OLD CROP CORN stored in all positions on September 1, 1986 is estimated at 4.04 billion bushels (103 million metric tons). Of the total stocks, 2.05 billion bushels (52.1 million metric tons) were stored on the farm and 1.99 billion bushels (50.5 million metric tons) were stored off the farm. The corn marketing year has been changed from October 1-September 30 to September 1-August 31 and this is the first time corn stocks have been surveyed on September 1.

OLD CROP SORGHUM in all positions on September 1, 1986 totaled 551 million bushels (14.0 million metric tons). A little more than 83 percent of the total sorghum stocks are in off-farm positions--460 million bushels (11.7 million metric tons).


SOYBEANS: The September 1, 1986 carryover of old crop soybeans is a record high 536 million bushels (14.6 million metric tons), 70 percent above last year and more than triple the September 1, 1984 stocks level. Soybeans stored on-farm totaled 167 million bushels (4.55 million metric tons), up 17 percent from September 1, 1985 and account for 31 percent of the soybean stocks stored in all positions. Off-farm stocks, at 369 million bushels (10.0 million metric tons), are more than doubled from a year ago.

As indicated by year-end stocks, disappearance during the marketing year (September 1985-August 1986) totaled 1.88 billion bushels (51.1 million metric tons), 9 percent above last year. Indicated disappearance during June-August 1986 totaled 313 million bushels (8.51 million metric tons), 7 percent more than during the same period a year ago.

WHEAT stored in all positions on September 1, 1986 is estimated at 3.12 billion bushels (84.8 million metric tons). Off-farm stocks, at 1.82 billion bushels (49.6 million metric tons), are 59 percent of the total stocks. Wheat stored on-farms is 1.29 billion bushels (35.1 million metric tons).

DURUM WHEAT stocks in all positions are placed at 177 million bushels (4.82 million metric tons). Farm stocks total 124 million bushels (3.38 million metric tons) or 70 percent of all durum stocks.
