FEED GRAINS, SOYBEANS AND WHEAT AT RECORD HIGHS

According to the Crop Reporting Board, stocks of the four feed grains (corn, sorghum, oats and barley) totaled 151 million metric tons on June 1, 1983, 32 percent greater than the total a year earlier. Corn stocks at the beginning of June 1983 totaled a record high 129 million metric tons, up 30 percent from the previous high set last year. In addition to the increase shown in corn, sorghum was up 39 percent; barley, up 49 percent; and oats, up 51 percent. Soybean stocks, were a record high 23.6 million metric tons, up 33 percent from a year earlier. Wheat stocks are also at a record high 41.9 million metric tons, up 32 percent from last year.

Corn stored in all positions on June 1, 1983 totaled a record high 5.08 billion bushels (129 million metric tons), 30 percent more than last year's level of 3.90 billion bushels (99.2 million metric tons). Of the total corn on hand June 1, 1983, 64 percent, or 3.25 billion bushels (82.6 million metric tons), was stored on farms. Farm stocks were 18 percent greater than June 1, 1982 farm stocks. Off-farm stocks, at 1.83 billion bushels (46.5 million metric tons), were up 60 percent from last year's level.

Indicated disappearance from all storage positions during April-May 1983 totaled 1.28 billion bushels (32.6 million metric tons), up 5 percent from disappearance during the comparable quarter a year ago.

Of the June 1, 1983 total corn stored in all positions, 3.21 billion bushels, or 63 percent, were under Government control -- 483 million bushels were owned by the Commodity Credit Corporation and 2.73 billion bushels were held under the farmer-owned reserve.

Sorghum stored in all positions on June 1, 1983 amounted to 530 million bushels (13.5 million metric tons), 39 percent more than a year earlier. Farm stocks totaled 94.9 million bushels (2.41 million metric tons), 2 percent more than last year. Off-farm holdings, at 435 million bushels (11.0 million metric tons), were up 52 percent. Indicated disappearance from all storage positions during April and May 1983 was 90.7 million bushels (2.30 million metric tons), up from the 82.1 million bushels (2.08 million metric tons) during the same period last year. Of the June 1, 1983 total sorghum stocks, 508 million bushels were under Government control -- 53.9 million bushels were owned by the Commodity Credit Corporation and 454 million bushels were held in the farmer-owned reserve.

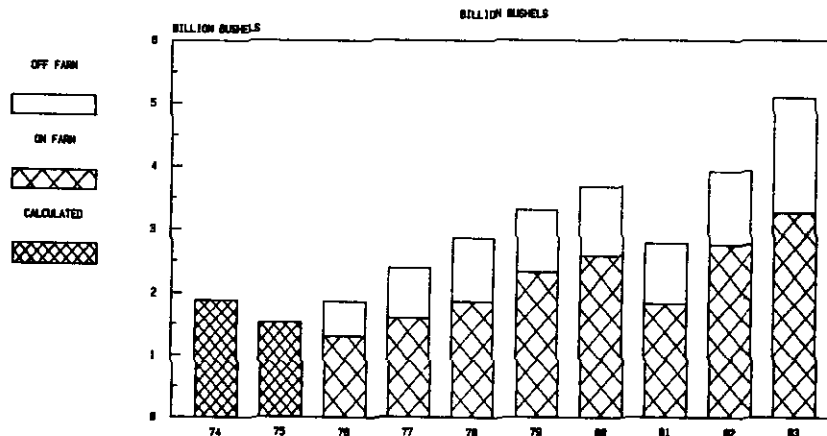
Sorghum stored in all positions on June 1, 1983 amounted to 530 million bushels (13.5 million metric tons), 39 percent more than a year earlier. Farm stocks totaled 94.9 million bushels (2.41 million metric tons), 2 percent more than last year. Off-farm holdings, at 435 million bushels (11.0 million metric tons), were up 52 percent. Indicated disappearance from all storage positions during April and May 1983 was 90.7 million bushels (2.30 million metric tons), up from the 82.1 million bushels (2.08 million metric tons) during the same period last year. Of the June 1, 1983 total sorghum stocks, 508 million bushels were under Government control -- 53.9 million bushels were owned by the Commodity Credit Corporation and 454 million bushels were held in the farmer-owned reserve.

Old crop oats stored in all positions on June 1, 1983 totaled 229 million bushels (3.33 million metric tons), 51 percent more than a year earlier and 30 percent greater than June 1, 1981. Farm holdings totaled 191 million bushels (2.77 million metric tons), 50 percent more than a year earlier. Off-farm stocks amounted to 38.5 million bushels (559 thousand metric tons), 55 percent more than the stocks on hand June 1, 1982. Indicated disappearance during April-May 1983 totaled 103 million bushels (1.50 million metric tons), up 22 percent from the comparable quarter a year ago. Larger quantities were used for seed than a year ago. Of the June 1, 1983 total oat stocks, 5.90 million bushels were under Government control -- 700 thousand bushels were owned by the Commodity Credit Corporation and 5.20 million bushels were held in the farmer-owned reserve.

