Hogs and pigs on U.S. farms December 1, 1973 are estimated at 61.0 million, 3 percent more than a year earlier, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

- Number kept for breeding at 8.7 million is virtually the same.
- Market hogs and pigs, at about 52.4 million, are up 4 percent.
- By weight groups, market hogs and pigs on Dec. 1, 1973 and the comparison with a year earlier:

- Less than 60 pounds - 20.3 million, up 5 percent
- 60-119 pounds - 13.8 million, up 2 percent
- 120-179 pounds - 10.3 million, up slightly
- 180-219 pounds - 6.2 million, up 6 percent
- 220 pounds and over - 1.8 million, up 8 percent

The 10 Corn Belt States had 46.7 million, up 5 percent from a year earlier, accounting for 77 percent of all hogs and pigs in the U.S. inventory.

The 14 quarterly States had 52.7 million, 4 percent above a year ago.

1973 PIG CROP

At 88.1 million, the pig crop from December 1972 through November 1973 was down 3 percent from a year earlier.

- December 1972 - May 1973 pig crop at 46.2 million was down 3 percent.
- June 1973 - November 1973 pig crop at 41.9 million was also down 3 percent.

The 5.9 million sows farrowed during June-November 1973 was down 2 percent from the same period a year earlier. Average litter size during June-November 1973 was 7.16 pigs compared with 7.24 a year ago.

The following changes will occur in the March 1974 Hogs and Pigs Report.

- Totals will not appear for the 10 Corn Belt States, only for the 14 quarterly States.
- The 10 quarterly States balance sheet will be discontinued.

The pig crop in the 10 Corn Belt States for June-August was 15.7 million, down 4 percent. For September-November 1973 it was 16.3 million, down 2 percent.

The 14 quarterly States pig crop for June-August 1973 was 17.8 million. The September-November 1973 pig crop total was 18.3 million. No comparisons are available for earlier periods.

FARROWING INTENTIONS

Hog producers intend to farrow 6.5 million sows during December 1973-May 1974, an increase of less than 1 percent from that period last year.

These intentions, and allowances for projected litter size indicate a pig crop of 46.7 million, up 1 percent from a year earlier.

Intentions in the 10 Corn Belt States are for 1.9 million sows to farrow December 1973-February 1974, up 1 percent. March through May 1974 intentions in the Corn Belt are virtually unchanged at 3.0 million sows. The 14 quarterly States totals for the same two periods in 1974 are 2.3 million and 3.3 million sows, respectively.
