

GRAIN STOCKS

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WHEAT, FEED GRAINS AND SOYBEANS ABOVE A YEAR AGO

April 1, 1978 wheat stocks at 41.5 million metric tons were nearly 10 percent above a year earlier, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Stocks of the four feed grains (corn, oats, barley, and sorghum) totaled 119 million metric tons, 20 percent above April 1, 1977. Corn stocks were up 17 percent, sorghum grain up 39 percent, oats up 61 percent and barley up 25 percent. Soybean stocks at 22.9 million metric tons were 36 percent above a year earlier.

CORN stored in all positions on April 1, 1978 totaled a record 3.84 billion bushels (97.6 million metric tons), up 17 percent from last year and 36 percent above April 1, 1976. Farm stocks at 2.48 billion bushels (63.1 million MT) were up 16 percent from April 1, 1977 and the highest April 1 stocks since 1972. Off-farm stocks at 1.36 billion bushels (34.4 million MT) were up 17 percent from the 1.16 billion bushels (29.4 million MT) in off-farm storage on April 1, 1977 and the highest April 1 stocks since 1961. Disappearance from all storage positions during January-March is indicated at 1.62 billion bushels (41.2 million MT), 2 percent above the 1.60 billion bushels (40.6 million MT) used in the same quarter a year ago.

SORGHUM GRAIN in all storage positions on April 1, 1978 totaled 412 million bushels (10.5 million MT), 39 percent more than a year earlier and 66 percent more than for the same date in 1976. Farm stocks totaled nearly 141 million bushels (3.57 million MT) and off-farm holdings were 272 million bushels (6.91 million MT), up 59 and 31 percent, respectively, from April 1, 1977. Disappearance from all storage positions during the first quarter of the calendar year is indicated at 205 million bushels (5.21 million MT), 5 percent more than the January-March disappearance in 1977.

OATS stored in all positions on April 1, 1978 totaled 417 million bushels (6.06 million metric tons), 61 percent above the record low April 1, 1977 stocks and 31 percent above April 1, 1976. Current oat stocks are the highest April 1 total since 1974. Farm stocks at 356 million bushels (5.17 million MT) were 68 percent above a year earlier and off-farm stocks at 61.2 million bushels (888 thousand MT) were up 29 percent. Disappearance during the January-March period was 146 million bushels (2.11 million MT), compared with 153 million bushels (2.23 million MT) in the same period last year.

This grain stocks report is based on responses from approximately 23,000 producers who report total stocks on their farms, plus responses from about 9,300 grain storage facilities that account for 86 percent of the total off-farm storage capacity.

BARLEY stocks in all positions on April 1, 1978 totaled 236 million bushels (5.14 million metric tons), 25 percent above last year, 28 percent above April 1, 1976 and the highest April 1 stocks since 1973. Farm holdings at 148 million bushels (3.23 million MT) were up 64 percent from a year earlier, but off-farm stocks at 87.5 million bushels (1.91 million MT) were down 10 percent. Disappearance from all storage positions during the January-March 1978 quarter was 92.0 million bushels (2.00 million MT), up 11 percent from the 83.2 million bushel (1.81 million MT) disappearance for the comparable period in 1977.

ALL WHEAT stocks in all positions on April 1, 1978 amounted to 1.52 billion bushels (41.5 million metric tons), about 10 percent greater than last year's 1.39 billion bushels (37.8 million MT). On-farm stocks at 643 million bushels (17.5 million MT) accounted for 42 percent of all stocks. Last year on-farm stocks accounted for 37 percent of all stocks or 511 million bushels (13.9 million MT). Off-farm stocks totaled 881 million bushels (24.0 million MT) compared with last year's 879 million bushels (23.9 million MT). Disappearance from January 1, 1978, through March 31, 1978, totaled 467 million bushels (12.7 million MT) compared with last year's disappearance of 392 million bushels (10.7 million MT).

DURUM WHEAT stored in all positions on January 1, 1978 totaled 91.3 million bushels (2.49 million metric tons), 16 percent less than last year's 108 million bushels (2.95 million MT). On-farm durum stocks totaled 61.6 million bushels (1.68 million MT), 67 percent of total durum stocks. Off-farm storage of durum amounted to 29.7 million bushels (808 thousand MT). Disappearance of durum from January 1, 1978 through March 31, 1978 totaled 17.1 million bushels (465 thousand MT). Last year's disappearance for the same quarter amounted to 19.4 million bushels (528 thousand MT).


RYE stocks in all positions on April 1, 1978 were the third smallest of record and amounted to 5.92 million bushels (150 thousand metric tons) of which about 3.98 million bushels (101 thousand MT) were on-farm and 1.94 million bushels (49.3 thousand MT) were in off-farm storages. In comparison, last year 2.84 million bushels (72.2 thousand MT) were on-farm and 3.37 million bushels (85.5 thousand MT) were off-farm with a total in all positions of 6.21 million bushels (158 thousand MT). Indicated disappearance from January 1 to April 1 amounted to 3.12 million bushels (79.3 thousand MT) compared with 2.68 million bushels (68.1 thousand MT) during the same period last year.

SOYBEANS in all positions on April 1, 1978 totaled 843 million bushels (22.9 million metric tons), up 36 percent from a year ago, but down 3 percent from April 1 two years ago. Farm stocks of 385 million bushels (10.5 million MT) were more than two-thirds larger than last April 1, but 6 percent below April 1, 1976. Off-farm stocks totaled 458 million bushels (12.5 million MT), up 17 percent from a year ago and about the same as two years ago, making it the second largest of record behind April 1, 1970. The January-March indicated disappearance was 465 million bushels (12.7 million MT), up 12 percent from the estimated disappearance for the same quarter a year ago.

The September-March indicated disappearance of 977 million bushels (26.6 million MT) was up 7 percent from the indicated disappearance for the same period a year earlier. During the past 7 months, about 408 million bushels (11.1 million MT) were exported and about 545 million bushels (14.8 million MT) were crushed, both at record high levels.

FLAXSEED stocks in all positions on April 1, 1978, totaled 8.89 million bushels (226 thousand metric tons), up 80 percent from April 1 stocks a year ago and up 24 percent from the same period two years ago. Farm stocks at 5.05 million bushels (128 thousand MT) were almost two and a half times larger than the small farm stocks a year ago and off-farm stocks at 3.85 million bushels (97.7 thousand MT) were about one-third larger than a year earlier. Indicated disappearance during January-March was 2.67 million bushels (67.7 thousand MT) compared with 2.28 million bushels (57.9 thousand MT) a year earlier.
