CORN STOCKS AT RECORD HIGH

Corn stocks on June 1, 1982 totaled a record high 97.9 million metric tons, up 39 percent from last year's level according to the Crop Reporting Board. Stocks of the four feed grains (corn, sorghum, barley and oats) totaled 113 million metric tons, 40 percent greater than the June 1, 1981 total. In addition to the increase shown for corn, sorghum was up 106 percent; barley, up 8 percent; and oats, down 14 percent. Soybean stocks, at 17.9 million metric tons, were down 3 percent from a year earlier while wheat stocks totaled 31.5 million metric tons, up 17 percent from June 1, 1981.

Corn stored in all positions on June 1, 1982 totaled a record high 3.85 billion bushels (97.9 million metric tons), 39 percent more than last year's level of 2.77 billion bushels (70.5 million metric tons). Of the total corn on hand June 1, 1982, 70 percent or 2.71 billion bushels (68.8 million metric tons) was stored on farms. Farm stocks were 49 percent greater than June 1 farm stocks a year ago. Off-farm stocks, at 1.15 billion bushels (29.1 million metric tons), were up 20 percent from last year's level. Indicated disappearance from all storage positions during April and May 1982 totaled 1.22 billion bushels (31.0 million metric tons), up 1 percent from disappearance during the comparable quarter a year ago. Of the June 1, 1982 total corn stored in all positions, 1.49 billion bushels or 39 percent were under Government control -- 264 million bushels were owned by the Commodity Credit Corporation and 1.23 billion bushels were held under farmer-owned reserve.

Sorghum stored in all positions on June 1, 1982 amounted to 380 million bushels (9.66 million metric tons), 106 percent more than a year earlier and 37 percent more than on June 1, 1980. Farm stocks totaled 93.1 million bushels (2.36 million metric tons), 82 percent more than last year. Off-farm holdings, at 287 million bushels (7.30 million metric tons), were up 115 percent. Disappearance from all storage positions during April and May 1982 was 81.5 million bushels (2.07 million metric tons), down 37 percent from the disappearance of 129 million bushels (3.28 million metric tons) during the same period last year. Of the June 1, 1982 total sorghum stocks, 262 million bushels were under Government control -- 37.4 million bushels were owned by the Commodity Credit Corporation and 224 million bushels were held in the farmer-owned reserve.

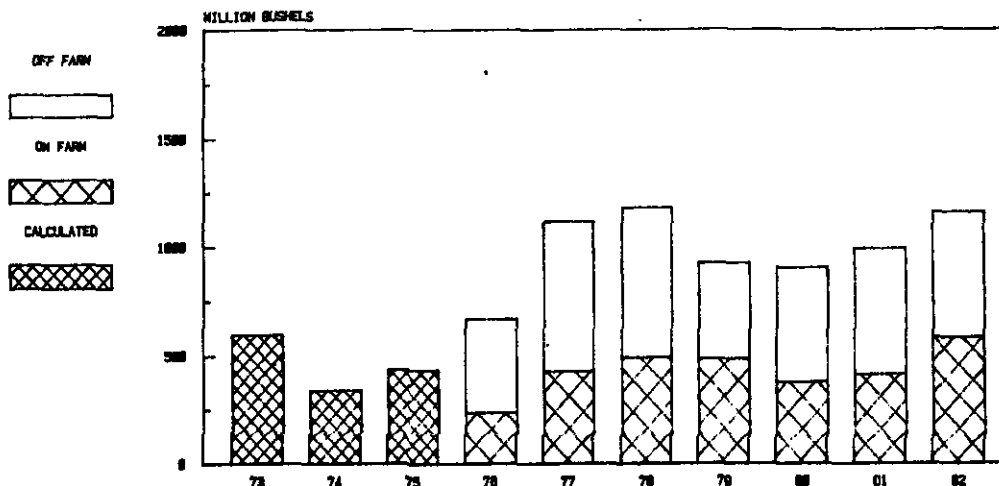

Old crop oat stocks in all storage positions on June 1, 1982 totaled 152 million bushels (2.20 million metric tons), 14 percent less than a year earlier and 36 percent less than on the same date in 1980. Farm stocks, at 127 million bushels (1.84 million metric tons), were 15 percent less than a year ago and off-farm stocks, at 24.6 million bushels (357 thousand metric tons), were 12 percent less than a year ago. Disappearance from all storage positions during April and May 1982 was 85.0 million bushels (1.23 million metric tons), 7 percent more than the disappearance for the same period last year. Of the June 1, 1982 total oat stocks, 700 thousand bushels were under Government control -- owned by the Commodity Credit Corporation. There were no oats held in the farmer-owned reserve.

