CORN, WHEAT AND SOYBEAN STOCKS AT RECORD HIGH

Stocks of corn in all positions on January 1, 1983 are estimated at a record high 214 million metric tons, 21 percent more than on January 1, 1982. Stocks of feed grains (corn, sorghum, barley and oats), at 250 million metric tons, were 21 percent more than a year ago. Wheat stocks were a record high 68.6 million metric tons, up 16 percent from last year. Soybeans stocks--a record high 49.7 million metric tons--were up 12 percent from last year.

CORN store in all positions on January 1, 1983 is estimated at a record high 8.42 billion bushels (214 million metric tons), 21 percent more than last year's level of 6.97 billion bushels (177 million metric tons). Of the total corn on hand January 1, 1983, 73 percent, or 6.16 billion bushels (156 million metric tons), was stored on farms. This is 22 percent more than the January 1 farm stocks a year ago. Off-farm stocks, at 2.27 billion bushels (57.6 million metric tons), were up 17 percent from last year's level.

Indicated disappearance from all storage positions during October-December 1982 totaled 2.26 billion bushels (57.4 million metric tons), down fractionally from the comparable quarter a year ago.

Of the January 1, 1983 total corn stored in all positions, 2.36 billion bushels or 28 percent were under Government control -- 398 million bushels were owned by the Commodity Credit Corporation and 1.96 billion bushels were held under farmer-owned reserve.

SORGHUM in all storage positions on January 1, 1983 totaled 793 million bushels (20.1 million metric tons), 15 percent more than a year earlier and 71 percent above the same date in 1981. Farm stocks of 268 million bushels (6.80 million metric tons) were 4 percent above a year ago and off-farm holdings, at 525 million bushels (13.3 million metric tons), were up 21 percent from January 1, 1982. Indicated disappearance during October-December 1982 totaled 345 million bushels (8.76 million metric tons), up 16 percent from the comparable quarter a year ago. Of the January 1, 1983 total sorghum stocks, 418 million bushels were under government control -- 374 million bushels were held in the farmer-owned reserve and 44.6 million bushels were owned by the Commodity Credit Corporation.

OATS in all storage positions on January 1, 1983 totaled 474 million bushels (6.87 million metric tons), up 30 percent from a year ago and 21 percent above January 1, 1981. Farm stocks amounted to 398 million bushels (5.78 million metric tons), 27 percent more than a year earlier. Off-farm holdings totaled 75.7 million bushels (1.10 million metric tons), up 48 percent from January 1, 1982. Indicated disappearance from all storage positions during October-December 1982 totaled 108 million bushels (1.56 million metric tons), up 15 percent from the comparable period last year. Of the January 1, 1983 total oat stocks, 4.30 million bushels were under government control -- 600 thousand bushels were owned by the Commodity Credit Corporation and 3.70 million bushels were held in the farmer-owned reserve.

BARLEY stored in all positions on January 1, 1983 totaled 419 million bushels (9.12 million metric tons), 26 percent more than a year earlier. Stocks of barley stored on farms amounted to 294 million bushels (6.40 million metric tons) or 70 percent of the total stocks. Off-farm storages held 125 million bushels (2.72 million metric tons) on January 1, or 30 percent of the total stocks. On-farm stocks were up 27 percent and off-farm were up 22 percent from January 1, 1982. Indicated disappearance during the October-December 1982 period was 82.7 million bushels (1.80 million metric tons), 30 percent less than the corresponding period a year earlier. Of the January 1, 1983 total barley stocks, 70.2 million bushels were under government control -- 4.30 million bushels were owned by the Commodity Credit Corporation and 65.9 million bushels were held in the farmer-owned reserve.

ALL WHEAT stored in all positions on January 1, 1983 totaled a record high 2.52 billion bushels (68.6 million metric tons), 16 percent more than last year's 2.18 billion bushels (59.3 million metric tons) and 32 percent more than January 1, 1981. Farm stocks amounted to 1.17 billion bushels (31.8 million metric tons) or 46 percent of the total January 1, 1983 wheat stocks. Farm stocks on January 1, 1982 were 956 million bushels (26.0 million metric tons) or 44 percent of the total stocks. Off-farm stocks on January 1, 1983 totaled 1.35 billion bushels (36.8 million metric tons), 11 percent more than the January 1, 1982 total of 1.22 billion bushels (33.3 million metric tons). Indicated disappearance during the October-December 1982 quarter totaled 466 million bushels (12.7 million metric tons). Disappearance for the comparable period a year ago was 557 million bushels (15.2 million metric tons). Wheat under government control on January 1, 1983 totaled 1.19 billion bushels--1.01 billion bushels held in the farmer-owned reserve and 179 million bushels were owned by the Commodity Credit Corporation.

