FEED GRAINS AND WHEAT ABOVE LAST YEAR

Stocks of the four feed grains (corn, sorghum, oats and barley) totaled 63.9 million metric tons on October 1, 1985, up 45 percent from October 1 last year but 41 percent below October 1, 1983. Wheat stocks, at 79.9 million metric tons, were up 7 percent from October 1 a year ago but down 1 percent from October 1, 1983.

OLD CROP CORN in all positions on October 1, 1985 totaled 1.38 billion bushels (35.0 million metric tons), 91 percent more than on October 1 a year ago but 56 percent below the record high stocks on October 1, 1983.

Of the total corn stocks on October 1, 1985, 49 percent, or 677 million bushels (17.2 million metric tons), was stored on the farm and 51 percent, or 702 million bushels (17.8 million metric tons), was stored off the farm. The on-farm stocks are up 95 percent from October 1 a year ago and the off-farm stocks are up 87 percent.

Indicated disappearance during the June-September 1985 period was 1.45 billion bushels (36.9 million metric tons), up 2 percent from the comparable period a year ago. The marketing year disappearance (October 1, 1984 through September 30, 1985) was 7.00 billion bushels (178 million metric tons), up 7 percent from the corresponding period a year ago. Usage, by category and percent change for the marketing year follows: Exports - down 1 percent from last year; food, processing, and seed use - up 11 percent from last year; feed and residual - up 9 percent from last year.

OLD CROP SORGHUM in all positions on October 1, 1985 totaled 271 million bushels (6.88 million metric tons), up 8 percent from October 1 a year earlier. Farm stocks totaled 45.9 million bushels (1.17 million metric tons), 21 percent more than a year earlier. Off-farm holdings, at 225 million bushels (5.72 million metric tons), are up 6 percent from a year earlier. Indicated disappearance from all storage positions during June-September 1985 was 89.7 million bushels (2.28 million metric tons), down 24 percent from the disappearance during the same period a year earlier.

OATS stored in all positions on October 1, 1985 totaled 532 million bushels (7.73 million metric tons), up 12 percent from October 1, 1984. Farm stocks, at 438 million bushels (6.36 million metric tons), are 10 percent more than on October 1 a year ago and off-farm holdings, at 94.2 million bushels (1.37 million metric tons) are up 23 percent from a year earlier. Indicated usage during June-September 1985 was 185 million bushels (2.68 million metric tons), 3 percent more than during the corresponding period a year ago.

BARLEY stored in all positions on October 1, 1985 totaled 654 million bushels (14.2 million metric tons), 14 percent more than on October 1 a year earlier and 27 percent more than on October 1, 1983. Of the total barley stocks on-hand October 1, 1985, 71 percent, or 463 million bushels (10.1 million metric tons), was stored on-farm. Farm stocks are 15 percent above a year earlier. Off-farm stocks, of 191 million bushels (4.15 million metric tons), are up 11 percent from October 1, 1984. Indicated disappearance during June-September 1985 was 192 million bushels (4.18 million metric tons), 10 percent less than the corresponding period a year ago.

ALL WHEAT stored in all positions on October 1, 1985 totaled 2.93 billion bushels (79.9 million metric tons), 7 percent more than the 2.74 billion bushels (74.6 million metric tons) on hand October 1, 1984, but 1 percent less than the October 1, 1983 stocks. Wheat stored off-farms is 1.72 billion bushels (46.9 million metric tons), or 59 percent of the total wheat stocks. Farm stocks amount to 1.21 billion bushels (33.0 million metric tons). Farm stocks are fractionally below October 1, 1984, while off-farm stocks are up 13 percent. Indicated disappearance of all wheat during June-September 1985 amounts to 909 million bushels (24.7 million metric tons), 27 percent less than the 1.25 billion bushels (34.1 million metric tons) disappearance during the same period a year ago.

DURUM WHEAT stocks in all positions on October 1, 1985 totaled 163 million bushels (4.44 million metric tons), down 8 percent from the 177 million bushels (4.81 million metric tons) stored on October 1, 1984. Farm stocks total 119 million bushels (3.24 million metric tons) and are 5 percent less than October 1 a year ago. Off-farm stocks of 44.1 million bushels (1.20 million metric tons) are down 15 percent from last October 1. Indicated disappearance from all storage positions during June-September 1985 is 42.4 million bushels (1.15 million metric tons), up 66 percent from the same period in 1984.
