CORN stored in all positions on June 1, 1986 is estimated at 4.99 billion bushels (127 million metric tons), 76 percent more than the June 1, 1985 level of 2.84 billion bushels (72.0 million metric tons). Of the total corn stocks on-hand June 1, 1986, 63 percent or 3.14 billion bushels (79.8 million metric tons), was stored on-farms. Farm stocks were 56 percent higher than June 1, 1985 farm stocks. Off-farm stocks, at 1.85 billion bushels (46.9 million metric tons), are up 123 percent from last June 1.

Indicated disappearance from all storage positions during April-May 1986 totaled 956 million bushels (24.3 million metric tons), down 15 percent from the disappearance during the comparable quarter a year ago.

OLD CROP WHEAT stored in all positions on June 1, 1986 is estimated at a record high 1.90 billion bushels (51.7 million metric tons), up 33 percent from the 1.43 billion bushels (38.8 million metric tons) stored on June 1, 1985. Off-farm stocks, at 1.22 billion bushels (33.2 million metric tons), are 64 percent of the total stocks and are up 45 percent from June 1 a year ago. Wheat stored on farms totaled 681 million bushels (18.5 million metric tons), up 17 percent from last June 1. Indicated disappearance from all storage positions during April-May 1986 is 230 million bushels (6.26 million metric tons), off 5 percent from the disappearance during the same period last year.

OLD CROP DURUM WHEAT stocks in all positions on June 1, 1986 are placed at 123 million bushels (3.34 million metric tons), 23 percent more than on June 1 a year ago. Farm stocks total 78.9 million bushels (2.15 million metric tons), up 14 percent from June 1, 1985. Off-farm stocks are placed at 43.7 million bushels (1.19 million metric tons), up 43 percent from last June 1. April-May 1986 indicated disappearance from all storage positions is 13.5 million bushels (366 thousand metric tons), 10 percent less than during the same period in 1985.

SOYBEANS stored in all positions on June 1, 1986 totaled 847 million bushels (23.0 million metric tons), up 39 percent from June 1, 1985 and 79 percent above June 1, 1984. Farm stocks are estimated at 412 million bushels (11.2 million metric tons), 26 percent more than on June 1, 1985. Off-farm stocks, at 435 million bushels (11.8 million metric tons), are up 54 percent from June 1 a year ago.

Indicated disappearance from all storage positions during April-May 1986 totaled 329 million bushels (8.96 million metric tons), 15 percent more than the disappearance for the same period in 1985. Indicated disappearance for the marketing year, at 1.57 billion bushels (42.7 million metric tons), is 10 percent higher than the previous year-to-date utilization.

OLD CROP BARLEY in all storage positions on June 1, 1986 set a record high at 325 million bushels (7.07 million metric tons), 31 percent more than the 247 million bushels (5.39 million metric tons) on June 1, 1985. On-farm stocks totaled a record high for June 1 at 199 million bushels (4.33 million metric tons) and accounted for 61 percent of the total stocks. Farm stocks are 22 percent more than the previous record high June 1 stocks of 163 million bushels (3.56 million metric tons) on June 1, 1985. Off-farm stocks, at 126 million bushels (2.73 million metric tons), are 49 percent more than a year earlier. Indicated disappearance during this crop marketing year (June 1, 1985 - May 31, 1986) was 512 million bushels (11.1 million metric tons), a decrease of 5 percent from the comparable period a year earlier.

OLD CROP OAT stocks in all storage positions on June 1, 1986 totaled 183 million bushels (2.66 million metric tons), up 2 percent from June 1, 1985. Farm stocks, at 147 million bushels (2.13 million metric tons), are virtually unchanged from a year earlier. Off-farm supplies, at 36.5 million bushels (530 thousand metric tons), are 9 percent more than on June 1 last year. Indicated disappearance during the marketing year (June 1, 1985- May 31, 1986) is 515 million bushels (7.48 million metric tons), 9 percent more than the comparable period a year ago.

SORGHUM in all storage positions on June 1, 1986 totaled 612 million bushels (15.5 million metric tons), 70 percent more than on June 1 a year earlier. Record high June 1 on-farm stocks of 137 million bushels (3.48 million metric tons) were 54 percent more than the June 1, 1985 level. Off-farm holdings, at 475 million bushels (12.1 million metric tons), were up 75 percent. Indicated disappearance from all storage positions for the 1985-86 marketing year to date was 772 million bushels (19.6 million metric tons), up 2 percent from the disappearance of 756 million bushels (19.2 million metric tons) during the comparable period last year.
