in storage in all positions on June 1, 1976 totaled 127 million bushels, 38 percent greater than a year earlier but 13 percent less than June 1, 1974. Farm stocks totaled 63 million bushels and off-farm stocks were 64 million bushels.

Disappearance from all storage positions during April and May 1976 was 57 million bushels, 36 percent above the same period last year.

All wheat (old crop) in storage on June 1, 1976 totaled 665 million bushels, 55 percent above a year earlier and 96 percent above 2 years ago. Farm stocks totaled nearly 235 million bushels and off-farm stocks were 430 million bushels.

Disappearance from all storage positions during April and May 1976 was 271 million bushels, 17 percent above the same period last year.

Durum wheat (old crop) stocks in all positions on June 1, 1976 totaled 53.9 million bushels. Farm stocks totaled nearly 38.9 million bushels and off-farm stocks were 15.1 million bushels.

Old crop rye stocks in all positions on June 1, 1976 totaled 4.5 million bushels, 32 percent below a year earlier and 68 percent below two years ago. Farm stocks totaled 2.1 million bushels and off-farm stocks were 2.4 million bushels.

Disappearance from all storage positions during April and May 1976 was 1.5 million bushels, 6 percent below the same period last year.

Soybean stocks in all positions on June 1, 1976 totaled 551 million bushels, up 30 percent from June 1 a year ago and 23 percent above two years ago. Farm stocks totaled 250 million bushels and off-farm stocks were 301 million bushels.

Disappearance during April and May was 310 million bushels, 35 percent above the same period a year ago.

Disappearance for the September 1975 - May 1976 period was 1,156 million bushels. During these 9 months, exports totaled about 456 million bushels, crushings accounted for about 655 million bushels and approximately 37 million bushels were used for seed.

Old crop flaxseed stocks on June 1 totaled 4.8 million bushels, 59 percent above a year ago and 19 percent above the June 1 level 2 years ago. Farm stocks were estimated at 1.7 million bushels and off-farm stocks totaled 3.1 million bushels.

April-May disappearance was 2.2 million bushels, 42 percent above the same period last year.