Old crop barley stored in all positions on June 1, 1982 totaled 149 million bushels (3.24 million metric tons), 8 percent more than a year earlier, but 23 percent less than on the same date in 1980. Of the total barley stocks on hand June 1, 1982, 63 percent or 93.9 million bushels (2.05 million metric tons) was stored on farms. Farm stocks were 26 percent above the June 1 farm stocks a year ago. Off-farm stocks, at 54.7 million bushels (1.19 million metric tons), were down 13 percent from last year's level. Disappearance during April and May 1982 was 77.9 million bushels (1.70 million metric tons), 18 percent more than the corresponding period a year earlier. Of the total barley stocks on hand June 1, 1982, 25.8 million bushels were under Government control. This included 3.30 million bushels owned by the Commodity Credit Corporation and 22.5 million bushels held in the farmer-owned reserve.

Old crop wheat stored in all positions on June 1, 1982 totaled 1.16 billion bushels (31.5 million metric tons), 17 percent greater than the 989 million bushels (26.9 million metric tons) on hand a year earlier, and 28 percent more than two years ago. Farm stocks of 580 million bushels (15.8 million metric tons) accounted for 50 percent of the total stocks. In comparison, farm stocks last June 1 were 414 million bushels (11.3 million metric tons), accounting for 42 percent of the total. Off-farm stocks on June 1, 1982 totaled 579 million bushels (15.8 million metric tons), 1 percent more than last year's 574 million bushels (15.6 million metric tons). April-May disappearance this year was 398 million bushels (10.8 million metric tons) compared with 340 million bushels (9.25 million metric tons) during the comparable period last year. June 1981 - May 1982 disappearance totaled 2.62 billion bushels (71.4 million metric tons), 15 percent more than the 2.29 billion bushels (62.3 million metric tons) disappearance for a year earlier. Of the total June 1, 1982 old crop wheat stocks, 749 million bushels were under Government control. This total includes 187 million bushels owned by the Commodity Credit Corporation and 562 million bushels held in the farmer-owned reserve.

Old crop durum wheat stocks in all positions on June 1, 1982, at 107 million bushels (2.91 million metric tons), are 79 percent greater than last year's 59.9 million bushels (1.63 million metric tons) and 76 percent more than two years ago. Farm stocks of 90.5 million bushels (2.46 million metric tons) accounted for 85 percent of total stocks. A year ago, farm stocks totaled 45.2 million bushels (1.23 million metric tons) or 75 percent of total durum stocks. Off-farm stocks this June 1 totaled 16.5 million bushels (450 thousand metric tons), compared with 14.7 million bushels (401 thousand metric tons) a year earlier. April-May disappearance this year totaled 25.6 million bushels (696 thousand metric tons); last year, April-May disappearance was 23.3 million bushels (635 thousand metric tons). June 1981-May 1982 disappearance totaled 139 million bushels (3.78 million metric tons), 27 percent more than the 109 million bushels (2.98 million metric tons) disappearance during the comparable period a year earlier.

Old crop rye stocks in all storage positions on June 1, 1982 totaled 3.06 million bushels (77.8 thousand metric tons), down 26 percent from last year's 4.15 million bushels (105 thousand metric tons). Farm stocks accounted for 1.96 million bushels (49.7 thousand metric tons) and off-farm stocks totaled 1.10 million bushels (28.0 thousand metric tons). Disappearance from all storage facilities during April and May 1982 totaled 2.65 million bushels (67.4 thousand metric tons), compared with 2.72 million bushels (69.2 thousand metric tons) disappearance for the comparable period last year.

Soybean stocks in all positions June 1, 1982 totaled 658 million bushels (17.9 million metric tons), down 3 percent from a year ago, and 15 percent below June 1, 1980. Farm stocks of 367 million bushels (9.98 million metric tons) were 1 percent more than last June 1 but 8 percent below June 1, 1980. Off-farm stocks totaled 291 million bushels (7.93 million metric tons), down 8 percent from a year ago, and 23 percent below June 1, 1980.

The September-May utilization is indicated at 1.69 billion bushels (46.0 million metric tons), up 15 percent from the same period a year earlier. The April and May 1982 indicated disappearance totaled 393 million bushels (10.7 million metric tons), up 12 percent from disappearances during the comparable period a year earlier.

Old crop flaxseed stocks in all storage positions on June 1, 1982 totaled 2.02 million bushels (51.2 thousand metric tons), down 27 percent from June 1 stocks a year earlier and 60 percent below two years ago. Farm stocks, at 1.25 million bushels (31.8 thousand metric tons), were 6 percent above a year ago, while off-farm stocks, at 762 thousand bushels (19.4 thousand metric tons), were down 52 percent. Indicated disappearance during April-May 1982 was 1.54 million bushels (39.1 thousand metric tons), compared with 1.56 million bushels (39.7 thousand metric tons) for the same period a year earlier.
