Corn Stocks Down 25 Percent

Corn stocks in all positions on December 1, 1993, totaled 5.94 billion bushels, down 25 percent from last year. Of the total stocks, 3.80 billion bushels are stored on farms, 34 percent less than a year earlier. Off-farm stocks, at 2.13 billion bushels, are down 2 percent from the previous year.

The September-November 1993 indicated disappearance based on September stocks, 1993 production, and December stocks is 2.52 billion bushels, 6 percent below the disappearance of 2.68 billion bushels during the same period in 1992.

All wheat in all storage positions on December 1, 1993, totaled 1.59 billion bushels, down slightly from December 1, 1992. Of the total, 656 million bushels were stored on farms, down 2 percent from last December 1. Off-farm stocks are 930 million bushels, up 1 percent from last year. The September-November 1993 indicated disappearance is 540 million bushels, up 4 percent from the same quarter in 1992.

Soybeans stored in all positions on December 1, 1993, totaled 1.55 billion bushels, down 15 percent from December 1, 1992. On-farm stocks, at 677 million bushels, were 23 percent below last December and accounted for 44 percent of total stocks. Off-farm holdings, at 877 million bushels, were 9 percent below a year ago.


Durum wheat stored in all positions December 1, 1993, is estimated at 76.2 million bushels, down 26 percent from December 1, 1992. On-farm stocks are 50.5 million bushels, down 35 percent from last December 1. Off-farm stocks, at 25.7 million bushels, are up 1 percent from a year ago. The indicated second quarter disappearance is 28.6 million bushels.

Barley stored in all positions on December 1, 1993, is estimated at 334 million bushels, down 4 percent from the stocks of December 1, 1992. Of the total barley stocks on hand, 194 million bushels are stored on farms, 2 percent below a year earlier. Off-farm stocks at 140 million bushels, are 6 percent below last year. Indicated disappearance during the September-November quarter totaled 69.0 million bushels, 4 percent below the disappearance for the same period in 1992.

Grain sorghum stocks in all positions December 1, 1993, are estimated to total 449 million bushels, down 26 percent from December 1, 1992. Stocks on farms are 109 million bushels, down 48 percent from last December 1. Off-farm stocks are 340 million bushels, down 14 percent from last year. The apparent September-November 1993 disappearance is 294 million bushels, 11 percent less than the same period in 1992.

Oats stored in all positions on December 1, 1993, totaled 194 million bushels, 20 percent below December 1, 1992. Of the total oat stocks on hand, 124 million bushels are stored on farms, 23 percent below last year. Off-farm stocks totaled 69.5 million bushels, 14 percent below a year earlier. The indicated September-November disappearance from all positions is 25.3 million bushels, down 51 percent from a year earlier.

**On-Farm Grain Storage Capacity
Down 4 Percent**

The United States on-farm grain storage capacity totaled 11.6 billion bushels on December 1, 1993, down 4 percent from December 1, 1992. Iowa leads all States in on-farm storage capacity with 1.70 billion bushels followed by Minnesota with 1.33 billion bushels; Illinois, 1.20 billion bushels; Nebraska, 1.00 billion bushels; and North Dakota at 810 million bushels. The top 5 States account for 52 percent of the Nation's on-farm grain storage capacity.

On-farm grain storage capacity includes all bins, cribs, sheds, and other structures normally used to store whole grains or oilseeds located on farms.

Off-Farm Grain Storage Capacity Down 2 Percent

Capacity of off-farm commercial grain storage totaled 8.49 billion bushels in the United States on December 1, 1993, down 2 percent from December 1, 1992. Twenty-three States and New England showed decreases from last year, 16 States recorded increases in capacity and one was unchanged. The States showing the largest decreases were Nebraska, 42.9 million bushels; Texas, 41.9 million bushels; Kansas, 25.5 million bushels; Indiana, 16.8 million bushels; and California, 11.1 million bushels. Iowa recorded the largest increase with 10.3 million bushels.

