CORN AND WHEAT STOCKS AT RECORD HIGH

Stocks of corn in all positions on October 1, 1982 totaled a record high 60.1 million metric tons, 129 percent more than last year. Stocks of feed grains (corn, sorghum, barley and oats), at 86.6 million metric tons, were 90 percent more than a year ago. Wheat stocks were at a record high 81.9 million metric tons, up 10 percent from last year.

OLD CROP CORN in all storage positions on October 1, 1982 totaled a record high 2.37 billion bushels (60.1 million metric tons), 129 percent more than last year's 1.03 billion bushels (26.3 million metric tons).

Of the total old crop corn stocks on October 1, 1982, 61 percent or 1.44 billion bushels (36.5 million metric tons) were stored on the farm. This is 193 percent more than the October 1 stocks a year ago. Off-farm stocks, at 929 million bushels (23.6 million metric tons), were up 71 percent from last year's level.

Disappearance during the June-September period was 1.49 billion bushels (37.8 million metric tons), down 15 percent from the comparable period a year ago. The marketing year disappearance (October 1, 1981 through September 30, 1982) was 6.87 billion bushels (174 million metric tons), down 5 percent from the corresponding period a year earlier.

Of the total October 1, 1982 corn stocks stored in all positions, 1.57 billion bushels were under Government control. Of this amount, 268 million bushels were owned by the Commodity Credit Corporation and 1.30 billion bushels were held under farmer-owned reserve.

OLD CROP SORGHUM in all positions on October 1, 1982 totaled 292 million bushels (7.42 million metric tons), 169 percent more than a year earlier. Farm stocks of 61.5 million bushels (1.56 million metric tons) were 108 percent above a year ago while off-farm holdings, at 231 million bushels (5.86 million metric tons), were up 192 percent from October 1, 1981. Disappearance during June through September from all storage positions totaled 87.7 million bushels (2.23 million metric tons), up 15 percent from the comparable period a year earlier. The marketing year disappearance (October 1, 1981 through September 30, 1982) was 697 million bushels (17.7 million metric tons), up 13 percent from the corresponding period a year earlier. Of the October 1, 1982 total sorghum stocks, 273 million bushels were under Government control -- 41.8 million bushels were owned by the Commodity Credit Corporation and nearly 232 million bushels were held in the farmer-owned reserve.

OATS stored in all positions on October 1, 1982 totaled 570 million bushels (8.27 million metric tons), up 24 percent from October 1, 1981. Farm stocks, at 475 million bushels (6.89 million metric tons), were 24 percent more than a year ago and off-farm holdings, at 95.2 million bushels (1.38 million metric tons), increased 29 percent from a year earlier. Usage during June-September was 181 million bushels (2.63 million metric tons), down 20 percent from the comparable period last year. Of the October 1, 1982 total oat stocks, 2.60 million bushels were under Government control -- 600 thousand bushels were owned by the Commodity Credit Corporation and 2.00 million bushels were held in the farmer-owned reserve.

BARLEY stocks in all positions on October 1, 1982 totaled 498 million bushels (10.8 million metric tons), 10 percent more than a year earlier. Stocks of barley stored on farms amounted to 350 million bushels (7.62 million metric tons) or 70 percent of the total stocks. Off-farm storages held 148 million bushels (3.21 million metric tons), on October 1, or 30 percent of the total stocks. On-farm stocks were up 16 percent from a year ago, while off-farm stocks were down fractionally. Disappearance during the June-September period was 168 million bushels (3.66 million metric tons), up 2 percent from the comparable period a year ago. Of the October 1, 1982 total barley stocks, 40.6 million bushels were under Government control. Of this amount, 3.60 million bushels were owned by the Commodity Credit Corporation and 37.0 million bushels were held in farmer-owned reserve.

ALL WHEAT stored in all positions on October 1, 1982 totaled a record high 3.01 billion bushels (81.9 million metric tons), 10 percent more than the 2.73 billion bushels (74.4 million metric tons) on hand a year earlier. Farm stocks of 1.43 billion bushels (39.0 million metric tons) accounted for 48 percent of the total. Wheat stored in off-farm storage facilities totaled 1.58 billion bushels (42.9 million metric tons) or 52 percent of the total stocks. On October 1 last year, farm stocks of all wheat totaled 1.20 billion bushels (32.8 million metric tons), and 1.53 billion bushels (41.6 million metric tons) were stored in off-farm facilities. Disappearance of all wheat during the June-September period totaled 963 million bushels (26.2 million metric tons) compared with 1.05 billion bushels (28.5 million metric tons) during the same period last year. All wheat stocks under Government control on October 1, 1982 totaled 1.03 billion bushels. Of this total, 850 million bushels were in the farmer-owned reserve and 180 million bushels were owned by the Commodity Credit Corporation.

DURUM WHEAT stocks in all positions on October 1, 1982 totaled 222 million bushels (6.04 million metric tons), 17 percent more than last year's 189 million bushels (5.15 million metric tons). Farm stocks accounted for 82 percent of the total or 181 million bushels (4.93 million metric tons). Off-farm stocks of 40.9 million bushels (1.11 million metric tons) accounted for the remaining 18 percent. On October 1, 1981, farm stocks totaled 148 million bushels (4.02 million metric tons) and off-farm stocks were 41.7 million bushels (1.13 million metric tons). Disappearance of durum wheat during the June-September period totaled 36.5 million bushels (992 thousand metric tons) compared with 56.6 million bushels (1.54 million metric tons) during the same period a year earlier.

