FEED GRAINS, SOYBEANS, AND WHEAT BELOW LAST YEAR

According to the Crop Reporting Board, stocks of the four feed grains (corn, sorghum, oats and barley) totaled 70.3 million metric tons on June 1, 1984, 52 percent below the total a year earlier. Corn stocks at the beginning of June 1984 totaled 54.3 million metric tons, down 57 percent from the record high June 1, 1983 stocks. Sorghum, barley, and oats were also down from last year-31 percent, 13 percent and 18 percent, respectively. Soybean stocks on June 1, 1984 totaled 12.4 million metric tons, down 42 percent from a year ago and 29 percent below June 1, 1982. Wheat stocks, at 37.9 million metric tons, were down 8 percent from a year ago, but 20 percent more than June 1, 1982.

Corn stored in all positions on June 1, 1984 totaled 2.14 billion bushels (54.3 million metric tons), 57 percent less than last year's record high level of 4.92 billion bushels (125 million metric tons). Of the total corn on hand June 1, 1984, 57 percent or 1.21 billion bushels (30.8 million metric tons), was stored on farms. Farm stocks were 61 percent lower than June 1, 1983 farm stocks. Off-farm stocks, at 926 million bushels (23.5 million metric tons) were down 49 percent from last year's level.

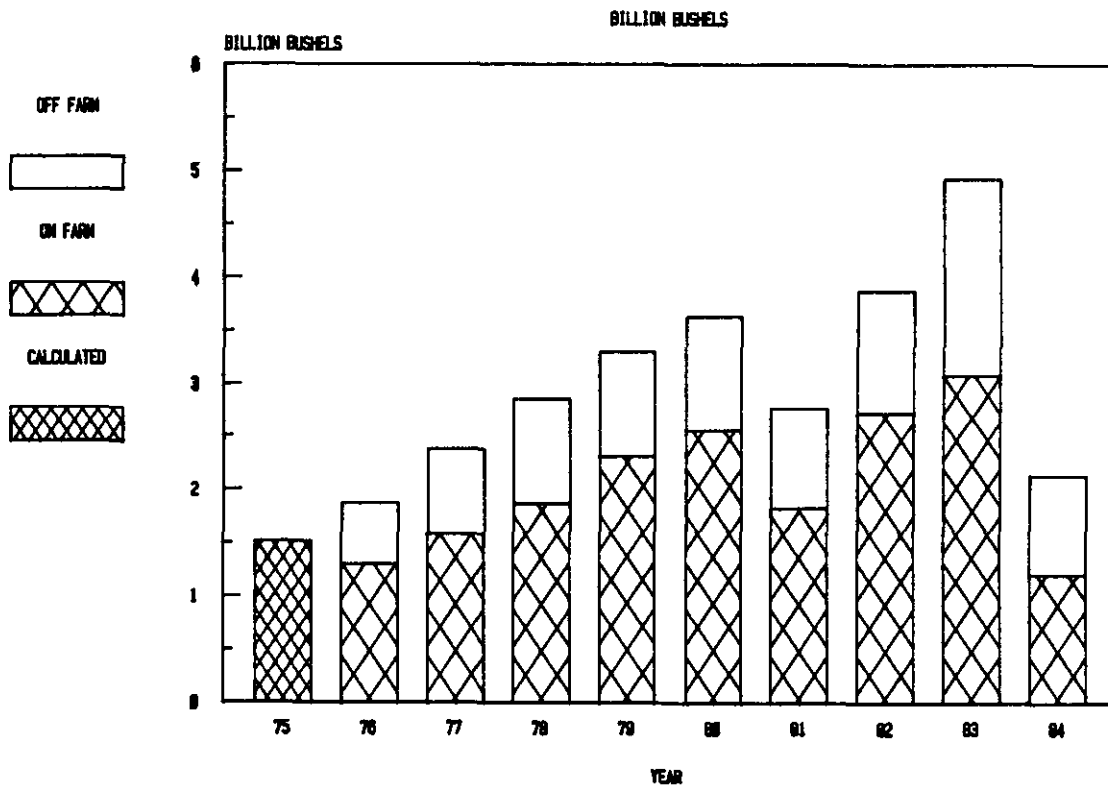
Indicated disappearance from all storage positions during April-May 1984 totaled 1.11 billion bushels (28.2 million metric tons), down 13 percent from disappearance during the comparable quarter a year ago.

