## SOYBEANS AND CORN STOCKS RECORD HIGH WHEAT STOCKS FRACTIONALLY LOWER THAN 1979

April 1, 1980 soybean stocks at a record 32.2 million metric tons were 34 percent above a year earlier, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Stocks of the four feed grains (corn, sorghum, oats and barley) totaled 142 million metric tons, 5 percent above a year ago. Corn stocks at a record 121 million metric tons were up 8 percent, while sorghum stocks were down 6 percent and oats and barley stocks were each off 12 percent. All wheat stocks at 33.3 million metric tons were fractionally lower than a year earlier.

CORN stored in all positions on April 1, 1980 totaled a record 4.78 billion bushels (121 million metric tons), 8 percent more than April 1, 1979. Farm stocks at 3.36 billion bushels (85.4 million metric tons), also a record, were up 8 percent from last year. Off-farm stocks at 1.42 billion bushels (36.0 million metric tons) were up 7 percent from the April 1 stocks a year earlier and were the highest April 1 off-farm stocks since 1961. Disappearance from all storage positions during January - March is indicated at 1.99 billion bushels (50.6 million metric tons), 12 percent above the 1.78 billion bushels (45.2 million metric tons) used in the same period a year ago.

SORGHUM GRAIN in all positions on April 1, 1980 amounted to 394 million bushels (10.0 million metric tons), 6 percent less than a year earlier and 5 percent less than April 1, 1978. Farm stocks at 142 million bushels (3.59 million metric tons) were 1 percent below a year ago and off-farm stocks at 253 million bushels (6.42 million metric tons) were down 9 percent from last year. Disappearance from all storage positions during the first quarter of the calendar year is indicated at 252 million bushels (6.40 million metric tons), 14 percent more than the January - March disappearance in 1979. Exports during the period were 106 million bushels (2.69 million metric tons) compared with 68 million bushels (1.73 million metric tons) during the comparable period last year.

OATS stored in all positions on April 1, 1980 amounted to 344 million bushels (4.99 million metric tons), 12 percent less than a year earlier and 18 percent below April 1, 1978. Farm stocks at 288 million bushels (4.18 million metric tons) were 12 percent below a year ago and off-farm stocks at 55.4 million bushels (804 thousand metric tons) were down 14 percent. Disappearance during the January - March period was 139 million bushels (2.02 million metric tons), 18 percent less than the same period last year.

This grain stocks report is based on responses from approximately 23,000 producers who reported total stocks of each crop on their farms, plus responses from about 10,100 grain storage facilities that account for 85 percent of the total off-farm storage capacity.

BARLEY stocks in all positions on April 1, 1980 totaled 261 million bushels (5.67 million metric tons), 12 percent less than last year but 10 percent above the April 1, 1978 stocks. Farm stocks of just over 164 million bushels (3.58 million metric tons) were down 17 percent from a year earlier and off-farm stocks at 96.2 million bushels (2.10 million metric tons) were down 2 percent. Indicated disappearance during the January-March quarter amounted to 103 million bushels (2.24 million metric tons), up 9 percent from the 94.4 million bushels (2.05 million metric tons) disappearance for the comparable period in 1979.

ALL WHEAT stored in all positions on April 1, 1980 amounted to 1.23 billion bushels (33.3 million metric tons), down slightly from stocks on hand a year earlier and 20 percent less than two years ago. Farm stocks of 570 million bushels (15.5 million metric tons) are 9 percent less than last year's 630 million bushels (17.1 million metric tons). On-farm storage this April 1 accounted for 47 percent of the total wheat stocks compared with 51 percent a year earlier. Off-farm wheat stocks at the beginning of April totaled 655 million bushels (17.8 million metric tons), 10 percent more than last year's 596 million bushels (16.2 million metric tons). Indicated disappearance during the January-March quarter is 491 million bushels (13.4 million metric tons) compared with 407 million bushels (11.1 million metric tons) for the comparable period a year ago.

DURUM WHEAT in all storage positions on April 1, 1980 totaled 85.7 million bushels (2.33 million metric tons), 18 percent less than last year's 104 million bushels (2.84 million metric tons). Farm storages are holding 64.5 million bushels (1.76 million metric tons), 75 percent of the April 1 total durum stocks. A year ago, durum stocks on farms totaled 83.0 million bushels (2.26 million metric tons), 79 percent of the total durum stocks. Off-farm durum stocks totaled 21.2 million bushels (577 thousand metric tons), 1 percent less than last year's 21.5 million bushels (586 thousand metric tons). Disappearance during the January-March quarter totaled 21.5 million bushels (584 thousand metric tons). For the same period last year, disappearance was 12.5 million bushels (341 thousand metric tons).


RYE stored in all positions on April 1, 1980 totaled 16.2 million bushels (412 thousand metric tons), 29 percent more than last year's 12.6 million bushels (319 thousand metric tons). On-farm rye stocks at 10.2 million bushels (259 thousand metric tons) were 18 percent more than a year ago and accounted for 63 percent of the total April 1, 1980 rye stocks. In comparison, last year 8.66 million bushels (220 thousand metric tons), or 69 percent of the total rye stocks were stored on-farms. This year's April 1 off-farm rye stocks at 6.02 million bushels (153 thousand metric tons) were 55 percent larger than last year. Indicated disappearance during the January-March quarter totaled 2.93 million bushels (74.3 thousand metric tons); last year's disappearance for the same period was 3.71 million bushels (94.2 thousand metric tons).

SOYBEANS in all positions on April 1, 1980 totaled a record 1.18 billion bushels (32.2 million metric tons), up 34 percent from a year ago and 39 percent more than April 1, 1978. Farm stocks of 604 million bushels (16.4 million metric tons) were 46 percent above April 1, 1979. Off-farm stocks totaled 580 million bushels (15.8 million metric tons), up 24 percent from last year. Both farm stocks and off-farm stocks are at record high levels for April 1.

The January-March indicated disappearance was 587 million bushels (16.0 million metric tons), up 15 percent from disappearance for the same quarter a year ago. The September-March indicated disappearance of 1.26 billion bushels (34.2 million metric tons) was up 9 percent from disappearance for the same period a year earlier.

FLAXSEED stocks in all positions on April 1, 1980 totaled 7.61 million bushels (193 thousand metric tons), up 30 percent from April 1 stocks a year ago but 9 percent less than on the same date two years ago. Farm stocks at 4.36 million bushels (111 thousand metric tons) were up 55 percent from a year earlier and off-farm stocks at 3.25 million bushels (82.5 thousand metric tons) were up 7 percent from last year. Indicated disappearance during January-March this year was 2.51 million bushels (63.9 thousand metric tons) compared with 2.32 million bushels (59.0 thousand metric tons) during the same period last year.