RYE stocks in all storage positions on October 1, 1982 totaled 15.9 million bushels (404 thousand metric tons), 10 percent more than a year earlier. Rye stored on farms amounted to 11.3 million bushels (288 thousand metric tons) or 71 percent of the total. Rye stored in off-farm facilities totaled 4.56 million bushels (116 thousand metric tons). June-September disappearance of rye totaled 7.11 million bushels (187 thousand metric tons) compared with 8.31 million bushels (211 thousand metric tons) during the same period a year earlier.


FLAXSEED stocks in all positions on October 1, 1982 totaled 7.49 million bushels (190 thousand metric tons), up 16 percent from October 1 a year ago. Farm stocks, at 5.72 million bushels (145 thousand metric tons), were 25 percent larger than last year and off-farm stocks, at 1.77 million bushels (45.0 thousand metric tons), were down 7 percent from October 1, 1981. June-September indicated disappearance of flaxseed, at 6.27 million bushels (159 thousand metric tons), was 53 percent more than disappearance for the same period a year ago.

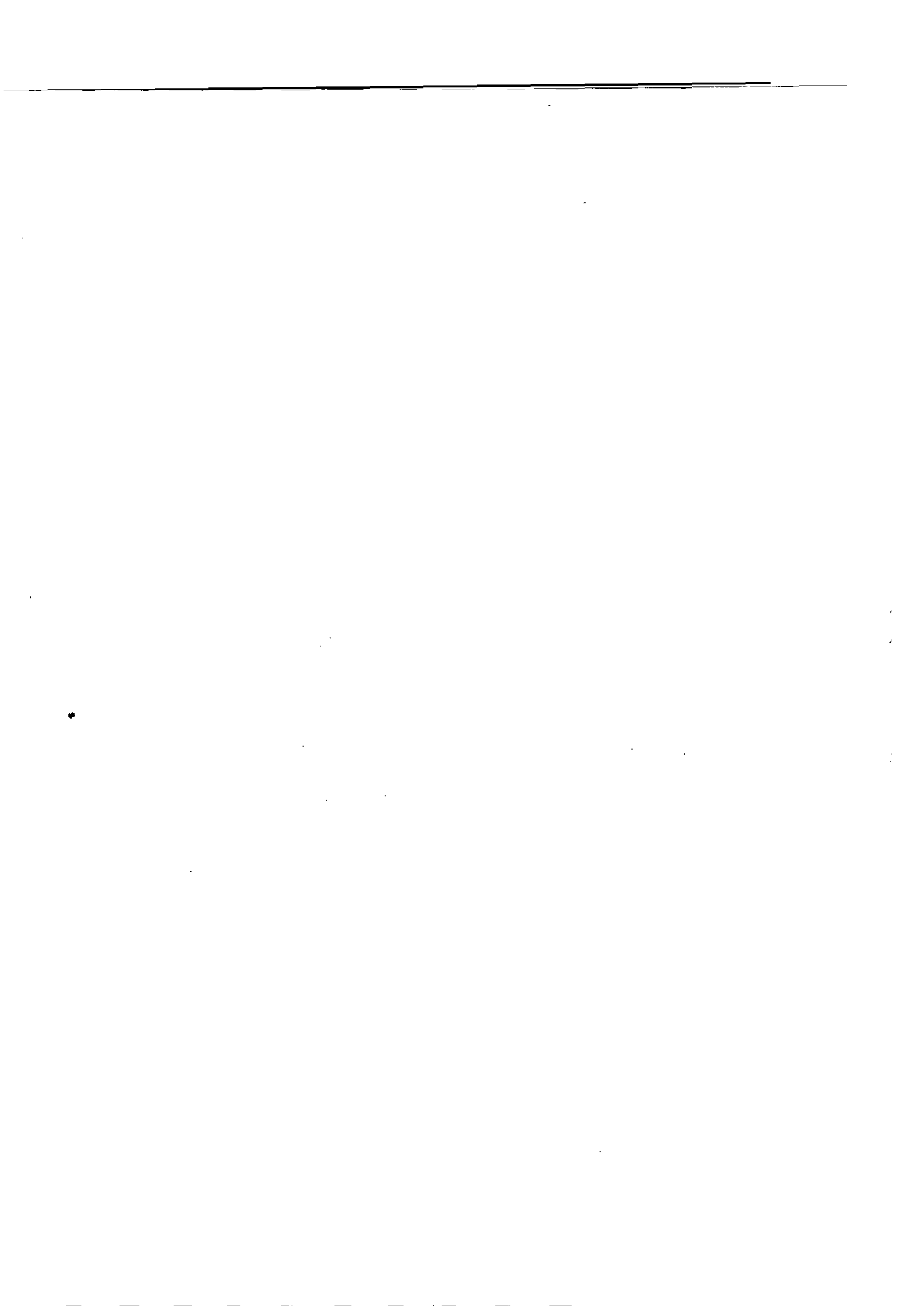