Sorghum in all storage positions on June 1, 1984 totaled 367 million bushels (9.33 million metric tons), 31 percent less than June 1 a year earlier. On-farm stocks of 60.3 million bushels (1.53 million metric tons) were 37 percent less than June 1 1983. Off-farm holdings, at 307 million bushels (7.80 million metric tons), were down 29 percent. Indicated disappearance from all storage positions during April and May 1984 was 99.9 million bushels (2.54 million metric tons), up from the disappearance of 92.1 million bushels (2.34 million metric tons) during the comparable period last year.

Old Crop Oats in all storage positions on June 1, 1984, totaled 181 million bushels (2.63 million metric tons), down 18 percent from June 1 a year ago. On-farm stocks totaled 151 million bushels (2.20 million metric tons), 16 percent less than the stocks on hand June 1, 1983. Off-farm stocks amounted to 29.8 million bushels (432 thousand metric tons), 23 percent less than the stocks on hand June 1, 1983. Indicated disappearance during April and May 1984 was 89.0 million bushels (1.29 million metric tons), down 10 percent from the comparable period last year.

Old Crop Barley stored in all positions on June 1, 1984, totaled 189 million bushels (4.11 million metric tons), down 13 percent from June 1 a year ago. Of the total barley stocks on hand June 1, 1984, 62 percent or 117 million bushels (2.54 million metric tons), was stored on-farms. Farm stocks were 15 percent below the June 1 farm stocks a year ago. Off-farm stocks, at 72.0 million bushels (1.57 million metric tons) were down 10 percent from last year's level. Indicated disappearance during April and May 1984 was 79.6 million bushels (1.73 million metric tons), 3 percent more than the corresponding period a year earlier.

Old Crop Wheat stored in all positions on June 1, 1984 totaled 1.39 billion bushels (37.9 million metric tons), down 8 percent from the 1.52 billion bushels (41.2 million metric tons) on hand June 1 a year ago, but 20 percent more than two years ago. Farm stocks amounted to 592 million bushels (16.1 million metric tons), down 12 percent from June 1, 1983. Off-farm stocks, at 803 million bushels (21.8 million metric tons) were down 5 percent from June 1 a year earlier. Indicated disappearance during April-May totaled 362 million bushels (9.86 million metric tons). For the comparable period last year, disappearance was 347 million bushels (9.44 million metric tons).

Old Crop Durum Wheat stocks in all positions June 1, 1984, totaled 101 million bushels (2.76 million metric tons), 25 percent less than last year's 136 million bushels (3.70 million metric tons), but down 4 percent from June 1, 1982. Farm stocks of 73.7 million bushels (2.01 million metric tons) were 34 percent below the 111 million bushels (3.02 million metric tons) on hand June 1, 1983. Off-farm stocks, at 27.6 million bushels (752 thousand metric tons) were up 11 percent from a year earlier. Indicated April-May 1984 disappearance of durum wheat was 22.2 million bushels (603 thousand metric tons), down 16 percent from the 26.5 million bushels (720 thousand metric tons) recorded for the comparable period a year earlier.

Soybean stocks in all positions June 1, 1984 totaled 456 million bushels (12.4 million metric tons), down 42 percent from a year ago, and 29 percent below June 1, 1982. Farm stocks of 164 million bushels (4.47 million metric tons) were down 61 percent from June 1, 1983. Off-farm stocks totaled 292 million bushels (7.95 million metric tons), down 20 percent from June 1 a year ago.

The September-May utilization is indicated at 1.45 billion bushels (39.6 million metric tons), 12 percent below the same period a year earlier. The April-May 1984 indicated disappearance totaled 293 million bushels (7.97 million metric tons), down 18 percent from disappearance during the comparable period a year earlier.

Sunflower stocks in all position on June 1, 1984 totaled 317 million pounds (144 thousand metric tons). This total represents reported stocks in only three States (North Dakota, South Dakota, and Minnesota).