DURUM WHEAT stored in all positions on January 1, 1983 totaled a record high 189 million bushels (5.14 million metric tons), 24 percent more than last year's 152 million bushels (4.15 million metric tons) and 83 percent more than January 1, 1981. Farm stocks of 156 million bushels (4.24 million metric tons), are 28 percent more than last year's 121 million bushels (3.30 million metric tons). Farm stocks on January 1, 1983 accounted for 83 percent of the total stocks compared with 80 percent a year ago. Off-farm stocks of 33.0 million bushels (898 thousand metric tons), are 6 percent more than last year's 31.0 million bushels (845 thousand metric tons). Disappearance during the October-December 1982 quarter totaled 28.9 million bushels (786 thousand metric tons), down 22 percent from the 36.8 million bushels (1.00 million metric tons) during the comparable period a year earlier.

RYE stored in all positions on January 1, 1983 totaled 10.9 million bushels (276 thousand metric tons), 38 percent more than last year's 7.88 million bushels (200 thousand metric tons). Farm stocks of 7.66 million bushels (195 thousand metric tons) accounted for 70 percent of total rye stocks. Last year, 5.71 million bushels (145 thousand metric tons) or 72 percent of total rye stocks were on farms. January 1, 1983 off-farm rye stocks totaled 3.21 million bushels (81.5 thousand metric tons) compared with last year's 2.17 million bushels (55.2 thousand metric tons). Indicated disappearance during the October-December 1982 quarter was 5.59 million bushels (142 thousand metric tons) compared with 6.67 million bushels (169 thousand metric tons) during the corresponding period a year earlier.

SOYBEANS in all storage positions on January 1, 1983 are estimated at a record high 1.83 billion bushels (49.7 million metric tons), up 12 percent from a year ago. Farm stocks of 1.07 billion bushels (29.2 million metric tons) were up 21 percent. Off-farm stocks, at 752 million bushels (20.5 million metric tons), were up 1 percent from January 1, 1982.

The September-December 1982 indicated disappearance, based on supply and January 1 stocks, was 717 million bushels (19.5 million metric tons), up 4 percent from the 687 million bushels (18.7 million metric tons) during the same period a year ago.

FLAXSEED stocks in all positions on January 1, 1983 totaled 5.51 million bushels (140 thousand metric tons), up 8 percent from January 1 stocks a year earlier but 16 percent less than two years ago. Farm stocks, at 4.31 million bushels (109 thousand metric tons) were up 33 percent from a year ago, while off-farm stocks, at 1.20 million bushels (30.5 thousand metric tons), were down 36 percent from a year ago. Indicated disappearance during October-December 1982 was 1.91 million bushels (48.6 thousand metric tons) compared with 1.38 million bushels (35.1 thousand metric tons) in the same three month period a year ago.

OFF-FARM GRAIN STORAGE CAPACITY

Capacity of off-farm commercial grain storage in the Nation totaled 7.86 billion bushels on January 1, 1983. This is an increase of 8 percent from a year earlier. Expansion of capacity occurred during the year in 31 States and New England, while 11 States registered declines.

Illinois, ranked number one in total storage capacity, followed by Iowa, Kansas, Texas, and Nebraska. These top five States together accounted for 53 percent of the Nation's off-farm grain storage capacity.

States making sizeable additions to capacity during 1982 included: Iowa--136 million bushels, Illinois--114 million bushels, Nebraska--118 million bushels, and Texas--62 million bushels.

State capacity data include all elevators, warehouses, terminals, merchant mills, other storages, and oilseed crushers which store grain, soybeans, or flaxseed. Capacity data exclude warehouses used to store only rice or peanuts, oilseed crushers processing only cottonseed or peanuts, tobacco warehouses, seed warehouses, and storages that handle only dry edible beans or dry edible peas.

NUMBER OF OFF-FARM GRAIN STORAGE FACILITIES

There were an estimated 14,544 off-farm grain storage facilities in operation on January 1, 1983, a decline of 147 from a year earlier. States with the largest number of facilities this year include: Illinois -- 1108, Iowa -- 1024, Texas -- 967, Kansas -- 862, and Minnesota -- 841.

Data users are advised that some differences exist between States in the procedure for making counts of facilities in the grain storage universe. In a few instances, the count includes only the headquarters which reports for more than one facility. This does not affect data on total capacity.
