Released January 12, 1993, by the Agricultural Statistics Board. Estimates refer to December 1, 1992.

Corn stocks in all positions on December 1, 1992, totaled 7.90 billion bushels, up 21 percent from last year. Of the total stocks, 5.74 billion bushels are stored on farms, 34 percent more than a year earlier. Off-farm stocks, at 2.16 billion bushels, are down 4 percent from last year.

The September-November 1992 indicated disappearance based on September stocks, 1992 production, and December stocks is 2.68 billion bushels, 9 percent above the disappearance of 2.46 billion bushels during the same period in 1991.

All wheat stored in all positions December 1, 1992, is estimated at 1.59 billion bushels, up 10 percent from December 1, 1991. On-farm stocks total 672 million bushels, up 19 percent from last December 1. Off-farm stocks are 917 million bushels, up 4 percent from last year. The September-November disappearance from all storage positions is 519 million bushels, down 13 percent from the same quarter in 1991.

Soybeans stored in all positions on December 1, 1992, totaled 1.83 billion bushels, up 3 percent from December 1, 1991. On-farm stocks, at 876 million bushels, were 8 percent above last December and accounted for 48 percent of total stocks. Off-farm holdings, at 958 million bushels, were 1 percent below a year ago.

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
Durum wheat stocks in all positions December 1, 1992, total 103 million bushels, up 1 percent from the previous December 1. Of the total, stocks on farms are 77.2 million bushels, down slightly from last year. Off-farm stocks are 25.3 million bushels, 5 percent from last December 1. The indicated second quarter disappearance is 8.82 million bushels, off 67 percent from same period last year.

Barley stored in all positions on December 1, 1992, is estimated at 348 million bushels, 6 percent above the stocks of December 1, 1991. Of the total barley stocks on hand, 198 million bushels are stored on farms, 1 percent above a year earlier. Off-farm stocks at 150 million bushels, are 14 percent above last year. Indicated disappearance during the September-November quarter totaled 70.0 million bushels, 37 percent below the same period in 1991.

Sorghum grain stocks in all positions December 1, 1992, are placed at 604 million bushels, up 34 percent from December 1, 1991. An estimated 211 million bushels are on farms. This is nearly twice that was on farms a year ago. Off-farm stocks, at 394 million bushels, are 16 percent more than last December 1. The disappearance from all storage positions for September-November 1992 is 333 million bushels, up 20 percent from the same quarter in 1991.

Oats stored in all positions on December 1, 1992, totaled 242 million bushels, 1 percent below December 1, 1991. Of the total oat stocks on hand, 161 million bushels are stored on farms, 9 percent above last year. Off-farm stocks totaled 81.2 million bushels, 16 percent below a year earlier. The indicated September-November disappearance from all positions is 52.2 million bushels, up 32 percent from a year earlier.

On-Farm Grain Storage Capacity

The United States on-farm grain storage capacity totaled 12.1 billion bushels on December 1, 1992, down 1 percent from December 1, 1991.

The National Agricultural Statistics Service collects on-farm grain storage capacity as part of the Agency's December Agricultural Survey. The capacity data are published for selected States and the United States, excluding Alaska and Hawaii. The data provide an indication of farm storage capacity with a range indicated by the sampling error. The measure of sampling error is expressed as a percent of the survey indications (coefficient of variation). When comparing the data from year to year, this survey variability must be taken into account.

Approximately 75,000 reports were included in the survey. At the U.S. level, the on-farm storage capacity of 12.1 billion bushels has a sampling error of .9 percent. This means that chances are 2 out of 3 that if the storage capacity indications from all possible samples were averaged together the results would be within plus or minus .9 percent of the 12.1 billion bushels.

Off-Farm Grain Storage Capacity Down 3 Percent

Capacity of off-farm commercial grain storage totaled 8.67 billion bushels in the United States on December 1, 1992, down 3 percent from December 1, 1991. Thirty-one States showed decreases from last year, 9 States and the New England States recorded increases in capacity and 1 was unchanged. The States showing the largest decreases were Minnesota, 41.8 million bushels; Nebraska, 35.0 million bushels; Kansas, 21.8 million bushels; and Texas, 12.3 billion bushels. North Dakota recorded the largest increase with 22.3 million bushels.

