## CORN, WHEAT AND SOYBEAN STOCKS DOWN SHARPLY

Stocks of corn in all positions on January 1, 1984 are estimated at 125 million metric tons, 41 percent less than on January 1, 1983. Stocks of feed grains (corn, sorghum, barley and oats), at 155 million metric tons, were 37 percent less than a year ago. Wheat stocks are estimated at 63.3 million metric tons, down 8 percent from last year's record high. Soybean stocks, at 35.1 million metric tons, were down 28 percent from last year.

CORN stored in all positions on January 1, 1984 is estimated at 4.93 billion bushels (125 million metric tons), 41 percent less than last year's record high 8.28 billion bushels (210 million metric tons). Of the total corn on hand January 1, 1984, 63 percent, or 3.10 billion bushels (78.7 million metric tons), was stored on farms. This is 48 percent less than the January 1 farm stocks a year ago. Off-farm stocks, at 1.83 billion bushels (46.5 million metric tons), were down 19 percent from last year's level.

Indicated disappearance from all storage positions during October-December 1983 totaled 2.42 billion bushels (61.4 million metric tons), up 7 percent from the comparable quarter a year ago.

SORGHUM in all storage positions on January 1, 1984 totaled 651 million bushels (16.5 million metric tons), 20 percent less than January 1 a year earlier and 6 percent less than the same date in 1982. On farm stocks of 148 million bushels (3.75 million metric tons), 45 percent less than January 1 last year. Off-farm holdings, at 503 million bushels (12.8 million metric tons), were down 7 percent. Indicated disappearance from all storage positions during October-December 1983 was 231 million bushels (5.88 million metric tons), 29 percent less than disappearance during the same period a year earlier.

OATS in all storage positions on January 1, 1984, totaled 378 million bushels (5.49 million metric tons), down 20 percent from a year ago, but up 4 percent from January 1, 1982. On farm stocks totaled 322 million bushels (4.68 million metric tons), down 19 percent from a year earlier. Off-farm stocks amounted to 56.0 million bushels (813 thousand metric tons), 26 percent less than the stocks on hand January 1, 1983. Indicated disappearance during October-December 1983 totaled 127 million bushels (1.84 million metric tons), up 17 percent from the comparable quarter a year ago.

BARLEY stored in all positions on January 1, 1984, totaled 378 million bushels (8.23 million metric tons), 10 percent less than last year's 418 million bushels (9.10 million metric tons). Stocks of barley stored on farms amounted to 257 million bushels (5.59 million metric tons), or 68 percent of the total stocks. Off farm storages held 121 million bushels (2.64 million metric tons) on January 1, or 32 percent of the total stocks. On farm stocks were down 13 percent and off farm stocks were down 2 percent from January 1, 1983. Indicated disappearance during the October-December 1983 period was 138 million bushels (3.00 million metric tons), 66 percent more than the corresponding period a year ago.

ALL WHEAT stored in all positions January 1, 1984 totaled 2.32 billion bushels (63.3 million metric tons), 8 percent less than last year's record 2.52 billion bushels (68.6 million metric tons), but 7 percent more than January 1, 1982. Farm stocks amounted to 1.01 billion bushels (27.5 million metric tons), down 13 percent from a year ago, and 43 percent of all stocks. Off-farm stocks, at 1.31 billion bushels (35.8 million metric tons), were off 3 percent from January 1, 1983. Indicated disappearance during October-December 1983 is 642 million bushels (17.5 million metric tons). Disappearance for the comparable period in 1982 was 467 million bushels (12.7 million metric tons).


DURUM WHEAT stored in all positions on January 1, 1984 totaled 133 million bushels (3.61 million metric tons), down 30 percent from last year's record high 189 million bushels (5.15 million metric tons) and 13 percent less than January 1, 1982. Farm stocks of 97.8 million bushels (2.66 million metric tons) are 37 percent below the 156 million bushels (4.24 million metric tons) on hand January 1, 1983. Off-farm stocks of 35.0 million bushels (951 thousand metric tons), are 5 percent more than last year's 33.3 million bushels (905 thousand metric tons). Indicated disappearance during the last quarter of 1983 totaled 40.1 million bushels (1.09 million metric tons), up 40 percent from the 28.6 million bushels (779 thousand metric tons) recorded during the comparable period in 1982.

SOYBEANS in all storage positions on January 1, 1984 totaled 1.29 billion bushels (35.1 million metric tons), down 28 percent from a year ago. Farm stocks of 631 million bushels (17.2 million metric tons), were down 40 percent. Off-farm stocks, at 659 million bushels (17.9 million metric tons), were down 12 percent from January 1, 1983.

The September-December 1983 indicated disappearance, based on supply and January 1 stocks, was 688 million bushels (18.7 million metric tons), down 1 percent from the 692 million bushels (18.8 million metric tons) during the same period a year ago.

SUNFLOWER stocks in all positions on January 1, 1984, totaled 1.56 billion pounds (706 thousand metric tons).

### OFF-FARM GRAIN STORAGE CAPACITY

Capacity of off-farm commercial grain storage in the Nation totaled 8.10 billion bushels on January 1, 1984. This is an increase of 3 percent from a year earlier. Expansion of capacity occurred during the year in 32 States and New England, 10 States registered declines, and one State continued unchanged.

Illinois ranked number one in total storage capacity, followed by Iowa, Kansas, Texas, and Nebraska. These top five States together accounted for 53 percent of the Nation's off-farm grain storage capacity.

State capacity data include all elevators, warehouses, terminals, merchant mills, other storages, and oilseed crushers which store grain, soybeans, sunflower, or flaxseed. Capacity data exclude warehouses used to store only rice or peanuts, oilseed crushers processing only cottonseed or peanuts, tobacco warehouses, seed warehouses, and storages that handle only dry edible beans.

### NUMBER OF OFF-FARM GRAIN STORAGE FACILITIES

There was an estimated 14,373 off-farm grain storage facilities in operation on January 1, 1984, a decline of 333 from a year earlier. States with the largest number of facilities this year include: Illinois -- 1042, Iowa -- 1009, Kansas -- 1002, Texas -- 894, and Minnesota -- 811.

Data users are advised that some differences may exist between States in the procedure for making counts of facilities in the grain storage universe. In a few instances, the count includes only the headquarters which reports for more than one facility. This does not affect the data on total capacity.
