CORN, WHEAT AND SOYBEAN STOCKS AT A RECORD HIGH

Stocks of corn in all positions on April 1, 1983 are estimated at a record high 162 million metric tons, 24 percent more than on April 1, 1982. Stocks of feed grains (corn, sorghum, barley, and oats), at 189 million metric tons, were 25 percent more than a year ago. Wheat stocks were a record high 50.9 million metric tons, up 20 percent from last year. Soybean stocks were also a record high -- 32.6 million metric tons, up 15 percent from a year earlier.

CORN stored in all positions on April 1, 1983 totaled a record high 6.36 billion bushels (162 million metric tons), 24 percent more than last year's level of 5.13 billion bushels (130 million metric tons). Of the total corn on hand April 1, 1983, 69 percent or 4.41 billion bushels (112 million metric tons) were stored on farms. Farm stocks were 22 percent greater than April 1, 1982 farm stocks. Off-farm stocks, at 1.95 billion bushels (49.6 million metric tons), were up 30 percent from last year's level.

Indicated disappearance from all storage positions during January-March 1983 totaled 2.06 billion bushels (52.4 million metric tons), up 12 percent from disappearance during the comparable quarter a year ago.

Of the April 1, 1983 total corn stored in all positions, 3.17 billion bushels or 50 percent were under Government control -- 472 million bushels were owned by the Commodity Credit Corporation and 2.70 billion bushels were held under farmer-owned reserve.

SORGHUM in all storage positions on April 1, 1983 totaled 618 million bushels (15.7 million metric tons), 34 percent more than last year's level of 462 million bushels (11.7 million metric tons). Of the total sorghum stocks on hand April 1, 1983, 24 percent, or 149 million bushels (3.78 million metric tons), were stored on farms. This is 19 percent more than the April 1 farm stocks a year ago. Off-farm stocks, at 470 million bushels (11.9 million metric tons), were up 40 percent from last year's level. Indicated disappearance during January-March 1983 totaled 191 million bushels (4.84 million metric tons), down 16 percent from the comparable quarter a year ago. Of the April 1, 1983 total sorghum stocks, 507 million bushels were under government control -- 460 million bushels were held in the farmer-owned reserve and 46.6 million bushels were owned by the Commodity Credit Corporation.

OATS stored in all positions on April 1, 1983 amounted to 332 million bushels (4.83 million metric tons), 40 percent more than a year earlier. Farm holdings totaled 273 million bushels (3.96 million metric tons), 36 percent more than a year earlier. Off-farm stocks amounted to 60.0 million bushels (870 thousand metric tons), 65 percent more than the stocks on hand April 1, 1982. Indicated disappearance during January-March 1983 totaled 141 million bushels (2.05 million metric tons), up 10 percent from the comparable quarter a year ago. Of the April 1, 1983 total oat stocks, 5.30 million bushels were under Government control -- 700 thousand bushels were owned by the Commodity Credit Corporation and 4.60 million bushels were held in the farmer-owned reserve.

BARLEY stored in all positions on April 1, 1983 totaled 297 million bushels (6.46 million metric tons), 31 percent more than last year's 227 million bushels (4.94 million metric tons). Of the barley stocks on hand April 1, 1983, two-thirds, or 198 million bushels (4.32 million metric tons), were stored on farms. Farm stocks were 35 percent above April 1, 1982. Off-farm stocks, at 98.3 million bushels (2.14 million metric tons) were up 24 percent from last year's level. Indicated disappearance during January-March 1983 was 121 million bushels (2.64 million metric tons), up 14 percent from the corresponding period a year earlier. Of the April 1, 1983 total barley stocks, 95.3 million bushels were under Government control. This included 5.50 million bushels owned by the Commodity Credit Corporation and 89.8 million bushels held in the farmer-owned reserve.

ALL WHEAT stored in all positions on April 1, 1983 totaled a record high 1.87 billion bushels (50.9 million metric tons), 20 percent more than last year's 1.56 billion bushels (42.4 million metric tons) and 41 percent more than April 1, 1981. Farm stocks, at 47 percent of the total, amounted to 884 million bushels (24.1 million metric tons), up 18 percent from a year ago. Off-farm stocks totaled 984 million bushels (26.8 million metric tons), 22 percent more than the April 1, 1982 total of 809 million bushels (22.0 million metric tons). Indicated disappearance from all positions during the January-March 1983 quarter totaled 652 million bushels (17.7 million metric tons). Disappearance for the comparable period a year earlier was 621 million bushels (16.9 million metric tons). Wheat stocks under Government control on April 1, 1983 totaled 1.28 billion bushels -- 1.10 billion bushels held in the farmer-owned reserve and 182 million bushels were owned by the Commodity Credit Corporation.

DURUM WHEAT stored in all positions on April 1, 1983 totaled a record high 164 million bushels (4.47 million metric tons), 24 percent more than last year's 133 million bushels (3.61 million metric tons) and 97 percent more than April 1, 1981. Farm stocks of 130 million bushels (3.54 million metric tons) were 23 percent more than last year's 106 million bushels (2.88 million metric tons). Farm stocks accounted for 79 percent of the total April 1, 1983 stocks compared with 80 percent a year ago. Off-farm stocks of 34.0 million bushels (925 thousand metric tons) were 26 percent more than last year's 26.9 million bushels (733 thousand metric tons). Indicated disappearance during the January-March 1983 quarter totaled 25.1 million bushels (682 thousand metric tons), up 27 percent from the 19.8 million bushels (538 thousand metric tons) during the comparable period a year earlier.

RYE stored in all positions on April 1, 1983 totaled 7.96 million bushels (202 thousand metric tons), 38 percent more than last year's 5.79 million bushels (147 thousand metric tons). Farm stocks of 5.43 million bushels (138 thousand metric tons) accounted for 68 percent of total rye stocks. Last year, 3.37 million bushels (85.7 thousand metric tons) or 58 percent of total rye stocks were on farms. April 1, 1983 off-farm rye stocks totaled 2.53 million bushels (64.2 thousand metric tons) compared with last year's 2.41 million bushels (61.3 thousand metric tons). Indicated disappearance during the January-March 1983 quarter was 2.91 million bushels (73.8 thousand metric tons) compared with 2.10 million bushels (53.3 thousand metric tons) during the corresponding period a year earlier.

SOYBEANS in all positions April 1, 1983 totaled a record high 1.20 billion bushels (32.6 million metric tons), up 15 percent from a year ago and 16 percent more than April 1, 1981. Farm stocks of 695 million bushels (18.9 million metric tons) were 20 percent above April 1, 1982. Off-farm stocks totaled 502 million bushels (13.7 million metric tons), up 9 percent from April 1, a year earlier.

The January-March indicated disappearance was 630 million bushels (17.1 million metric tons), up 7 percent from disappearance during the comparable quarter a year earlier.

The September-March indicated disappearance was 1.35 billion bushels (36.6 million metric tons), up 5 percent from disappearance for the same period a year ago.

FLAXSEED stocks in all positions on April 1, 1983 totaled 4.69 million bushels (119 thousand metric tons), up 32 percent from April 1 stocks a year ago and 8 percent more than on the same date two years ago. Farm stocks, at 2.89 million bushels (73.4 thousand metric tons), were up 42 percent from a year earlier while off-farm stocks, at 1.80 million bushels (45.7 thousand metric tons), were up 18 percent. Indicated disappearance during January-March 1983 was 1.77 million bushels (44.9 thousand metric tons) compared with 1.54 million bushels (39.1 thousand metric tons) during the same period a year earlier.
