## FEED GRAINS AND WHEAT ABOVE LAST YEAR

Stocks of the four feed grains (corn, sorghum, oats and barley) totaled 242 million metric tons on January 1, 1986, up 33 percent from January 1 last year and 56 percent more than January 1, 1984. Wheat stocks, at 69.0 million metric tons, were up 18 percent from January 1 a year ago and up 9 percent from January 1, 1984.

CORN stored in all positions on January 1, 1986 is estimated at 7.88 billion bushels (200 million metric tons), 34 percent more than the January 1, 1985 total of 5.86 billion bushels (149 million metric tons). Of the total corn stocks on hand January 1, 1986, 70 percent, or 5.53 billion bushels (140 million metric tons), was stored on farms. This is 28 percent more than the January 1 farm stocks a year ago. Off-farm stocks, at 2.35 billion bushels (59.7 million metric tons), are 51 percent above January 1, 1985.

Indicated disappearance from all storage positions during October-December 1985 totaled 2.37 billion bushels (60.2 million metric tons), down 6 percent from the comparable quarter a year ago.

SORGHUM in all storage positions on January 1, 1986 totaled 990 million bushels (25.1 million metric tons), up 37 percent from January 1 a year earlier. On farm stocks of 327 million bushels (8.32 million metric tons) are up 43 percent from January 1, 1985. Off-farm holdings, at 662 million bushels (16.8 million metric tons), are up 33 percent from January 1 a year ago. Indicated disappearance from all storage positions during October-December 1985 is 394 million bushels (10.0 million metric tons), fractionally above the disappearance during the same period a year earlier.

OATS stocks in all storage positions on January 1, 1986 totaled 379 million bushels (5.49 million metric tons), up 6 percent from January 1, 1985. Farm stocks, at 310 million bushels (4.50 million metric tons), are 3 percent more than on January 1 a year ago. Off-farm holdings, at 68.4 million bushels (993 thousand metric tons) are up 18 percent from a year earlier. Indicated disappearance during October-December 1985 is 132 million bushels (1.92 million metric tons), 13 percent more than the corresponding period a year ago.


BARLEY stored in all positions on January 1, 1986 totaled 534 million bushels (11.6 million metric tons), 22 percent more than January 1 a year ago and 45 percent more than January 1, 1984. Of the total barley stocks on hand January 1, 1986, 68 percent, or 365 million bushels (7.95 million metric tons), was stored on farms. Farm stocks are 19 percent above a year earlier. Off-farm stocks, of 168 million bushels (3.67 million metric tons), are up 30 percent from January 1, 1985. Indicated disappearance during October-December 1985 is 121 million bushels (2.64 million metric tons), 12 percent less than the corresponding period a year ago.

ALL WHEAT stored in all positions on January 1, 1986 is estimated at 2.54 billion bushels (69.0 million metric tons), 18 percent more than the 2.14 billion bushels (58.3 million metric tons) on hand January 1, 1985. Wheat stored on farms accounts for 1.02 billion bushels (27.8 million metric tons), or 40 percent of the total stocks on January 1, 1986. Off-farm stocks total 1.51 billion bushels (41.2 million metric tons). Farm stocks are up 10 percent from January 1, 1985, while off-farm stocks are up 25 percent. Indicated disappearance from all storage positions during Oct-Dec 1985 is 435 million bushels (11.8 million metric tons), down 28 percent from the 602 million bushel (16.4 million metric ton) disappearance during the comparable period in 1984.

DURUM WHEAT in all storage positions on January 1, 1986 is estimated at 150 million bushels (4.09 million metric tons), up 14 percent from the 132 million bushels (3.60 million metric tons) on hand a year earlier. Farm stocks are placed at 112 million bushels (3.04 million metric tons), up 17 percent. Off-farm stocks are 4 percent more than the January 1, 1985 level. Indicated 85-86 marketing year-to-date (June 1 - January 1) disappearance from all storage positions is 62.1 million bushels (1.69 million metric tons), down 11 percent from the comparable period a year ago.

SOYBEANS in all storage positions on January 1, 1986 totaled 1.76 billion bushels (48.0 million metric tons), up 24 percent from January 1, 1985 and 37 percent above January 1, 1984. Farm stocks, at 927 million bushels (25.2 million metric tons), increased 21 percent from last January 1. Off-farm stocks, at 837 million bushels (22.8 million metric tons), are up 28 percent from January 1, 1985. The September-December 1985 indicated disappearance, based on supply and January 1 stocks, is 650 million bushels (17.7 million metric tons), up 6 percent from the 615 million bushel (16.7 million metric ton) disappearance during the same period a year ago.

## OFF-FARM GRAIN STORAGE CAPACITY

Capacity of off-farm commercial grain storage totaled 8.25 billion bushels in the United States on January 1, 1986. Capacity increased 1.7 percent from last year's revised capacity figure of 8.11 billion bushels. Increases in capacity occurred in 29 States and New England, 11 States registered declines, and 2 States remained unchanged from January 1, 1985.

Illinois continues to lead all States in total storage capacity followed by: Iowa, Kansas, Texas, and Nebraska. The top 5 States account for 52 percent of the Nation's off-farm storage capacity.

State capacity data include all elevators, warehouses, terminals, merchant mills, other storages, and oilseed crushers which store grain, soybeans, sunflower, or flaxseed. Capacity data exclude warehouses used to store only rice or peanuts, oilseed crushers processing only cottonseed or peanuts, tobacco warehouses, seed warehouses, and storages that handle only dry edible beans.

## NUMBER OF OFF-FARM GRAIN STORAGE FACILITIES

Off-farm grain storage facilities totaled 13,770 on January 1, 1986, 151 fewer than on January 1, 1984. States with the largest number of facilities include: Kansas-992, Illinois-980, Iowa-941, Texas-874, and Minnesota-806.

Data users are advised that some differences may exist, between States, in the procedure for making counts of facilities in the grain storage universe. In a few instances, the count includes only the headquarters which report for more than one facility. This does not affect the data on total capacity.
