## SOYBEANS AND FEED GRAINS DOWN FROM A YEAR EARLIER

Stocks of soybeans on April 1, 1981 totaled 28.1 million metric tons, down 13 percent from last year's record level, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Stocks of the four feed grains (corn, sorghum, oats and barley) totaled 118 million metric tons, 18 percent less than a year ago. Corn stocks at 101 million metric tons were off 18 percent, while sorghum stocks were down 21 percent. Barley stocks were down 23 percent from a year earlier and oats stocks were down 25 percent. All wheat stocks totaled 36.3 million metric tons, 9 percent more than a year ago.

CORN stored in all positions on April 1, 1981 totaled 4.00 billion bushels (101 million metric tons), 18 percent below last year's record level of 4.86 billion bushels (123 million metric tons). Off-farm stocks at 1.34 billion bushels (34.1 million metric tons) were down 5 percent from the April 1 stocks a year earlier. Farm stocks at 2.65 billion bushels (67.3 million metric tons) were off 23 percent from last year's record level. Disappearance from all storage positions during the first quarter of the calendar year is indicated at 1.86 billion bushels (47.3 million metric tons), 8 percent below the 2.03 billion bushels (51.5 million metric tons) used in the same period a year ago. Of the total corn stored in all positions on April 1, 1981, 1.11 billion bushels were under Government control. Of this amount, 245 million bushels were owned by the Commodity Credit Corporation and 863 million bushels were held in the farmer-owned reserve.

SORGHUM GRAIN in all positions on April 1, 1981 amounted to 313 million bushels (7.95 million metric tons), 21 percent less than a year earlier and 25 percent less than April 1, 1979. Farm stocks totaled 82.9 million bushels (2.11 million metric tons) and off-farm holdings were 230 million bushels (5.84 million metric tons), down 42 and 9 percent, respectively, from April 1, 1980. Disappearance from all storage positions during the first quarter of the calendar year was 154 million bushels (3.91 million metric tons), 39 percent less than the January-March disappearance in 1980. Of the April 1, 1981 total sorghum stocks, 40.3 million bushels were under Government control. This total includes 40.2 million bushels owned by the Commodity Credit Corporation and 133 thousand bushels held in the farmer-owned reserve.

The Quarterly Grain Stocks reports are based on responses from approximately 20,000 producers who reported grain stocks on their farms, plus responses from about 9,800 grain storage facilities which account for 85 percent of the total off-farm storage capacity.

OATS stored in all positions on April 1, 1981 amounted to 256 million bushels (3.71 million metric tons), 25 percent less than a year earlier and 33 percent below April 1, 1979. Farm stocks amounted to 211 million bushels (3.07 million metric tons), 26 percent less than a year earlier. Off-farm holdings totaled 44.4 million bushels (644 thousand metric tons), down 20 percent from April 1, 1980. Indicated disappearance during January-March 1981 totaled 135 million bushels (1.96 million metric tons), down 2 percent from the comparable quarter a year ago. Of the total oats on hand April 1, 2.85 million bushels were under Government control. Of this amount, 1.66 million bushels were owned by Commodity Credit Corporation and 1.19 million bushels were held in the farmer-owned reserve.

BARLEY stored in all positions on April 1, 1981 totaled 202 million bushels (4.40 million metric tons), 23 percent less than last year's 262 million bushels (5.71 million metric tons), and 32 percent below April 1, 1979. Off-farm stocks at 90.0 million bushels (1.96 million metric tons), were 7 percent less than a year earlier. Farm stocks, at 112 million bushels (2.44 million metric tons), were 32 percent below the stocks on hand April 1, 1980. Disappearance during January-March 1981 was 99.8 million bushels (2.17 million metric tons), down 3 percent from the corresponding period a year earlier. Of the total barley on hand April 1, 16.8 million bushels were under Government control. Of this amount, 3.22 million bushels were owned by the Commodity Credit Corporation and 13.6 million bushels were held in the farmer-owned reserve.

ALL WHEAT stored in all positions on April 1, 1981 amounted to 1.33 billion bushels (36.3 million metric tons), up 9 percent from stocks on hand a year earlier and 8 percent more than two years ago. Farm stocks of 543 million bushels (14.8 million metric tons) are 5 percent less than last year's 570 million bushels (15.5 million metric tons). On-farm storage this April 1 accounted for 41 percent of the total wheat stocks compared with 46 percent a year earlier. Off-farm wheat stocks at the beginning of April totaled 791 million bushels (21.5 million metric tons), 21 percent more than last year's 656 million bushels (17.8 million metric tons). Indicated disappearance during the January-March quarter is 571 million bushels (15.5 million metric tons) compared with 491 million bushels (13.4 million metric tons) for the comparable period a year ago. Of the total April 1, 1981 all wheat stocks, 523 million bushels were under Government control. This total includes 192 million bushels owned by the Commodity Credit Corporation and 331 million bushels held in the farmer-owned reserve.

DURUM WHEAT in all storage positions on April 1, 1981 totaled 83.2 million bushels (2.26 million metric tons), 3 percent less than last year's 85.8 million bushels (2.33 million metric tons). Farm storages are holding 60.0 million bushels (1.63 million metric tons), 72 percent of the April 1 total durum stocks. A year ago, durum stocks on farms totaled 64.5 million bushels (1.76 million metric tons), 75 percent of the total durum stocks. Off-farm durum stocks totaled 23.2 million bushels (632 thousand metric tons), 9 percent more than last year's 21.3 million bushels (579 thousand metric tons). Disappearance during the January-March quarter totaled 20.2 million bushels (551 thousand metric tons), compared with 21.4 million bushels (583 thousand metric tons) for the comparable period a year earlier.


RYE stored in all positions on April 1, 1981 totaled 6.80 million bushels (173 thousand metric tons), 55 percent less than last year's 15.0 million bushels (381 thousand metric tons). On-farm rye stocks at 3.48 million bushels (88.3 thousand metric tons) were 61 percent less than a year ago. This year's April 1 off-farm rye stocks at 3.32 million bushels (84.4 thousand metric tons) were 45 percent less than last year. Indicated disappearance during the January-March quarter totaled 2.49 million bushels (63.2 thousand metric tons); last year's disappearance for the same period was 2.72 million bushels (69.0 thousand metric tons).

SOYBEANS in all positions on April 1, 1981 totaled 1.03 billion bushels (28.1 million metric tons), down 13 percent from a year ago but 17 percent more than April 1, 1979. Farm stocks of 540 million bushels (14.7 million metric tons) were 10 percent below April 1, 1980. Off-farm stocks totaled 494 million bushels (13.4 million metric tons), down 15 percent from April 1 a year earlier.

The September-March indicated disappearance was 1.14 billion bushels (31.1 million metric tons), down 9 percent from disappearance for the same period a year ago. Exports totaled about 457 million bushels (12.4 million metric tons) and crushings accounted for about 635 million bushels (17.3 million metric tons).

FLAXSEED stocks in all positions on April 1, 1981 totaled a record low 4.41 million bushels (112 thousand metric tons), down 39 percent from April 1 stocks a year ago and 18 percent less than on the same date two years ago. Farm stocks at 2.16 million bushels (54.8 thousand metric tons) were down 46 percent from a year earlier and off-farm stocks at 2.25 million bushels (57.2 thousand metric tons) were down 31 percent from April 1 last year. Indicated disappearance during January-March this year was 2.27 million bushels (57.5 thousand metric tons) compared with 2.42 million bushels (61.4 thousand metric tons) during the same period a year earlier.
