SOYBEAN STOCKS

SOYBEANS: The September 1, 1983 carryover of old crop soybeans into the 1983-84 marketing year totaled a record 387 million bushels (10.5 million metric tons), 45 percent above last year and 8 percent above the previous record carryover of September 1, 1980. Soybeans stored on-farm totaled 150 million bushels (4.07 million metric tons), up 15 percent from last year but 6 percent below two years ago. On-farm stocks accounted for 39 percent of the soybeans stored in all positions. Off-farm stocks, at 237 million bushels (6.45 million metric tons), were up 74 percent from last year and 49 percent above two years ago.

As indicated by year-end stocks, disappearance during the marketing year (September 1982-August 1983) totaled 2.16 billion bushels (58.7 million metric tons), 5 percent above last year. Indicated disappearance during June-August 1983 totaled 481 million bushels (13.1 million metric tons), 24 percent more than during the same period last year. The historic relationship of the calculated stocks and reported stocks on September 1 would indicate that the 1982 production may be about 2 percent too high. Final revisions of the 1982 national and State production estimates will be published in the October 1983 Crop Production report.
