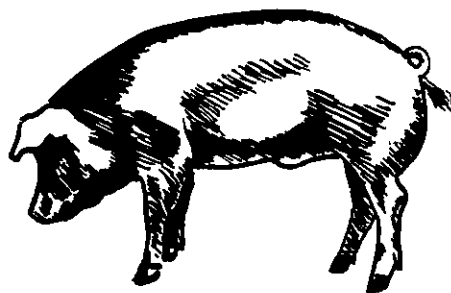


HOGS AND PIGS

JUNE 1968 (U.S. and 10 Corn Belt States)

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The June 1, 1968 inventory of all hogs and pigs on farms in the United States is estimated at 59.0 million head, according to the Crop Reporting Board. This was 1 percent less than the 59.4 million head on farms a year earlier. Hogs kept for breeding purposes totaled 8.9 million, down 1 percent. The remainder kept for other purposes totaled 50.1 million, a decrease of 1 percent.

The December-May pig crop totaled 47.7 million head, down 1 percent from the 48.2 million head for the same period a year earlier. A total of 6.5 million sows farrowed in this period, 1 percent less than the 6.6 million a year earlier. The number of pigs per litter averaged 7.36 compared with 7.34 last year.

Hog producers indicated on June 1 they intended to farrow 6.0 million sows during June-November 1968, an increase of 2 percent from the 5.9 million sows farrowed during the same period last year. If carried out as intended and if pigs per litter equal the average adjusted with an allowance for trend, the June-November 1968 pig crop will be 44.1 million head, 2 percent more than last year. The 1968 pig crop (December 1967 through November 1968) would be 91.8 million head, slightly above 1967.

HOGS AND PIGS ON FARMS JUNE 1, 1968

Hogs on farms on June 1, 1968 totaled 59,014,000 head, a decrease of 1 percent from June 1, 1967. Hogs and pigs kept for breeding totaled 8,897,000 head, 1 percent below a year earlier. Other hogs and pigs at 50,117,000 head, were down 1 percent. By weight group classification, the number of other hogs and pigs on hand June 1, 1968 and the percentage change from the previous year are: less than 60 pounds, 25,373,000 head, down 3 percent; 60-119 pounds, 11,608,000 head, down 2 percent; 120-179 pounds, 7,616,000 head, up 3 percent; 180-219 pounds, 4,095,000 head, up 8 percent; and 220 pounds and heavier, 1,425,000 head, up 11 percent.

In the 10 Corn Belt States--Ohio, Indiana, Illinois, Wisconsin, Minnesota, Iowa, Missouri, South Dakota, Nebraska, and Kansas-- the June 1 number of hogs and pigs totaled 45,406,000 head, 1 percent below last year. Breeding hogs, at 6,674,000 head, decreased 1 percent. Other hogs, at 38,732,000 head, were also down 1 percent. In Iowa, the leading State in hog production, the number of hogs and pigs on hand totaled 14,719,000 head, down 4 percent from the same date a year earlier. Other leading States showing decreases were Indiana, 4 percent; Illinois, 3 percent; Wisconsin, 2 percent; and Ohio 1 percent. The decreases were partly offset by increases of 7 percent in Nebraska and Kansas, 6 percent in South Dakota, 3 percent in Minnesota and 2 percent in Missouri. The 10 Corn Belt States accounted for 77 percent of total U. S. inventory of hogs and pigs on June 1, the same as a year earlier.

DECEMBER 1967-MAY 1968 FIG CROP DOWN 1 PERCENT

The U. S. pig crop December 1967 through May 1968 totaled 47,712,000 head, 1 percent less than the 48,204,000 a year earlier. Regional declines from a year earlier were: North Atlantic, 1 percent; East North Central, 4 percent; South Atlantic, 1 percent; and Western region, 4 percent. The crop in the South Central region gained 2 percent and the West North Central region was unchanged.

Sows farrowing during the December 1967-February 1968 quarter totaled 2,493,000 head, up 2 percent from the year earlier period. During the March-May 1968 quarter, 3,988,000 sows farrowed, a decline of 3 percent from a year earlier.

The December-May percentage decline in sows farrowing was the same as indicated by farmers' intentions last December.

The average number of pigs per litter was 7.36 for the December-May period compared with 7.34 a year earlier. Average litter size for the period increased in the West North Central and Western regions, but was lower in the East North Central, South Atlantic and South Central regions and unchanged in the North Atlantic region.

The December 1967-February 1968 pig crop in the 10 Corn Belt States totaled 12,719,000 head, down less than 1 percent from a year earlier. Sows farrowing in the 10 States during the period totaled 1,747,000 head, 2,000 head more than a year earlier. Pigs per litter averaged 7.28 compared with 7.32 in the year-earlier period.

The March-May 1968 pig crop in the 10 Corn Belt States totaled 24,168,000, down 2 percent from the 24,544,000 head for the same period of 1967. Sows farrowing in the 10 States totaled 3,234,000 head, 3 percent less than a year earlier. Pigs per litter averaged 7.47 compared with 7.37 a year earlier.

JUNE-NOVEMBER INTENTIONS

June 1 reports from farmers on breeding intentions indicate that 5,962,000 sows will farrow in the United States during June-November 1968, 2 percent more than the year-earlier period and 5 percent above average. The East North Central and Western regions were unchanged, but farrowings in other regions are expected to increase as follows: South Central States, 1 percent; North Atlantic and South Atlantic each 2 percent; West North Central, 3 percent.

If June-November farrowings are as intended and pigs per litter equal the average plus an allowance for trend, the crop for the period will total 44,100,000 head, 2 percent above a year earlier.

Sows bred and intended for farrowing in 10 Corn Belt States during June-August 1968 total 2,280,000 head, 2 percent more than a year earlier. Farrowings in Ohio, Illinois, and South Dakota are expected to decrease, while Indiana and Wisconsin are unchanged. The other 5 States showed gains ranging from 1 percent in Missouri to 11 percent in Nebraska.

Reported intentions are for 2,260,000 sows to farrow during the September-November quarter in the 10 States. This would be 2 percent more than a year earlier. Farrowings are expected to decrease only in Missouri and South Dakota.

Several changes have been made in the June 1 Hogs and Pigs report. The name, Pig Crop Report, was changed to Hogs and Pigs. Estimates of numbers of hogs and pigs on farms as of June 1 are included for all 50 States for 1964 through 1968, and will be a regular part of the June report. U. S., regional, and 10-State estimates on monthly farrowings, previously published, have been discontinued.
