SOYBEAN AND CORN STOCKS AT RECORD HIGH

WHEAT STOCKS 3 PERCENT BELOW 1979

Soybean stocks at a record 21.1 million metric tons on June 1, 1980 were up 47 percent from a year ago, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Stocks of the four feed grains (corn, oats, barley, and sorghum) totaled 106 million metric tons, 6 percent more than last June's 99.5 million metric tons. An 11 percent increase from last year in stocks of corn to a record 91.1 million metric tons more than offset a 15 percent decline in sorghum stocks and declines of 17 percent in oats and 16 percent in barley stocks. June 1, 1980 wheat stocks at 24.5 million metric tons were 3 percent less than the 25.2 million metric tons on June 1, 1979.

Corn in all storage positions on June 1, 1980 totaled a record 3.59 billion bushels (91.1 million metric tons), 11 percent more than a year earlier and 26 percent above June 1, 1978. Farm stocks totaled over 2.49 billion bushels (63.4 million metric tons), up 10 percent from last year, while off-farm stocks at 1.09 billion bushels (27.7 million metric tons) were up 13 percent from a year earlier. Disappearance from all storage positions during April and May 1980 was 1.19 billion bushels (30.3 million metric tons), about the same as a year ago.

Sorghum grain in all storage positions on June 1, 1980 amounted to 276 million bushels (7.01 million metric tons), 15 percent less than a year earlier and 14 percent below the same date in 1978. Farm stocks totaled 89.9 million bushels (2.28 million metric tons), 10 percent less than last year and off-farm holdings at 186 million bushels (4.73 million metric tons) were down 17 percent. Disappearance from all storage positions during April and May 1980 was 119 million bushels (3.01 million metric tons), up 23 percent from the disappearance of 96.0 million bushels (2.44 million metric tons) during the same period last year. Exports during the period were 58 million bushels (1.47 million metric tons) compared with 28 million bushels (711 thousand metric tons) during the comparable period last year.

Old crop oat stocks in all storage positions on June 1, 1980 amounted to 239 million bushels (3.47 million metric tons), 17 percent less than a year earlier and 23 percent less than the same date in 1978. Farm stocks at 202 million bushels (2.92 million metric tons) were 15 percent below a year ago and off-farm stocks at 37.9 million bushels (549 thousand metric tons) were 25 percent less than a year ago. Disappearance from all storage positions during April and May 1980 was 104 million bushels (1.51 million metric tons), up less than 1 percent from the disappearance for the same period last year.

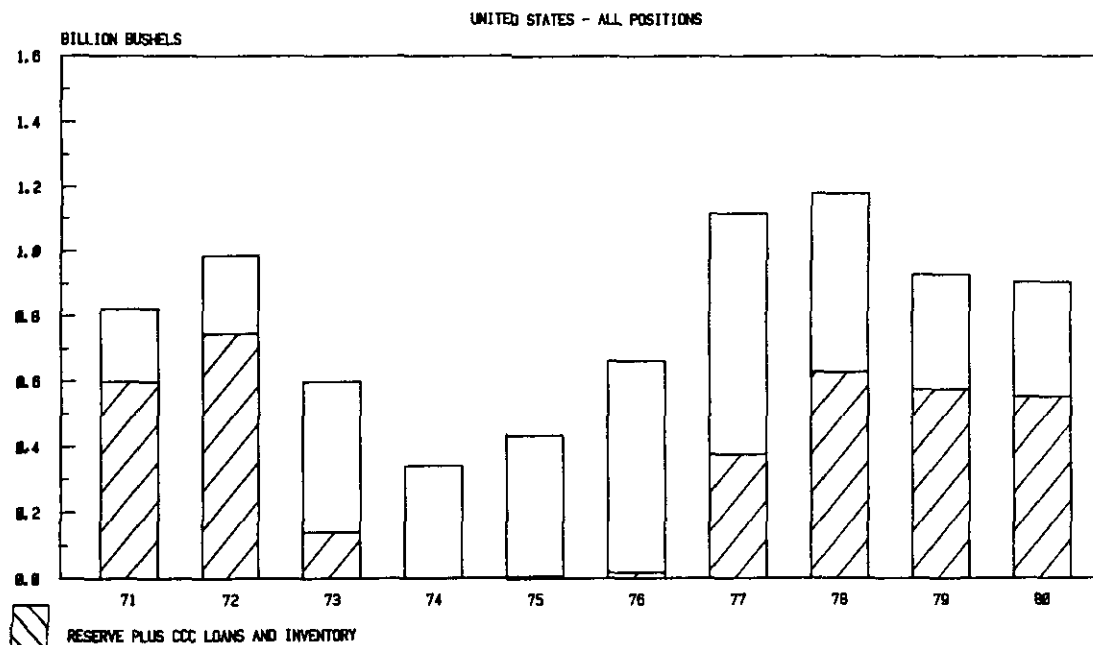
Old crop barley stocks in all positions on June 1, 1980 totaled 191 million bushels (4.17 million metric tons), 16 percent less than last year but 11 percent greater than the June 1, 1978 stocks. Farm storages held 112 million bushels (2.43 million metric tons) on June 1, 26 percent below last year but off-farm stocks at 79.7 million bushels (1.74 million metric tons) were up 1 percent.

