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HIGHLIGHTS

OLD CROP CORN stored in all positions on September 1, 1990, is estimated at 1.34 billion bushels, down 30 percent from September 1, 1989. Of the total stocks, 755 million bushels are stored on-farms, down 22 percent from a year earlier. Off-farm stocks, at 590 million bushels, are down 39 percent from last year. The indicated disappearance from all positions for the June-August quarter is 1.50 billion bushels, 1 percent above the disappearance for the same quarter last year.

OLD CROP SORGHUM in all positions on September 1, 1990, is estimated at 220 million bushels, down 50 percent from a year ago. Of the total, 189 million bushels were stored off-farms. The indicated disappearance from all positions for the June-August quarter is 115 million bushels, down 4 percent from the same period last year.

BARLEY stored in all positions on September 1, 1990, is estimated at 411 million bushels, down 1 percent from September 1, 1989. Of the total barley stocks on hand, 258 million are stored on farms, 2 percent above a year earlier. Off-farm stocks, at 152 million, are 7 percent below last year.

OLD CROP SOYBEANS stored in all positions totaled 239 million bushels on September 1, 31 percent above holdings a year ago, but 21 percent below September 1, 1988. On-farm stocks, at 86.0 million bushels, are 2 percent below last September and accounted for 36 percent of stocks in all positions on September 1, 1990. Off-farm holdings totaled 153 million bushels, 62 percent above September 1, 1989.

Indicated disappearance during the June-August 1990 quarter totaled 357 million bushels, 26 percent above June-August 1989.

ALL WHEAT stored on September 1, 1990, is estimated at 2.40 billion bushels, up 25 percent from September 1, 1989. On-farm stocks total 995 million bushels, up 20 percent from a year ago. Off-farm stocks, at 1.41 billion bushels, are up 30 percent from last year. The indicated first quarter disappearance from all positions is 890 million bushels, up 9 percent from the same period in 1989.

DURUM WHEAT stocks on September 1, 1990, are 131 million bushels, up 8 percent from last year. Farm stocks are placed at 99.8 million bushels, up 26 percent from September 1989. Off-farm storage totals 31.4 million bushels, down 26 percent from the previous year. The indicated June-August disappearance from all positions is 39.5 million bushels, up 29 percent from a year ago.

OAT STOCKS in all positions on September 1, 1990, totaled 353 million bushels. Of the total stocks, 236 million bushels are stored on-farms. Off-farm stocks totaled 117 million bushels.

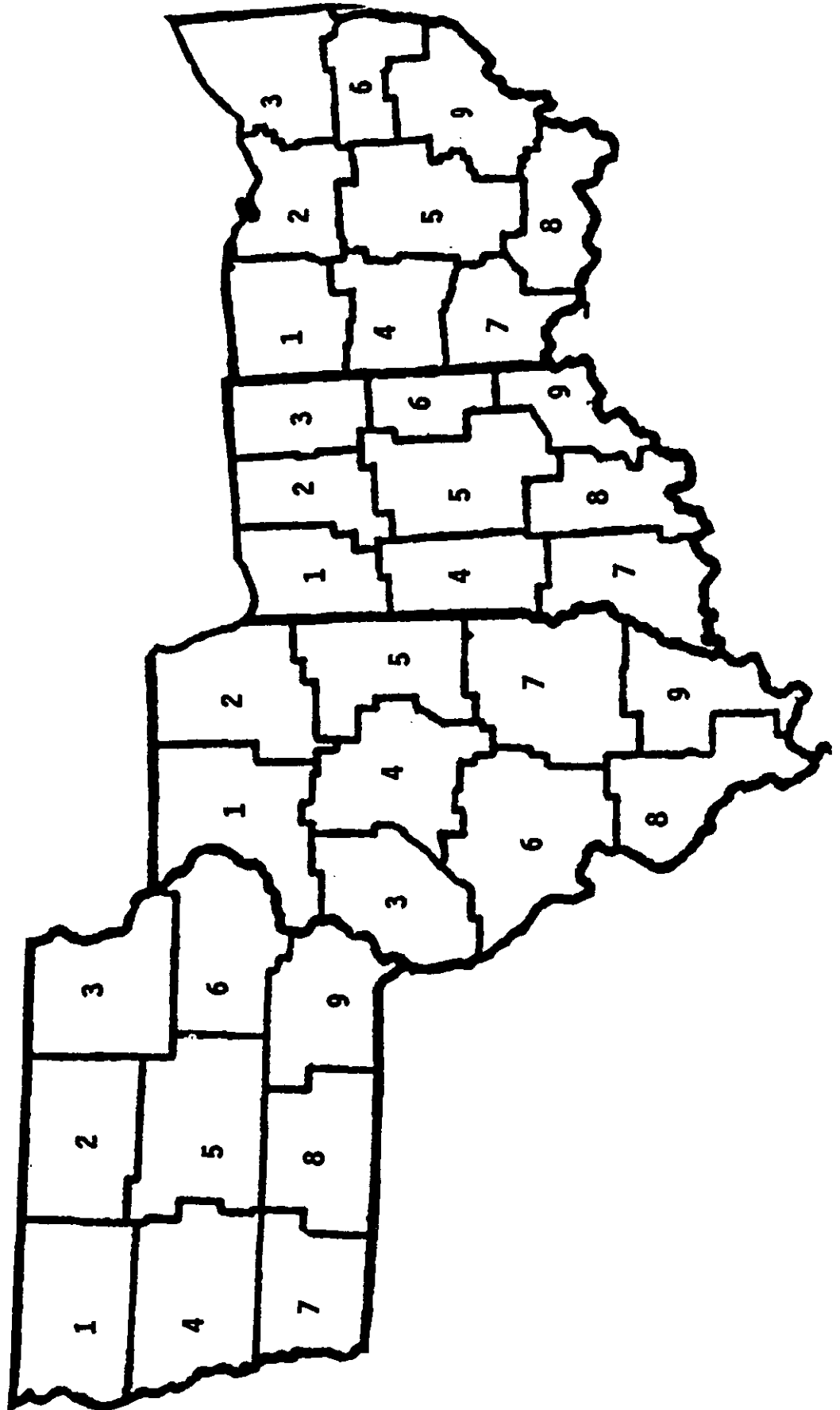
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SPECIAL SOYBEAN STOCKS SUMMARY

WASHINGTON, September 17--The National Agricultural Statistics Service (NASS) is frequently asked for additional detail about quantities of grain stored by district and county within States. Several recent studies of the mechanics of the commodity futures markets have intensified the number of such requests. Charles Caudill, the NASS Administrator, states that NASS is generally unable to respond to these requests because of the requirement to maintain confidentiality of reported data and because of budget restraints. However, due to the importance of the commodities markets studies, a one time effort was undertaken to provide estimates of soybean stocks by district for selected States and time periods. Some data were combined to preserve the confidentiality of individual operations or in cases where survey indications were not stable enough to make district estimates.

The following table shows quantities of on-farm and off-farm soybean stocks by selected agricultural statistics districts within Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, and Ohio for December 1, 1988, March 1, 1989, and June 1, 1989. Samples and data collection procedures were not designed with the intention of making district estimates. In some situations, the data were resummarized and individual reports were prorated to districts if the original data did not contain sufficient detail for proper allocation. Allocations to districts in these cases were based on production, storage capacity, and personal knowledge of operations. Data files for off-farm storage in Iowa for December 1 and March 1 were no longer available for this new summarization.
