CORN stored in all positions on March 1, 1987 is estimated at 8.25 billion bushels (209 million metric tons). Of the total stocks, 5.02 billion bushels (128 million metric tons) were stored on the farm and 3.22 billion bushels (81.9 million metric tons) were stored off the farm. The December 1986-February 1987 indicated disappearance, based on supply and March 1 stocks, is 2.06 billion bushels (52.3 million metric tons).


ALL WHEAT stored in all positions on March 1, 1987 is estimated at 2.25 billion bushels (61.3 million metric tons). Off-farm stocks are placed at 1.46 billion bushels (39.7 million metric tons). On-farm storage accounts for 796 million bushels (21.7 million metric tons). Indicated disappearance from all storage positions during the December 1986-February 1987 quarter is 418 million bushels (11.4 million metric tons).

DURUM WHEAT stocks stored in all positions on March 1, 1987 is set at 129 million bushels (3.50 million metric tons). Stocks on-farms total 72.6 million bushels (1.98 million metric tons), or 56 percent of all durum stocks. The indicated December 1986-February 1987 disappearance from all storage positions is 25.8 million bushels (702 thousand metric tons).

SOYBEANS stored in all positions on March 1, 1987 totaled 1.38 billion bushels (37.7 million metric tons). Farm stocks are estimated at 635 million bushels (17.3 million metric tons) and off-farm stocks at 749 million bushels (20.4 million metric tons). Indicated disappearance from all storage positions during the December 1986-February 1987 period totaled 597 million bushels (16.3 million metric tons). Indicated disappearance for the marketing year is 1.16 billion bushels (31.5 million metric tons).
