CORN stored in all positions on June 1, 1989 is estimated at 3.42 billion bushels, down 41 percent from June 1, 1988. Of the total stocks, 2.02 billion bushels were stored on-farms. Off-farm stocks totaled 1.40 billion bushels. The indicated disappearance from all positions for the quarter ending June 1, 1989 is 1.78 billion bushels, down 1 percent from the comparable period last year.

OLD CROP WHEAT in all positions June 1, 1989 is 694 million bushels, down 45 percent from last June 1 and the lowest carryover level since 1976. Farm stocks, at 283 million bushels, are down 46 percent from June 1, 1988. Off-farm stocks are 44 percent less than a year ago at 411 million bushels. The indicated March-May disappearance from all positions is 528 million bushels, down 20 percent from the same quarter last year.

OLD CROP DURUM WHEAT stocks on June 1, 1989 are 59.8 million bushels, down 28 percent from last year; also the lowest carryover since 1976. Farm stocks declined to 34.2 million bushels, off 36 percent. Off-farm storage totals 25.6 million bushels, down 13 percent. Indicated fourth quarter disappearance from all positions is 18.6 million bushels, 15 percent less than in the same period last year.

SOYBEANS stored in all positions on June 1, 1989 totaled 465 million bushels, 29 percent below a year earlier and 44 percent lower than June 1, 1987. This stocks level is the lowest June 1 total since 1977. Farm stocks, at 229 million bushels, are down 25 percent from June 1, 1988. Off-farm stocks totaled 236 million bushels, 33 percent below last June 1.

Indicated disappearance during the March-May quarter is 425 million bushels, compared with 491 million bushels during March-May 1988. Disappearance during the September-May marketing year reached 1.38 million bushels. A year earlier, the comparable disappearance was 1.70 million bushels.

OLD CROP BARLEY stored in all positions on June 1, 1989 totaled 197 million bushels, down 39 percent from June 1, 1988. Of the total stocks, 84.6 million bushels were stored on-farms and 112 million bushels were stored off-farms. Indicated disappearance during the marketing year (June 1, 1988-May 31, 1989) was 415 million bushels compared with 544 million bushels for the same period a year earlier.

OLD CROP OAT stocks in all storage positions on June 1, 1989 totaled 98.3 million bushels, down 12 percent from June 1, 1988. On-farms stocks totaled 59.9 million bushels, down 22 percent from June 1, 1988. Off-farm stocks at 38.4 million bushels were up 9 percent from June 1, 1988. Indicated disappearance during the marketing year (June 1, 1988-May 31, 1989) was 232 million bushels compared with 395 million bushels for the comparable period a year earlier.

SORGHUM stored in all positions June 1, 1989 totaled 559 million bushels, down 31 percent from June 1, 1988. Of the total stocks, 473 million bushels, or 85 percent, were in off-farm storage. The indicated September 1988-May 1989 disappearance from all positions is 682 million bushels, up 1 percent from the comparable period a year ago.
