MARCH 1972 (10 Corn Belt States)

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Hogs and pigs on farms March 1 in the 10 Corn Belt States are estimated at 41.8 million head - 6 percent less than a year earlier, according to the Crop Reporting Board. Hogs for breeding at 6.5 million are down 8 percent while market hogs at 35.3 million are off 6 percent from March 1971. The 10 Corn Belt States include Ohio, Indiana, Illinois, Wisconsin, Minnesota, Iowa, Missouri, South Dakota, Nebraska and Kansas.

The December-February 1972 pig crop, estimated at 13.3 million, is 6 percent below last year. A 10 percent decrease in sows farrowing was partially offset by a 4 percent rise in average litter rate.

Hog producers in the 10 States currently intend to farrow 7 percent fewer hogs during both March-May and June-August than in the same periods a year earlier.

INVENTORY DOWN 6 PERCENT

The March 1 inventory is estimated at 41,792,000, down 6 percent from last year, with all States down except Indiana and Missouri which were virtually unchanged from 1971. Decreases range from 2 percent in Illinois to 14 percent in Nebraska and South Dakota, with Iowa down 7 percent. Hogs kept for breeding, at 6,449,000, were down 8 percent.

Market hogs are estimated at 35,343,000, down 6 percent from last year. All weight groups are below a year ago. By weight groups the March 1, 1972 number on hand and decreases from last year are as follows: Under 60 pounds--12,418,000, down 726,000; 60-119 pounds--7,833,000, down 286,000; 120-179 pounds--8,814,000, down 681,000; 180-219 pounds--5,257,000, down 355,000; 220 pounds and over--1,021,000, down 77,000 head.

DECEMBER-FEBRUARY PIG CROP DOWN 6 PERCENT

Sows farrowing during December 1971-February 1972 totaled 1,822,000, 10 percent below a year earlier. The average litter rate was 7.30 compared to 6.99 in 1971 and 7.22 in 1970. All 10 States farrowed fewer sows than a year ago with the largest decline in Nebraska, down 19 percent. The pig crop at 13,297,000 head was 6 percent below a year earlier.

MARCH-MAY INTENTIONS DOWN 7 PERCENT

Hog producers in the 10 States intend to farrow 3,082,000 sows during March-May, 7 percent fewer than last year. All 10 States show declines with the largest drop, 13 percent, in South Dakota. Iowa, the Nation's leading hog producing State, is down 7 percent.

JUNE-AUGUST INTENTIONS DOWN 7 PERCENT

The first intentions estimate of sows to farrow June-August in the 10 States is 2,158,000 head, 7 percent below 1971. Kansas, with no change, is the only State not expecting a decline. The declines range from 4 to 16 percent with Iowa 7 percent below last year.