The April-May 1980 indicated disappearance was 69.2 million bushels (1.51 million metric tons), up 3 percent from the disappearance for the comparable period a year ago.

Old crop wheat stored in all positions on June 1, 1980 amounted to 901 million bushels (24.5 million metric tons), 3 percent less than the 925 million bushels (25.2 million metric tons) on hand a year earlier and 23 percent less than two years ago. Farm stocks totaled 377 million bushels (10.2 million metric tons), 42 percent of the total. In comparison, last June 1 farm stocks were 485 million bushels (13.2 million metric tons) or 52 percent of the total. June 1, 1980 off-farm stocks totaled 524 million bushels (14.3 million metric tons), 19 percent more than last year's 440 million bushels (12.0 million metric tons). April-May disappearance this year was 324 million bushels (8.83 million metric tons) compared with 301 million bushels (8.19 million metric tons) during the comparable months last year. The larger disappearance this year resulted from increased exports.

Old crop durum wheat stocks in all positions on June 1, 1980 at 57.4 million bushels (1.56 million metric tons) were 33 percent below last year's 85.8 million bushels (2.33 million metric tons) and 14 percent less than two years ago. Farm stocks accounted for 77 percent of the total or about 44.4 million bushels (1.21 million metric tons). June 1, 1979 farm stocks totaled 69.7 million bushels (1.90 million metric tons) or 81 percent of the total durum stocks. June 1, 1980 off-farm stocks totaled 12.9 million bushels (352 thousand metric tons) compared with 16.1 million bushels (438 thousand metric tons) last year. April-May disappearance this year totaled 28.4 million bushels (772 thousand metric tons); last year, April-May disappearance was 18.7 million bushels (509 thousand metric tons).

Old crop rye stocks in all storage positions on June 1, 1980 totaled 13.3 million bushels (338 thousand metric tons), up 38 percent from last year's 9.67 million bushels (246 thousand metric tons). Farm stocks accounted for 8.06 million bushels (205 thousand metric tons) and off-farm stocks were 5.25 million bushels (133 thousand metric tons). Disappearance from all storages during April and May 1980 totaled 2.93 million bushels (74.3 thousand metric tons) compared with 2.89 million bushels (73.3 thousand metric tons) disappearance for the comparable period last year.

Soybean stocks in all positions June 1, 1980 totaled a record 774 million bushels (21.1 million metric tons), up 47 percent from a year ago and 53 percent above June 1 two years ago. Both farm and off-farm stocks are at record high levels for June 1. Farm stocks of 398 million bushels (10.8 million metric tons) were 64 percent greater than last June 1 and 92 percent above June 1, 1978. Off-farm stocks totaled 376 million bushels (10.2 million metric tons), up 32 percent from last year and 26 percent above June 1 two years ago.

The September-May utilization is indicated at 1668 million bushels (45.4 million metric tons), up 11 percent from the same period a year earlier. During September-May, about 710 million bushels (19.3 million metric tons) were exported and about 872 million bushels (23.7 million metric tons) were crushed. The amount used or to be used for seeding the 1980 crop is expected to total about 75 million bushels. This indicates that about 1657 million bushels were utilized during the nine month period, giving a calculated stocks of 785 million bushels (supply of 2442 million bushels minus 1657 million bushels utilized). The historic relationship of the calculated stocks and reported stocks on June 1 would indicate that the 1979 production estimate may be some 15 million bushels too low. Final revisions of the 1979 national and State production estimates will be published in the October 1980 Crop Production Report following evaluation of the September 1 Stocks Report.

Old crop flaxseed stocks in all positions on June 1, 1980 totaled 5.26 million bushels (134 thousand metric tons), up 90 percent from June 1 stocks a year ago but 4 percent less than two years ago. Farm stocks at 2.93 million bushels (74.4 thousand metric tons) were more than double those of a year earlier while off-farm stocks were up 45 percent from last year. Indicated disappearance during April-May 1980 was 2.34 million bushels (59.5 thousand metric tons) compared with 3.07 million bushels (77.9 thousand metric tons) for the same period a year earlier.
