Released June 30, 1992, by the Agricultural Statistics Board. Estimates refer to June 1, 1992.

Corn stored in all positions on June 1, 1992, is estimated at 2.74 billion bushels, down 8 percent from June 1, 1991. Of the total stocks, 1.52 billion bushels are stored on farms, down 14 percent from last year. Off-farm stocks, at 1.22 billion bushels, are down 1 percent from last year. The indicated disappearance from all positions for the March-May quarter is 1.82 billion bushels, 1 percent above the disappearance for the same quarter last year.

Old crop all wheat in all storage positions on June 1, 1992, totaled 472 million bushels, down 45 percent from June 1, 1991. This is the smallest June 1 stocks since 1975. Farm stocks total 145 million bushels, down 58 percent from last June 1. All wheat off-farm stocks are 328 million bushels, down 38 percent from a year ago. Indicated disappearance for March-May is 415 million bushels, off 22 percent from the same quarter in 1991.

Old crop durum wheat stored in all positions June 1, 1992, totaled 54.9 million bushels, off 12 percent from June 1991. On-farm stocks are 35.7 million bushels, down 18 percent from a year ago. Off-farm durum stocks total 19.2 million bushels, up 2 percent from last June 1. The indicated fourth quarter disappearance from all positions is 24.4 million bushels, up 21 percent from the same period a year ago.

Soybeans stored in all positions on June 1, 1992, totaled 696 million bushels, 4 percent below holdings a year ago but 17 percent above the stocks of June 1, 1990. On-farm stocks are estimated at 279 million bushels, 17 percent below last June and account for 40 percent of the total stocks on hand. Off-farm holdings, at 417 million bushels, are 8 percent above June 1, 1991.

Indicated disappearance during the March-May quarter, at 482 million bushels, compares with 467 million bushels for the same period last year. September-May disappearance is 12 percent above the 1990-91 comparable disappearance.



Barley stored in all positions on June 1, 1992, is estimated at 130 million bushels, 4 percent below the stocks of June 1, 1991. Of the total barley stocks on hand, 45.1 million are stored on farms, 8 percent below a year earlier. Off-farm stocks, at 84.9 million bushels, are down 2 percent from a year earlier. The March-May disappearance was 85.9 million bushels, up 14 percent from the same quarter last year.

Oats stored in all positions on June 1, 1992, totaled 127 million bushels, down 26 percent from June 1, 1991. Of the total oat stocks on hand, 61.0 million bushels are stored on farms, down 34 percent from last year. Off-farm stocks totaled 65.7 million bushels, down 17 percent from a year earlier. The March-May disappearance was 48.2 million bushels, down 17 percent from the same quarter a year ago.

Grain sorghum in all storage positions June 1, 1992, is estimated at 110 million bushels, off 50 percent from last June 1. On-farm stocks are 34.1 million bushels, down 22 percent from June 1991. A total of 76.2 million bushels are in off-farm storages. This is down 57 percent from 1991. The indicated disappearance for the quarter ending June 1, 1992, is 141 million bushels, up 27 percent from the comparable period last year.

Reliability of June 1, 1992, Grain Stocks Estimates

Survey Procedures: The grain stocks estimates in this report are based on surveys conducted during the first two weeks of June. Separate surveys were conducted to obtain the on-farm and off-farm estimates. The on-farm stocks survey included about 70,000 operators selected in a manner that ensures that all operations in the U.S. had a chance to be selected. These producers were asked to provide the total quantities of grain on their operations as of June 1, 1992. This included all whole grains and oilseeds stored whether for feed, seed, or sale as well as any stored under a Government program.

The off-farm stocks survey is an enumeration of all known commercial grain storage facilities. This includes approximately 13,000 facilities with about 9 billion bushels of storage capacity. An effort is made to obtain a report from every facility. Reports of stock holdings are normally received from operations covering about 90 percent of the capacity. Estimates are made for missing facilities to make the survey complete.

Estimation Procedures: On-farm and off-farm survey data are reviewed at the State and national levels for reasonableness, consistency with historical estimates, and current crop size. After estimates are made for on-farm and off-farm stock inventories, the total of these two are combined and evaluated using the balance sheet approach. This method utilizes other sources of data to measure the reasonableness of the stocks estimates. Estimates of production, imports, exports, crushings, millings, and all other recorded uses of grain and oilseeds are reviewed to make sure beginning stocks, production and utilization, and ending stocks are within reasonable balance and present the best possible estimate of stocks.

Revision Policy: On-farm and off-farm stocks are subject to revision the quarter following initial publication and again in the following December 1 Grain Stocks report published in January each year. Revisions can be made when late reports are received, errors are detected in reporting and calculating, and production estimates are revised. Estimates will also be reviewed after data for the 5-year Census of Agriculture, conducted by the Department of Commerce, are available. No revisions will be made after that date.

Reliability: Reliability of the on-farm and off-farm stocks must be treated separately because the survey design for the two surveys are drastically different. The on-farm stocks estimates are subject to sampling variability because all operations holding on-farm stocks are not included in the sample. This variability, as measured by the relative standard error at

the U.S. level, is approximately 1.5 percent for corn, 2.4 percent for soybeans, and 3.0 percent for all wheat. This means that chances are approximately 95 out of 100 that survey estimates for stocks will be within plus or minus 3.0 percent for corn, 4.8 percent for soybeans, and 6.0 percent for all wheat of the value that could be developed by averaging the estimates produced from all possible samples selected from the same population and surveyed using the same procedures. The relative standard errors of the estimates for barley, and oats are 4.0, and 3.6, respectively. Sampling errors cannot be applied directly to the on-farm stocks published in this report to determine confidence intervals since the Agricultural Statistics Board estimates represent a composite of information such as the balance sheet components.

Survey estimates are also subject to non sampling errors such as omission, duplication, imputation for missing data, and mistakes in reporting, recording, and processing the data. Off-farm, as well as on-farm stocks, are subject to these types of errors. These errors cannot be measured directly, but they are minimized through rigid quality controls in the data collection process and a careful review of all reported data for consistency and reasonableness.

New in this report: Beginning this year, end of year stock estimates are included for canola and rapeseed.
