SOYBEANS AND FEED GRAINS ABOVE A YEAR AGO WHEAT STOCKS DECLINE

April 1, 1979 soybean stocks at 23.7 million metric tons were 3 percent above a year earlier, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Stocks of the four feed grains (corn, oats, barley and sorghum) totaled 135 million metric tons, 12 percent above a year ago. Corn stocks were up 14 percent, sorghum grain up 1 percent, and barley up 24 percent, while oat stocks were off 6 percent. All wheat stocks at 33.3 million metric tons were 20 percent below April 1, 1978.

CORN stored in all positions on April 1, 1979 totaled a record 4.42 billion bushels (112 million metric tons), 14 percent above April 1, 1978. Farm stocks at 3.10 billion bushels (78.7 million metric tons), also a record, were up 23 percent from last year. Off-farm stocks at 1.32 billion bushels (33.6 million metric tons) were down 3 percent from the April 1 stocks a year earlier, but were still the third highest April 1 off-farm stocks on record. Disappearance from all storage positions during January-March is indicated at 1.78 billion bushels (45.2 million metric tons), 9 percent above the 1.63 billion bushels (41.3 million metric tons) used in the same period a year earlier.

SORGHUM GRAIN in all storage positions on April 1, 1979 amounted to 419 million bushels (10.6 million metric tons), 1 percent above a year earlier and 41 percent above the same date in 1977. Farm stocks at a record high 143 million bushels (3.62 million metric tons) and off-farm holdings at 276 million bushels (7.02 million metric tons) were both up 1 percent from last year. Disappearance from all storage positions during the first quarter of the calendar year is indicated at 222 million bushels (5.64 million metric tons), 9 percent more than the January-March disappearance in 1978.

OATS stored in all positions on April 1, 1979 amounted to 394 million bushels (5.71 million metric tons), 6 percent less than a year earlier but 52 percent above the record low April 1, 1977 stocks. Farm stocks at 329 million bushels (4.78 million metric tons) were 8 percent below a year ago and off-farm stocks at 64.4 million bushels (935 thousand metric tons) were 5 percent above a year ago. Disappearance during the January-March period was 170 million bushels (2.47 million metric tons), 16 percent more than the same period last year.

This grain stocks report is based on responses from approximately 23,000 producers who report total stocks on their farms, plus responses from about 9,400 grain storage facilities that account for 86 percent of the total off-farm storage capacity.

BARLEY stocks in all positions on April 1, 1979 totaled 295 million bushels (6.42 million metric tons), 24 percent above last year and 57 percent above April 1, 1977. This is the highest April 1 barley stocks since 1970 and the second highest of record. Farm holdings at 197 million bushels (4.28 million metric tons) were up 32 percent from a year earlier and off-farm stocks at 98.1 million bushels (2.14 million metric tons) were up 10 percent. Disappearance from all storage positions during January-March 1979 was 93.3 million bushels (2.03 million metric tons), up 2 percent from the 91.3 million bushel (1.99 million metric tons) disappearance for the comparable period in 1978.

ALL WHEAT stocks in all positions on April 1, 1979 totaled 1.22 billion bushels (33.3 million metric tons), 20 percent less than last year's April 1 stocks of 1.53 billion bushels (41.6 million metric tons). About 51 percent of the stocks or 629 million bushels (17.1 million metric tons) were on-farm while 595 million bushels (16.2 million metric tons) were in off-farm facilities. Last year 640 million bushels (17.4 million metric tons) or 42 percent were on-farm and 888 million bushels (24.2 million metric tons) were off-farm. Disappearance from January 1, 1979 to April 1, 1979 totaled 408 million bushels (11.1 million metric tons) compared with 466 million bushels (12.7 million metric tons) last year.

DURUM WHEAT stocks in all positions on April 1, 1979 amounted to 105 million bushels (2.87 million metric tons), 15 percent more than last year's April 1 stocks of 91.4 million bushels (2.49 million metric tons). On-farm durum stocks totaled 83.7 million bushels (2.28 million metric tons) or 79 percent of the total durum stocks. Off-farm durum stocks were 21.7 million bushels (592 thousand metric tons). A year ago 67 percent of the stocks were on-farm at 61.6 million bushels (1.68 million metric tons) and 29.8 million bushels (810 thousand metric tons) were off-farm. Disappearance during the January-March 1979 quarter totaled 11.6 million bushels (316 thousand metric tons) compared with 17.0 million bushels (463 thousand metric tons) last year.


RYE stocks in all positions on April 1, 1979 amounted to 12.6 million bushels (319 thousand metric tons), more than double last year's 6.12 million bushels (156 thousand metric tons). Stocks on-farms totaled 8.66 million bushels (220 thousand metric tons) and off-farm storage was 3.91 million bushels (99.2 thousand metric tons). In comparison, last year's on-farm rye stocks were 4.16 million bushels (106 thousand metric tons) while off-farm stocks were 1.96 million bushels (49.9 thousand metric tons). Indicated disappearance from January 1, 1979 to April 1, 1979 amounted to 3.70 million bushels (93.9 thousand metric tons) while disappearance during the same period last year was 3.17 million bushels (80.5 thousand metric tons).

SOYBEANS in all positions on April 1, 1979 totaled a record 871 million bushels (23.7 million metric tons), up 3 percent from a year ago and 41 percent above April 1, 1977. Farm stocks of 404 million bushels (11.0 million metric tons) were 3 percent above April 1, 1978. Off-farm stocks totaled nearly 468 million bushels (12.7 million metric tons), also up 3 percent from last year. The January-March indicated disappearance was 511 million bushels (13.9 million metric tons), up 7 percent from disappearance for the same quarter a year ago.

The September-March indicated disappearance of 1.13 billion bushels (30.8 million metric tons) was up 11 percent from disappearance for the same period a year earlier. During the September 1978-March 1979 period, about 512 million bushels (13.9 million metric tons) were exported and about 608 million bushels (16.6 million metric tons) were crushed.

FLAXSEED stocks in all positions on April 1, 1979 totaled 6.06 million bushels (154 thousand metric tons), down 28 percent from April 1 stocks a year ago but up 22 percent from the same date two years ago. Farm stocks at 2.94 million bushels (74.7 thousand metric tons) were down 35 percent from a year earlier and off-farm stocks at 3.12 million bushels (79.3 thousand metric tons) were down 20 percent. Indicated disappearance during January-March this year was 2.31 million bushels (58.7 thousand metric tons) compared with 2.54 million bushels (64.4 thousand metric tons) during the same period last year.
