CORN STOCKS AT RECORD HIGH

Stocks of old crop corn in all positions on October 1, 1983 totaled a record high 79.8 million metric tons, 37 percent more than last year. Stocks of feed grains (corn, sorghum, oats and barley), at 109 million metric tons, were 28 percent more than a year ago. Wheat stocks totaled 80.4 million metric tons, down 1 percent from last year.

OLD CROP CORN in all positions on October 1, 1983 totaled a record high 3.14 billion bushels (79.8 million metric tons), 37 percent above last year's level of 2.29 billion bushels (58.1 million metric tons).

Of the total corn stocks on October 1, 1983, 49 percent or 1.54 billion bushels (39.0 million metric tons) were stored on the farm. This is 13 percent more than the October 1 farm stocks a year ago. Off-farm stocks, at 1.60 billion bushels (40.7 million metric tons) were up 72 percent from last year's level.

Indicated disappearance during the June-September period was 1.94 billion bushels (49.3 million metric tons), up 20 percent from the comparable period a year ago. The marketing year disappearance (October 1, 1982 through September 30, 1983) was 7.54 billion bushels (192 million metric tons), up 9 percent from the corresponding period a year ago.

OLD CROP SORGHUM in all positions on October 1, 1983 totaled 399 million bushels (10.1 million metric tons), 35 percent more than a year earlier. Farm stocks totaled 58.7 million bushels (1.49 million metric tons), 5 percent less than a year earlier. Off-farm holdings, at 340 million bushels (8.64 million metric tons), were up 45 percent from a year earlier. Disappearance from all storage positions during June through September was 129 million bushels (3.28 million metric tons), up 55 percent from the disappearance during the same period a year earlier.

OATS stored in all positions on October 1, 1983 totaled 502 million bushels (7.29 million metric tons), down 14 percent from October 1, 1982. Farm stocks, at 423 million bushels (6.14 million metric tons), were 13 percent less than a year ago, and off-farm holdings, at 79.2 million bushels (1.15 million metric tons), declined 17 percent from a year earlier. Indicated usage during June-September was 199 million bushels (2.89 million metric tons), up 6 percent from the comparable period last year.

BARLEY stored in all positions on October 1, 1983 totaled 525 million bushels (11.4 million metric tons), 5 percent more than a year ago and 16 percent greater than on the same date in 1981. Of the total barley stocks on hand October 1, 1983, 67 percent or 351 million bushels (7.64 million metric tons), was stored on farms. Farm stocks were 1 percent below a year ago. Off-farm stocks, at 174 million bushels (3.78 million metric tons), were up 17 percent from last year's level. Indicated disappearance during June-September 1983 was 230 million bushels (5.00 million metric tons), 35 percent more the corresponding period a year ago.

ALL WHEAT stored in all positions on October 1, 1983 totaled 2.95 billion bushels (80.4 million metric tons), 1 percent below the 2.99 billion bushels (81.3 million metric tons) on hand a year earlier. Farm stocks of 1.24 billion bushels (33.7 million metric tons) accounted for 42 percent of the total. Wheat stored off-farms totaled 1.71 billion bushels (46.7 million metric tons). On October 1, 1982 farm stocks of all wheat totaled 1.42 billion bushels (38.7 million metric tons), and 1.57 billion bushels (42.6 million metric tons), were stored in off-farm facilities. Indicated disappearance of all wheat during the June-September period totaled 998 million bushels (27.2 million metric tons) compared with 986 million bushels (26.8 million metric tons) during the same period a year ago.

DURUM WHEAT stocks in all positions October 1, 1983 totaled 170 million bushels (4.63 million metric tons), down 22 percent from last year's 218 million bushels (5.93 million metric tons). Farm stocks accounted for 73 percent of the total, or 124 million bushels (3.36 million metric tons). Off-farm stocks totaled 46.5 million bushels (1.27 million metric tons). Last October 1, farm stocks stood at 177 million bushels (4.81 million metric tons) and off-farm stocks were 41.0 million bushels (1.12 million metric tons). Indicated disappearance of durum wheat during June-September totaled 44.6 million bushels (1.21 million metric tons) compared with 37.4 million bushels (1.02 million metric tons) during the same period in 1982.

SUNFLOWER: The October 1, 1983 carryover of old crop sunflower into the 1983-84 marketing year totaled 419 million pounds (190 thousand metric tons).
