Corn Stocks Down 36 Percent

Corn stocks in all positions on June 1, 1994, totaled 2.36 billion bushels, 36 percent below a year earlier. Of the total stocks, 1.20 billion bushels are stored on farms, 46 percent less than last year. Off-farm stocks, at 1.16 billion bushels, are down 23 percent from last year.

The March-May 1994 indicated disappearance is 1.64 billion bushels, 17 percent below the disappearance of 1.97 billion bushels during the same period a year earlier.

Old crop all wheat stocks on June 1, 1994, are estimated at 571 million bushels, up 8 percent from June 1, 1993. Farm stocks are 177 million bushels, down 4 percent from a year ago. Off-farm stocks total 394 million bushels, up 14 percent. The fourth quarter all wheat disappearance is 451 million bushels, down 12 percent from the same three months in 1993.

Soybeans stored in all positions on June 1, 1994, totaled 555 million bushels, 19 percent below holdings a year ago and 20 percent below the stocks of June 1, 1992. On-farm stocks are estimated at 195 million bushels, 39 percent below last June and account for 35 percent of the total stocks on hand. Off-farm holdings, at 360 million bushels, are 1 percent below June 1, 1993.

Indicated disappearance during the March-May quarter, at 454 million bushels, compares with 532 million bushels for the same period last year. September-May disappearance is 13 percent below the 1992-93 comparable disappearance.

Barley stored in all positions on June 1, 1994, totaled 138 million bushels, 9 percent below the stocks of June 1, 1993. Of the total barley stocks on hand, 63.9 million bushels were stored on farms. 6 percent below a year earlier. Off-farm stocks, at 74.4 million bushels, were 10 percent below last year. Indicated disappearance during the March-May quarter totaled 86.1 million bushels, 7 percent below the same period a year earlier.

Oats stored in all positions on June 1, 1994, totaled 106 million bushels. 7 percent below the stocks of June 1, 1993. Of the total oat stocks on hand, 53.9 million bushels were stored on farms, 18 percent below last year. Offfarm stocks totaled 51.6 million bushels, 10 percent above a year earlier. The indicated March-May disappearance from all positions is 41.0 million bushels, down 34 percent from a year earlier.

Old crop durum wheat stocks on June 1, 1994, are estimated at 29.2 million bushels, down 40 percent from last June. These are the lowest June 1 durum stocks since 1976.

Grain sorghum stocks in all positions June 1, 1994, total 128 million bushels, down 52 percent from the June 1, 1993, inventory. Off-farm stocks are down 53 percent from last year at 96.0 million bushels; farm storages, at 31.8 million bushels, are down 46 percent. The apparent March-May disappearance from all positions is 148 million bushels, off 13 percent from the comparable period a year ago.

Reliability of June 1, 1994, Grain Stocks Estimates

Survey Procedures: The grain stocks estimates in this report are based on surveys conducted during the first two weeks of June. Separate surveys were conducted to obtain the on-farm and off-farm estimates. The on-farm stocks survey included about 70,000 operators selected in a manner that ensures that all operations in the U.S. had a chance to be selected. These producers were asked to provide the total quantities of grain on their operations as of June 1, 1994. This included all whole grains and oilseeds stored whether for feed, seed, or sale as well as any stored under a Government program.

The off-farm stocks survey is an enumeration of all known commercial grain storage facilities. This includes nearly 12,000 facilities with about 8.50 billion bushels of storage capacity. An effort is made to obtain a report from every facility. Reports of stock holdings are normally received from operations covering about 90 percent of the capacity. Estimates are made for missing facilities to make the survey complete.

Estimation Procedures: On-farm and off-farm survey data are reviewed at the State and national levels for reasonableness, consistency with historical estimates, and current crop size. After estimates are made for on-farm and off-farm stock inventories, the total of these two are combined and evaluated using the balance sheet approach. This method utilizes other sources of data to measure the reasonableness of the stocks estimates. Estimates of production, imports, exports, crushings, milling, and all other recorded uses of grain and oilseeds are reviewed to make sure beginning stocks, production and utilization, and ending stocks are within reasonable balance and present the best possible estimate of stocks.

Revision Policy: On-farm and off-farm stocks are subject to revision the quarter following initial publication and again in the following December 1 "Grain Stocks" report published in January each year. Revisions can be made when late reports are received, errors are detected in reporting and calculating, and production estimates are revised. Estimates will also be reviewed after data for the 5-year Census of Agriculture, conducted by the Department of Commerce, are available. No revisions will be made after that date.

Reliability: Reliability of the on-farm and off-farm stocks must be treated separately because the survey design for the two surveys are drastically different. The on-farm stocks estimates are subject to sampling variability because all operations holding on-farm stocks are not included in the sample. This variability, as measured by the relative standard error at the U.S. level, is approximately 1.4 percent for corn, 2.9 percent for soybeans, and 4.0 percent for all wheat. This means that chances are approximately 95 out of 100 that survey estimates for stocks will be within plus or minus 2.8 percent for corn, 5.8 percent for soybeans, and 8.0 percent for all wheat of the value that could be developed by averaging the estimates produced from all possible samples selected from the same population and surveyed using the same procedures. The relative standard errors of the

estimates for sorghum, barley, and oats are 6.4, 3.8, and 3.5, respectively. Sampling errors cannot be applied directly to the on-farm stocks published in this report to determine confidence intervals since the Agricultural Statistics Board estimates represent a composite of information such as the balance sheet components.

Survey estimates are also subject to non-sampling errors such as omission, duplication, imputation for missing data, and mistakes in reporting, recording, and processing the data. Off-farm, as well as on-farm stocks, are subject to these types or errors. These errors cannot be measured directly, but they are minimized through rigid quality controls in the data collection process and a careful review of all reported data for consistency and reasonableness.