Illinois continued to lead all States in off-farm storage capacity, followed by Iowa, Texas, Kansas, and Nebraska. The top five States accounted for 53 percent of the Nation's off-farm storage capacity on December 1, 1992.

Off-farm grain storage capacity includes all elevators, warehouses, terminals, merchant mills, other storages, and oilseed crushers which store grains, soybeans, sunflower, or flaxseed. Capacity data exclude warehouses used to store only rice or peanuts, oilseed crushers processing only cottonseed or peanuts, tobacco warehouses, seed warehouses, and storages that handle only dry edible beans.

Off-Farm Grain Storage Facilities Decline

Off-farm grain storage facilities totaled 12,504 on December 1, 1992, 321 fewer than on December 1, 1991. States with the largest number of facilities are Illinois, 1,280; Kansas, 933; Texas, 855; Iowa, 760; Minnesota, 756; and Nebraska, 675.

Data users are advised that some differences may exist between the procedures for making counts of facilities. In a few instances, the count includes Headquarters operations which report for more than one facility. This does not affect the data on total capacity.

Reliability of December 1, 1992, Grain Stocks Estimates

Survey Procedures: The grain stocks estimates in this report are based on surveys conducted during the first two weeks of December. Separate surveys were conducted to obtain the on-farm and off-farm estimates. The on-farm stocks survey included about 75,000 operators selected in a manner that ensures that all operations in the U.S. had a chance to be selected. These producers were asked to provide the total quantities of grain on their operations as of December 1, 1992. This included all whole grains and oilseeds stored whether for feed, seed, or sale as well as any stored under a Government program.

The off-farm stocks survey is an enumeration of all known commercial grain storage facilities. This includes nearly 13,000 facilities with about 9 billion bushels of storage capacity. An effort is made to obtain a report from every facility. Reports of stock holdings are normally received from operations covering about 90 percent of the capacity. Estimates are made for missing facilities to make the survey complete.

Estimation Procedures: On-farm and off-farm survey data are reviewed at the State and national levels for reasonableness, consistency with historical estimates, and current crop size. After estimates are made for on-farm and off-farm stock inventories, the total of these two are combined and evaluated using the balance sheet approach. This method utilizes other sources of data to measure the reasonableness of the stocks estimates. Estimates of production, imports, exports, crushings, milling, and all other recorded uses of grain and oilseeds are reviewed to make sure beginning stocks, production and utilization, and ending stocks are within reasonable balance and present the best possible estimate of stocks.

Revision Policy: On-farm and off-farm stocks are subject to revision the quarter following initial publication and again in the following December 1 Grain Stocks report published in January each year. Revisions can be made when late reports are received, errors are detected in reporting and calculating, and production estimates are revised. Estimates will also be reviewed after data for the 5-year Census of Agriculture, conducted by the Department of Commerce, are available. No revisions will be made after that date.

Reliability: Reliability of the on-farm and off-farm stocks must be treated separately because the survey design for the two surveys are drastically different. The on-farm stocks estimates are subject to sampling variability because all operations holding on-farm stocks are not included in the sample. This variability, as measured by the relative standard error at the U.S. level, is approximately 1.2 percent for corn, 1.8 percent for soybeans, and 1.9 percent for all wheat. This means that chances are approximately 95 out of 100 that survey estimates for stocks will be within plus or minus 2.4 percent for corn, 3.6 percent for soybeans, and 3.8 percent for all wheat of the value that could be developed by averaging the estimates produced from all possible samples selected from the same population and surveyed using the same procedures. The relative standard errors of the

estimates for sorghum, barley, and oats are 6.1, 3.0, and 2.7, respectively. Sampling errors cannot be applied directly to the on-farm stocks published in this report to determine confidence intervals since the Agricultural Statistics Board estimates represent a composite of information such as the balance sheet components.

Survey estimates are also subject to non sampling errors such as omission, duplication, imputation for missing data, and mistakes in reporting, recording, and processing the data. Off-farm, as well as on-farm stocks, are subject to these types of errors. These errors cannot be measured directly, but they are minimized through rigid quality controls in the data collection process and a careful review of all reported data for consistency and reasonableness.

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