Illinois continued to lead all States in off-farm storage capacity, followed by Iowa, Texas, Kansas, and Nebraska. The top five States accounted for 53 percent of the Nation's off-farm storage capacity on December 1, 1993.

Off-farm grain storage capacity includes all elevators, warehouses, terminals, merchant mills, other storages, and oilseed crushers which store grains, soybeans, sunflower, or flaxseed. Capacity data exclude warehouses used to store only rice or peanuts, oilseed crushers processing only cottonseed or peanuts, tobacco warehouses, seed warehouses, and storages that handle only dry edible beans.

Off-Farm Grain Storage Facilities

Off-farm grain storage facilities totaled 11,818 on December 1, 1993, 610 fewer than on December 1, 1992. States with the largest number of facilities are Illinois, 1,165; Kansas, 912; Texas, 829; Iowa, 720; Minnesota, 716; and Nebraska, 602.

Data users are advised that some differences may exist between the procedures for making counts of facilities. In a few instances, the count includes Headquarters operations which report for more than one facility. This does not affect the data on total capacity.

Reliability of December 1, 1993, Grain Stocks Estimates

Survey Procedures: The grain stocks estimates in this report are based on surveys conducted during the first two weeks of December. Separate surveys were conducted to obtain the on-farm and off-farm estimates. The on-farm stocks survey included about 70,000 operators selected in a manner that ensures that all operations in the U.S. had a chance to be selected. These producers were asked to provide the total quantities of grain on their operations as of December 1, 1993. This included all whole grains and oilseeds stored whether for feed, seed, or sale as well as any stored under a Government program.

The off-farm stocks survey is an enumeration of all known commercial grain storage facilities. This includes approximately 12,000 facilities with about 8.5 billion bushels of storage capacity. An effort is made to obtain a report from every facility. Reports of stock holdings are normally received from operations covering about 90 percent of the capacity. Estimates are made for missing facilities to make the survey complete.

Estimation Procedures: On-farm and off-farm survey data are reviewed at the State and national levels for reasonableness, consistency with historical estimates, and current crop size. After estimates are made for on-farm and off-farm stock inventories, the total of these two are combined and evaluated using the balance sheet approach. This method utilizes other sources of data to measure the reasonableness of the stocks estimates. Estimates of production, imports, exports, crushings, milling, and all other recorded uses of grain and oilseeds are reviewed to make sure beginning stocks, production and utilization, and ending stocks are within reasonable balance and present the best possible estimate of stocks.

Revision Policy: On-farm and off-farm stocks are subject to revision the quarter following initial publication and again in the following December 1 Grain Stocks report published in January each year. Revisions can be made when late reports are received, errors are detected in reporting and calculating, and production estimates are revised. Estimates will also be reviewed after data for the 5-year Census of Agriculture, conducted by the Department of Commerce, are available. No revisions will be made after that date.

Reliability: Reliability of the on-farm and off-farm stocks must be treated separately because the survey design for the two surveys are drastically different. The on-farm stocks estimates are subject to sampling variability because all operations holding on-farm stocks are not included in the sample. This variability, as measured by the relative standard error at the U.S. level, is approximately 1.1 percent for corn, 1.7 percent for soybeans, and 2.6 percent for all wheat. This means that chances are approximately 95 out of 100 that survey estimates for stocks will be within plus or minus 2.2 percent for corn, 3.4 percent for soybeans, and 5.2 percent for all wheat of the value that could be developed by averaging the estimates produced from all possible samples selected from the same population and surveyed using the same procedures. The relative standard errors of the

estimates for sorghum, barley, and oats are 5.6, 3.6, and 2.8, respectively. Sampling errors cannot be applied directly to the on-farm stocks published in this report to determine confidence intervals since the Agricultural Statistics Board estimates represent a composite of information such as the balance sheet components.

Survey estimates are also subject to non sampling errors such as omission, duplication, imputation for missing data, and mistakes in reporting, recording, and processing the data. Off-farm, as well as on-farm stocks, are subject to these types of errors. These errors cannot be measured directly, but they are minimized through rigid quality controls in the data collection process and a careful review of all reported data for consistency and reasonableness.
