## CORN AND SOYBEAN STOCKS DOWN SHARPLY

Stocks of corn in all positions on April 1, 1984 total 82.8 million metric tons, 48 percent less than on April 1, 1983. Stocks of feed grains (corn, sorghum, barley and oats), at 104 million metric tons, were down 44 percent from a year ago. Soybean stocks, at 20.5 million metric tons, were down 36 percent from April 1 last year. Wheat stocks are estimated at 47.7 million metric tons, down 7 percent from April 1, 1983.

CORN stored in all positions on April 1, 1984 is estimated at 3.26 billion bushels (82.8 million metric tons), 48 percent less than last year's record high 6.25 billion bushels (159 million metric tons). Of the total corn on hand April 1, 1984, 60 percent, or 1.94 billion bushels (49.4 million metric tons), was stored on farms. This is 55 percent less than the April 1 farm stocks a year ago. Off-farm stocks, at 1.31 billion bushels (33.4 million metric tons), were down 33 percent from last year's level.

Indicated disappearance from all storage positions during January-March 1984 totaled 1.68 billion bushels (42.6 million metric tons), down 18 percent from the comparable quarter a year ago.

SORGHUM in all storage positions on April 1, 1984 totaled 465 million bushels (11.8 million metric tons), 25 percent less than April 1 a year earlier. On-farm stocks of 86.5 million bushels (2.20 million metric tons), 42 percent less than April 1 last year. Off-farm holdings, at 378 million bushels (9.60 million metric tons), were down 20 percent. Indicated disappearance from all storage positions during January-March 1984 was 188 million bushels (4.76 million metric tons), down 2 percent from the comparable quarter a year ago.

OATS in all storage positions on April 1, 1984, totaled 269 million bushels (3.91 million metric tons), down 19 percent from April 1 a year ago. On-farm stocks totaled 227 million bushels (3.29 million metric tons), 17 percent less than the stocks on hand April 1, 1983. Off-farm stocks amounted to 42.5 million bushels (616 thousand metric tons), 29 percent less than the stocks on hand April 1, 1983. Indicated disappearance during January-March 1984 totaled 109 million bushels (1.58 million metric tons), down 23 percent from the comparable quarter a year ago.

BARLEY stored in all positions on April 1, 1984 totaled 273 million bushels (5.95 million metric tons), 8 percent less than last year's 297 million bushels (6.46 million metric tons). Stocks of barley stored on farms amounted to 174 million bushels (3.78 million metric tons), or 64 percent of the total stocks. Off-farm storages held 99.7 million bushels (2.17 million metric tons), or 36 percent of the total stocks. On-farm stocks were down 12 percent but off-farm stocks were up 2 percent from April 1, 1983. Indicated disappearance during the January-March 1984 period was 102 million bushels (2.23 million metric tons), down 16 percent from the corresponding period a year ago.

ALL WHEAT stored in all positions on April 1, 1984 totaled 1.75 billion bushels (47.7 million metric tons), 7 percent less than last year's record high 1.88 billion bushels (51.1 million metric tons), but 13 percent more than April 1, 1982 stocks. Farm stocks amounted to 772 million bushels (21.0 million metric tons), off 13 percent from a year ago. Off-farm stocks, at 981 million bushels (26.7 million metric tons), were down 1 percent from April 1 last year. Indicated disappearance during January-March 1984 totaled 574 million bushels (15.6 million metric tons). In the comparable period a year earlier, disappearance was 644 million bushels (17.5 million metric tons).

DURUM WHEAT stored in all positions on April 1, 1984 amounted to 125 million bushels (3.39 million metric tons), down 24 percent from 1983's record high 164 million bushels (4.47 million metric tons) and 6 percent less than April 1, 1982. Farm stocks of 89.3 million bushels (2.43 million metric tons) are 31 percent below the 130 million bushels (3.54 million metric tons) on hand April 1, 1983. Off-farm stocks, at 35.2 million bushels (959 thousand metric tons), are up 4 percent from April 1 a year ago. Indicated disappearance during January-March 1984 quarter stands at 8.53 million bushels (232 thousand metric tons), down 66 percent from the 25.0 million bushels (681 thousand metric tons) recorded during the comparable period in 1983.

SOYBEANS in all positions on April 1, 1984 totaled 753 million bushels (20.5 million metric tons), down 36 percent from April 1, a year ago and 28 percent less than April 1, 1982. Farm stocks of 339 million bushels (9.23 million metric tons), were 50 percent below April 1, 1983. Off-farm stocks totaled 414 million bushels (11.3 million metric tons), down 18 percent from April 1 a year earlier.

Another indication of stocks is provided by subtracting usage (quantities exported, crushed, and used for seed and feed) from beginning supply. Usage during the September-March period implies a soybean stocks level of approximately 850 million bushels on April 1, 1984. The difference between the derived stocks level and the official estimate based on survey data is larger than normal. Revised estimates of crop acreage, yield, and production and quarterly grain and oilseed stocks for the period 1979-83 will be published in June 1984.


SUNFLOWER stocks in all storage positions on April 1, 1984, totaled 901 million pounds (409 thousand metric tons). This total represents reported stocks in only three States (North Dakota, South Dakota and Minnesota).

#### GRAIN AND OILSEED STOCKS SURVEYS

Off-farm grain and oilseeds stock estimates are based on quarterly surveys of all known commercial grain and oilseed storage facilities (about 14,000). Lists maintained in each State Statistical Office are divided into groups of similar plants, such as mill and elevators, terminals, oilseed processors, etc. Each group is further stratified by size. Smaller facilities are sampled with a complete enumeration made of the largest facilities. About 85 percent of the total off-farm grain and oilseed storage capacity is included in the survey returns.

On-farm grain and oilseed stocks estimates are based on two separate quarterly surveys of farmers. Historically, on-farm stocks estimates have been based on a mail survey of farmers. For the April 1, 1984 survey, about 20,000 farmers provided stocks information on this survey. As resources have permitted, the Agency has been shifting from mail surveys to the use of multiple frame sampling to improve the quality of the crop estimating program. The use of this methodology relies upon a list of farm operators and a sample of segments of land that is screened for stocks of grains which might be missed by the list. In April 1983, the Agency initiated a multiple frame stocks survey in the 23 major grain and oilseed producing States. Each person or operation selected in the sample was surveyed by mail, telephone, or personal interview. For the April 1, 1984 report, approximately 28,000 individuals were contacted for stocks information in carrying out the survey. This survey is designed to provide estimates with a sampling variability of 2-3 percent at the 23 State level.