Old crop barley stored in all positions on June 1, 1983 totaled 223 million bushels (4.85 million metric tons), 49 percent more than a year ago and 62 percent greater than on the same date in 1981. Of the total barley stocks on hand June 1, 1983, 64 percent, or 143 million bushels (3.11 million metric tons), was stored on farms. Farm stocks were 52 percent above the June 1 farm stocks a year ago. Off-farm stocks, at 79.7 million bushels (1.74 million metric tons) were up 43 percent from last year's level. Indicated disappearance during April and May 1983 was 74.1 million bushels (1.61 million metric tons), 4 percent less than the corresponding period a year earlier. Of the June 1, 1983 total barley stocks, 104 million bushels were under Government control. This included 5.50 million bushels owned by the Commodity Credit Corporation and 98.4 million bushels held in the farmer-owned reserve.

Old crop rye stocks in all storage positions on June 1, 1983 totaled 6.41 million bushels (163 thousand metric tons), more than double last year's 3.10 million bushels (78.6 thousand metric tons). Farm stocks accounted for 4.13 million bushels (105 thousand metric tons) and off-farm stocks totaled 2.28 million bushels (58.0 thousand metric tons). Indicated disappearance from all storage facilities during April and May 1983 totaled 1.55 million bushels (39.4 thousand metric tons), compared with 2.69 million bushels (68.3 thousand metric tons) disappearance for the comparable period last year.

Old crop wheat stored in all positions on June 1, 1983 totaled a record high 7.54 billion bushels (41.9 million metric tons), 32 percent greater than the 1.16 billion bushels (31.7 million metric tons) on hand a year earlier, and 56 percent more than two years ago. Farm stocks of 695 million bushels (18.9 million metric tons) accounted for 45 percent of the total stocks. In comparison, farm stocks last June 1 were 581 million bushels (15.8 million metric tons), accounting for 50 percent of the total. Off-farm stocks on June 1, 1983 totaled 847 million bushels (23.0 million metric tons), 45 percent more than last year's 583 million bushels (15.9 million metric tons). Indicated April-May disappearance this year totaled 336 million bushels (9.14 million metric tons) compared with 393 million bushels (10.7 million metric tons) during the comparable period last year. June 1982-May 1983 disappearance totaled 2.43 billion bushels (66.2 million metric tons), 7 percent less than the 2.62 billion bushel (71.4 million metric tons) disappearance for a year earlier. Of the total June 1, 1983 old crop wheat stocks, 1.24 billion bushels were under Government control. This total includes 181 million bushels owned by the Commodity Credit Corporation and 1.06 billion bushels held in the farmer-owned reserve.

Old crop durum wheat stocks in all positions on June 1, 1983 totaled a record high 142 million bushels (3.87 million metric tons), 32 percent greater than last year's 108 million bushels (2.93 million metric tons) and more than double the 59.9 million bushels (1.63 million metric tons) two years ago. Farm stocks of 117 million bushels (3.19 million metric tons) accounted for 82 percent of total stocks. A year ago, farm stocks totaled 90.5 million bushels (2.46 million metric tons) or 84 percent of total durum stocks. Off-farm stocks on June 1, 1983 totaled 25.2 million bushels (686 thousand metric tons), compared with 17.1 million bushels (467 thousand metric tons) a year earlier. Indicated April-May 1983 disappearance totaled 21.9 million bushels (595 thousand metric tons); last year, April-May disappearance totaled 25.0 million bushels (679 thousand metric tons). June 1982-May 1983 disappearance totaled 113 million bushels (3.07 million metric tons), 18 percent less than the 138 million bushels (3.76 million metric tons) disappearance during the comparable period a year earlier.

Old crop rye stocks in all storage positions on June 1, 1983 totaled 6.41 million bushels (163 thousand metric tons), more than double last year's 3.10 million bushels (78.6 thousand metric tons). Farm stocks accounted for 4.13 million bushels (105 thousand metric tons) and off-farm stocks totaled 2.28 million bushels (58.0 thousand metric tons). Indicated disappearance from all storage facilities during April and May 1983 totaled 1.55 million bushels (39.4 thousand metric tons), compared with 2.69 million bushels (68.3 thousand metric tons) disappearance for the comparable period last year.

Soybean stocks in all positions June 1, 1983 totaled a record high 867 million bushels (23.6 million metric tons), up 33 percent from a year ago, and 28 percent above June 1, 1981. Farm stocks of 476 million bushels (12.9 million metric tons) were 32 percent more than June 1, 1982. Off-farm stocks totaled 391 million bushels (10.6 million metric tons), up 34 percent from a year ago.

The September-May utilization is indicated at 1.68 billion bushels (45.6 million metric tons), up 1 percent from the same period a year earlier. The April-May 1983 indicated disappearance totaled 325 million bushels (8.65 million metric tons), down 16 percent from disappearance during the comparable period a year earlier.

Old crop flaxseed stocks in all storage positions on June 1, 1983 totaled 2.86 million bushels (72.6 thousand metric tons), up 41 percent from June 1 stocks a year earlier and 3 percent above two years ago. Farm stocks, at 2.21 million bushels (56.2 thousand metric tons), were 76 percent above a year ago, while off-farm stocks, at 647 thousand bushels (16.4 thousand metric tons), were down 17 percent. Indicated disappearance during April-May 1983 was 1.83 million bushels (46.5 thousand metric tons), compared with 1.53 million bushels (38.8 thousand metric tons) for the same period a year earlier.
