## SOYBEAN STOCKS UP 49 PERCENT

## FEED GRAINS UP 25 PERCENT

Soybean stocks at 13.6 million metric tons were up 49 percent from a year ago, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Stocks of the four feed grains (corn, oats, barley, and sorghum) totaled 87.4 million metric tons, 25 percent more than last June's 70.2 million metric tons. Increases from last year for individual feed grains were 18 percent for corn, 88 percent for oats, 37 percent for barley, and 52 percent for sorghum. June 1, 1978 wheat stocks at 32.0 million metric tons were up 6 percent from last year.

Corn in all storage positions on June 1, 1978 totaled 2.80 billion bushels (71.1 million MT), 18 percent above a year earlier, 50 percent above two years earlier, and the largest June 1 stocks in more than 15 years. Farm stocks totaled 1.81 billion bushels (46.0 million MT) and off-farm stocks were 989 million bushels (25.1 million MT). Disappearance from all storage positions during April and May was 1.04 billion bushels (26.5 million MT), up 12 percent from the same period of 1977.

Sorghum grain in all storage positions on June 1, 1978 amounted to 318 million bushels (8.09 million MT), 62 percent above a year earlier and 107 percent above the same date in 1976. Farm stocks totaled 109 million bushels (2.77 million MT), 78 percent more than last year while off-farm holdings at 209 million bushels (5.32 million MT) were up 55 percent. June 1 stocks indicate April-May disappearance at 95.7 million bushels (2.43 million MT), compared with 100 million bushels (2.54 million MT) in the same period last year.

Old crop oat stocks in storage on June 1, 1978 totaled 309 million bushels (4.49 million MT), 88 percent above the low June 1, 1977 stocks and 51 percent above the June 1, 1976 stocks. Farm stocks totaled 256 million bushels (3.72 million MT) and were nearly double the June 1, 1977 farm stocks. Off-farm stocks at 53.4 million bushels (775 thousand MT) were up 50 percent from last year. Disappearance from all storage positions during April and May 1978 was 108 million bushels (1.56 million MT), up 14 percent from the 94.1 million bushels (1.37 million MT) for the same period last year.

Old crop barley stocks in storage in all positions on June 1, 1978 totaled 172 million bushels (3.74 million MT), up 37 percent from last year and up 34 percent from June 1, 1976. Farm stocks totaled 104 million bushels (2.26 million MT), nearly double last year while off-farm stocks were 67.6 million bushels (1.47 million MT), down 8 percent from last year. Disappearance from all storage positions during April-May 1978 was 65.5 million bushels (1.43 million MT), up 5 percent from the comparable period in 1977.

All wheat (old crop) stored in all positions on June 1, 1978 totaled 1.17 billion bushels (32.0 million MT), 6 percent more than a year ago when stocks were at the level of 1.11 billion bushels (30.3 million MT), and 77 percent greater than two years ago. This is the largest June 1 stocks since 1963. Farm stocks totaled 492 million bushels (13.4 million MT) and off-farm storage was 682 million bushels (18.6 million MT). April-May disappearance this year totaled 351 million bushels (9.54 million MT) compared with 277 million bushels (7.55 million MT) last year.

Durum wheat (old crop) stocks in all positions amounted to 67.5 million bushels (1.84 million MT), 26 percent less than last year's 91.8 million bushels (2.50 million MT), but 26 percent more than two years ago. Farm stocks amounted to 49.6 million bushels (1.35 million MT), and off-farm storages had about 17.8 million bushels (486 thousand MT). Disappearance from all positions during April and May amounted to 23.9 million bushels (651 thousand MT) compared with 16.5 million bushels (448 thousand MT) during the same period last year.

Rye (old crop) on farms and in warehouses on June 1, 1978 totaled 3.97 million bushels (101 thousand MT), 10 percent less than last year's 4.42 million bushels (112 thousand MT), and the lowest level of record for June 1. Farm stocks accounted for 2.54 million bushels (64.5 thousand MT), while off-farm storages had about 1.42 million bushels (36.2 thousand MT). Disappearance from all storages during April and May 1978 amounted to 1.95 million bushels (49.6 thousand MT) compared with 1.79 million bushels (45.5 thousand MT) for the same period last year.

Soybean stocks in all positions on June 1, 1978 totaled 500 million bushels (13.6 million MT), up 49 percent from a year ago, but down 10 percent from June 1 two years ago. Farm stocks of 202 million bushels (5.51 million MT) were 119 percent larger than last June 1 but 20 percent below June 1, 1976. Off-farm stocks totaled 298 million bushels (8.10 million MT), up 22 percent from a year ago, but down 1 percent from two years ago.

The April-May indicated disappearance was 340 million bushels (9.25 million MT), up 20 percent from the disappearance for the same period a year ago. The September-May disappearance was 1.32 billion bushels (35.9 million MT), up 10 percent from the same period a year earlier. During the past nine months, about 555 million bushels (15.1 million MT) were exported and about 709 million bushels (19.3 million MT) were crushed.

Flaxseed (old crop) stocks in all positions on June 1, 1978 totaled 5.95 million bushels (151 thousand MT), up 98 percent from June 1 stocks a year ago and up 22 percent from the same period two years ago. Farm stocks at 3.33 million bushels (84.6 thousand MT) were more than double those of a year ago and off-farm stocks at 2.62 million bushels (66.6 thousand MT) were up 36 percent. Indicated disappearance during April-May was 3.00 million bushels (76.3 thousand MT) compared with 1.95 million bushels (49.4 thousand MT) a year earlier.


