CORN AND SOYBEANS UP; WHEAT DOWN
FROM A YEAR EARLIER

Stocks of corn in all positions on January 1, 1985 are estimated at 148 million metric tons, 18 percent more than on January 1, 1984. Stocks of feed grains (corn, sorghum, barley and oats), at 181 million metric tons, are 17 percent more than a year ago. Soybean stocks, at 38.7 million metric tons, are up 10 percent from January 1 last year. Wheat stocks are estimated at 58.2 million metric tons, 8 percent less than January 1, 1984.

CORN stored in all positions on January 1, 1985 is estimated at 5.81 billion bushels (148 million metric tons), 18 percent more than the January 1, 1984 level of 4.91 billion bushels (125 million metric tons). Of the total corn on hand January 1, 1985, 73 percent, or 4.25 billion bushels (108 million metric tons), was stored on farms. This is 38 percent more than the January 1 farm stocks a year ago. Off-farm stocks, at 1.56 billion bushels (39.6 million metric tons), are down 15 percent from last January 1.

Indicated disappearance from all storage positions during October-December 1984 totaled 2.57 billion bushels (65.3 million metric tons), up 8 percent from the comparable quarter a year ago.

SORGHUM in all storage positions on January 1, 1985 totaled 729 million bushels (18.5 million metric tons), up 11 percent from January 1 a year earlier but down 10 percent from the same date in 1983. On-farm stocks of 233 million bushels (5.91 million metric tons) are up 56 percent from January 1 last year. Off-farm holdings, at 496 million bushels (12.6 million metric tons), are down 2 percent from a year ago. Indicated disappearance from all storage positions during October-December 1984 is 388 million bushels (9.85 million metric tons), 66 percent more than the disappearance during the same period a year earlier.

OATS in all storage positions on January 1, 1985, totaled 357 million bushels (5.18 million metric tons), down 6 percent from January 1 a year ago, and down 21 percent from January 1, 1983. On-farm stocks totaled 299 million bushels (4.35 million metric tons), down 7 percent from January 1, a year earlier. Off-farm stocks amounted to 57.8 million bushels (838 thousand metric tons), 2 percent more than the stocks on hand January 1, 1984. Indicated disappearance during October-December 1984 totaled 117 million bushels (1.69 million metric tons), down 8 percent from the comparable quarter a year ago.

BARLEY stored in all positions on January 1, 1985, totaled 438 million bushels (9.53 million metric tons), 19 percent more than the 368 million bushels (8.00 million metric tons) stored on January 1, 1984. Stocks of barley stored on farms amounted to 306 million bushels (6.67 million metric tons), or 70 percent of the total stocks. Off-farm storages held 131 million bushels (2.86 million metric tons) on January 1, or 30 percent of the total stocks. On-farm stocks are up 25 percent and off-farm stocks are 7 percent above January 1, 1984. Indicated disappearance during the October-December 1984 period is 136 million bushels (2.96 million metric tons), 9 percent less than the corresponding period a year ago.

ALL WHEAT stored in all positions January 1, 1985 is estimated at 2.14 billion bushels (58.2 million metric tons), 8 percent less than the 2.33 billion bushels (63.3 million metric tons) on hand a year earlier. Of the total stocks on hand January 1, 1985, 44 percent, or 933 million bushels (25.4 million metric tons) was stored on farms. This is 8 percent less than the January 1, 1984 farm stocks. Off-farm stocks, at 1.21 billion bushels (32.8 million metric tons), are down 8 percent from the January 1 level a year ago. Indicated disappearance from all storage positions during October-December 1984 is 600 million bushels (16.3 million metric tons), down 5 percent from the comparable quarter in 1983.

DURUM WHEAT stored in all positions January 1, 1985 totaled 132 million bushels (3.60 million metric tons), down 1 percent from the 133 million bushels (3.62 million metric tons) stored on January 1, 1984. Farm stocks of 95.0 million bushels (2.58 million metric tons) are 3 percent less than the 97.8 million bushels (2.66 million metric tons) on-farms a year earlier. Off-farm stocks amounted to 37.1 million bushels (1.01 million metric tons), 5 percent more than January 1 a year ago. Indicated disappearance from all storage positions during the last quarter of 1984 is 44.5 million bushels (1.21 million metric tons), up 70 percent from the 26.2 million bushels (713 thousand metric tons) disappearance during the comparable period in 1983.

SOYBEANS in all storage positions on January 1, 1985 totaled 1.42 billion bushels (38.7 million metric tons), up 10 percent from January 1 a year ago, but 19 percent below January 1, 1983. Farm stocks, of 767 million bushels (20.9 million metric tons), are up 24 percent from January 1, 1984. Off-farm stocks, at 656 million bushels (17.8 million metric tons), are down 2 percent. The September-December 1984 indicated disappearance, based on supply and January 1 stocks, is 614 million bushels (16.7 million metric tons), down 11 percent from the 690 million bushels (18.8 million metric tons) disappearance during the same period a year ago.

OFF-FARM GRAIN STORAGE CAPACITY

Capacity of off-farm commercial grain storage in the Nation totaled 8.12 billion bushels on January 1, 1985. This is an increase of less than one-half of one percent from a year earlier. Expansion of capacity occurred during the year in 21 States and New England, 19 States registered declines, and 2 States continued unchanged.

Illinois ranked number one in total storage capacity, followed by: Kansas, Iowa, Texas, and Nebraska. These top 5 States together accounted for 52 percent of the Nation's off-farm grain storage capacity.

State capacity data include all elevators, warehouses, terminals, merchant mills, other storages, and oilseed crushers which store grain, soybeans, sunflower, or flaxseed. Capacity data exclude warehouses used to store only rice or peanuts, oilseed crushers processing only cottonseed or peanuts, tobacco warehouses, seed warehouses, and storages that handle only dry edible beans.

NUMBER OF OFF-FARM GRAIN STORAGE FACILITIES

There was an estimated 13,936 off-farm grain storage facilities in operation on January 1, 1985, a decline of 259 from a year earlier. States with the largest number of facilities this January 1 include: Illinois -- 1027, Kansas -- 1000, Iowa -- 976, Texas -- 891, and Minnesota -- 813.

Data users are advised that some differences may exist, between States, in the procedure for making counts of facilities in the grain storage universe. In a few instances, the count includes only the headquarters which reports for more than one facility. This does not affect the data on total capacity.
