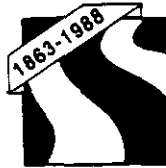

CORN stored in all positions on December 1, 1988 is estimated at 7.07 billion bushels. Of the total stocks, 4.28 billion bushels were stored on-farms. Off-farm stocks totaled 2.79 billion bushels.

The September-November 1988 indicated disappearance based on supply and December 1 stocks is 2.11 billion bushels, 3 percent below the disappearance of 2.18 billion bushels during September-November 1987.

WHEAT stored in all positions on December 1, 1988 is estimated at 1.71 billion bushels, down 32 percent from December 1, 1987. Farm stocks total 614 million bushels, 36 percent less than last December. Off-farm stocks total 1.10 billion bushels, off 29 percent from last year. The apparent September-November 1988 disappearance from all positions is 543 million bushels, up 14 percent from the comparable quarter in 1987.

DURUM WHEAT stocks December 1 total 92.7 million bushels, off 23 percent from December 1, 1987. Farm stocks are down 35 percent from last year at 49.6 million bushels. Off-farm durum stocks are down just 1 percent from a year earlier. The indicated September-November disappearance from all positions is 14.0 million bushels, 46 percent less than in the same quarter in 1987.

SOYBEANS stored in all positions on December 1, 1988 totaled 1.37 billion bushels, 22 percent less than on December 1, 1987. Farm stocks totaled 650 million bushels, down 25 percent from last December 1. Off-farm stocks, at 717 million bushels, were 19 percent below December 1, 1987. The September-November 1988 indicated disappearance, based on supply and December 1 stocks, is 474 million bushels, down 22 percent from the 604 million bushels disappearance during the same period a year ago.


BARLEY stored in all positions on December 1, 1988 totaled 376 million bushels. Of the total barley stocks on-hand, 183 million bushels were stored on-farms and 193 million bushels were stored off-farms.

ON-FARM GRAIN STORAGE CAPACITY 1/

Capacity of the United States on-farm grain storage totaled 13.3 billion bushels on December 1, 1988, 2 percent below a year ago.

The National Agricultural Statistics Service collects on-farm grain storage capacity data as part of the Agency's quarterly Agricultural surveys. The capacity data from the December Agricultural Survey is published annually for selected States and the United States, excluding Alaska and Hawaii. The data provides an indication of farm storage capacity with a range indicated by the sampling error. The measure of sampling error is expressed as a percent of the survey indication, (coefficient of variation). When comparing the data year to year this survey variability must be taken into account.

Approximately 75,000 reports were included in the survey. At the U. S. level, the on-farm storage capacity indication of 13.3 billion bushels has a sampling error of 1.3 percent. This means that chances are 2 out of 3 that if the storage capacity indications from all possible samples were averaged together the results would be within plus or minus 1.3 percent of 13.3 billion bushels.

## OFF-FARM GRAIN STORAGE CAPACITY

Capacity of off-farm commercial grain storage totaled 9.61 billion bushels in the United States on December 1, 1988, practically unchanged from December 1, 1987. The largest increase in capacity occurred in Texas - 43.8 million bushels followed by North Dakota - 17.0 million bushels and Ohio - 15.8 million bushels. The increases in capacity were partially offset by decreases in Iowa - 25.9 million bushels and Illinois - 23.2 million bushels. Off-farm capacity increased in 15 States and the New England States while decreasing in 25 States.

Illinois continues to lead all States in off-farm storage capacity, followed by Iowa, Kansas, Texas, and Nebraska. The top 5 States account for 53 percent of the Nation's off-farm storage capacity on December 1, 1988.

State capacity data include all elevators, warehouses, terminals, merchant mills, other storages, and oilseed crushers which store grain, soybeans, sunflower, or flaxseed. Capacity data exclude warehouses used to store only rice or peanuts, oilseed crushers processing only cottonseed or peanuts, tobacco warehouses, seed warehouses, and storages that handle only dry edible beans.

## NUMBER OF OFF-FARM GRAIN STORAGE FACILITIES

Off-farm grain storage facilities totaled 13,799 on December 1, 1988, 90 fewer than on-hand December 1, 1987. States with the largest number of facilities are Illinois - 1,295, Kansas - 941, Iowa - 907, Texas - 875, and Minnesota - 803.

Data users are advised that some differences may exist, between States, in the procedures for making counts of facilities. In a few instances, the count includes Headquarters operations which report for more than one facility. This does not affect the data on total capacity.
