CORN STOCKS AT RECORD HIGH

Corn stocks on April 1, 1982 totaled a record high 129 million metric tons, up 27 percent from a year ago, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Stocks of the four feed grains (corn, sorghum, barley and oats) totaled 149 million metric tons, 27 percent above the April 1, 1981 total. Soybean stocks, at 28.6 million metric tons, were up 2 percent and all wheat stocks at 42.3 million metric tons were up 17 percent from a year earlier. Other changes from last year were: sorghum, up 47 percent; oats, down 8 percent; and barley, up 11 percent.

CORN stored in all positions on April 1, 1982 totaled a record high 5.07 billion bushels (129 million metric tons), 27 percent more than last year's level of 3.99 billion bushels (101 million metric tons). Of the total corn on hand April 1, 1982, 70 percent or 3.57 billion bushels (90.7 million metric tons) was stored on farms. Farm stocks were 35 percent greater than April 1 farm stocks a year ago. Off-farm stocks, at 1.50 billion bushels (38.2 million metric tons), were up 12 percent from last year's level.

Indicated disappearance from all storage positions during January-March 1982 totaled 1.82 billion bushels (46.3 million metric tons), down 3 percent from disappearance during the comparable quarter a year ago.

Of the April 1, 1982 total corn stored in all positions, 1.43 billion bushels or 28 percent were under Government control - 262 million bushels were owned by the Commodity Credit Corporation and 1.16 billion bushels were held under farmer-owned reserve.

SORGHUM GRAIN in all positions on April 1, 1982 totaled 461 million bushels (11.7 million metric tons), 47 percent more than a year earlier and 17 percent more than April 1, 1980. Farm stocks totaled 125 million bushels (3.18 million metric tons) and off-farm holdings were 336 million bushels (8.54 million metric tons), up 54 and 44 percent, respectively, from April 1, 1981. Disappearance from all storage positions during the first quarter of the calendar year was 228 million bushels (5.79 million metric tons), 51 percent more than the January-March disappearance in 1981. Of the April 1, 1982 total sorghum stocks, 254 million bushels were under Government control. This total includes 38.1 million bushels owned by the Commodity Credit Corporation and 216 million bushels held in the farmer-owned reserve.

OATS stored in all positions on April 1, 1982 amounted to 237 million bushels (3.43 million metric tons), 8 percent less than a year earlier and 30 percent below April 1, 1980. Farm stocks amounted to 200 million bushels (2.91 million metric tons), 5 percent less than a year earlier. Off-farm holdings totaled 36.3 million bushels (527 thousand metric tons), down 18 percent from April 1, 1981. Indicated disappearance during January-March 1982 totaled 128 million bushels (1.86 million metric tons), down 5 percent from the comparable quarter a year ago. Of the total oats on hand April 1, only 1.60 million bushels were under Government control. All of this was owned by the Commodity Credit Corporation.

BARLEY stored in all positions on April 1, 1982 totaled 226 million bushels (4.93 million metric tons), 11 percent more than last year's 203 million bushels (4.43 million metric tons), but 14 percent below April 1, 1980. Of the total barley stocks on hand April 1, 1982, 65 percent or 147 million bushels (3.21 million metric tons), was stored on farms. Farm stocks were 30 percent more than the April 1 farm stocks a year ago. Off-farm stocks, at 79.2 million bushels (1.72 million metric tons), were down 12 percent from last year's level. Disappearance during January-March 1982 was 106 million bushels (2.30 million metric tons), up 6 percent from the corresponding period a year earlier. Of the total barley stocks on hand April 1, 24.0 million bushels were under Government control. This included 3.30 million bushels owned by the Commodity Credit Corporation and 20.7 million bushels held in the farmer-owned reserve.

ALL WHEAT stored in all positions on April 1, 1982 totaled 1.55 billion bushels (42.3 million metric tons), 17 percent more than last year's 1.33 billion bushels (36.2 million metric tons) and 27 percent more than April 1, 1980. Farm stocks were 748 million bushels (20.4 million metric tons), and accounted for 48 percent of the total April 1, 1982 wheat stocks. Farm stocks on April 1, 1981, at 539 million bushels (14.7 million metric tons), accounted for 41 percent of total stocks. April 1, 1982 off-farm wheat stocks totaled 807 million bushels (22.0 million metric tons), 2 percent more than the April 1, 1981 total of 790 million bushels (21.5 million metric tons). Indicated disappearance during the January-March 1982 period totaled 621 million bushels (16.9 million metric tons). Disappearance for the comparable period a year ago was 575 million bushels (15.6 million metric tons). Wheat under Government control on April 1 totaled over 723 million bushels -- 535 million in the farmer-owned reserve and 189 million owned by the Commodity Credit Corporation.

DURUM WHEAT stored in all positions on April 1, 1982 totaled 132 million bushels (3.60 million metric tons), 59 percent more than last year's 83.3 million bushels (2.27 million metric tons) and 54 percent more than April 1, 1980. Farm stocks of 106 million bushels (2.88 million metric tons) are 76 percent more than last year's 60.0 million bushels (1.63 million metric tons). This year's farm stocks of durum wheat account for 80 percent of the total durum wheat stocks, compared with 72 percent last year. Off-farm stocks of 26.7 million bushels (725 thousand metric tons) are 14 percent more than last year's 23.3 million bushels (634 thousand metric tons). Indicated disappearance during the January-March 1982 quarter totaled 20.1 million bushels (546 thousand metric tons), compared with the 20.2 million bushels (549 thousand metric tons) disappearance during the comparable period a year earlier.

RYE stored in all positions on April 1, 1982 totaled 5.67 million bushels (144 thousand metric tons), 17 percent less than last year's 6.87 million bushels (174 thousand metric tons). Farm stocks of 3.35 million bushels (85.0 thousand metric tons) accounted for 59 percent of total rye stocks on April 1, 1982. On April 1, 1981, 3.52 million bushels (89.3 thousand metric tons) or 51 percent of total rye stocks were on farms. Off-farm rye stocks on April 1, 1982 totaled 2.32 million bushels (59.0 thousand metric tons), compared with last year's 3.35 million bushels (85.1 thousand metric tons). Disappearance during the January-March 1982 quarter was 2.17 million bushels (55.0 thousand metric tons) compared with 2.48 million bushels (62.9 thousand metric tons) during the corresponding period a year earlier.

SOYBEANS in all positions April 1, 1982 totaled 1.05 billion bushels (28.6 million metric tons), up 2 percent from a year ago but 11 percent less than April 1, 1980. Farm stocks of 591 million bushels (16.1 million metric tons) were 11 percent above April 1, 1981. Off-farm stocks totaled 459 million bushels (12.5 million metric tons), down 8 percent from April 1, a year earlier.

The January-March disappearance was 594 million bushels (16.2 million metric tons), up 21 percent from disappearance during the comparable quarter a year earlier.

The September-March indicated disappearance was 1.30 billion bushels (35.3 million metric tons), up 16 percent from disappearance for the same period a year ago.

FLAXSEED stocks in all positions on April 1, 1982 totaled a record low 3.56 million bushels (90.3 thousand metric tons), down 18 percent from April 1 stocks a year ago and 51 percent less than on the same date two years ago. Farm stocks at 2.04 million bushels (51.7 thousand metric tons) were down 2 percent from a year earlier while off-farm stocks, at 1.52 million bushels (38.6 thousand metric tons), were down 32 percent. Indicated disappearance during January-March 1982 was 1.54 million bushels (39.1 thousand metric tons) compared with 2.22 million bushels (56.3 thousand metric tons) during the same period a year earlier.
