JUNE 1 INVENTORY

Hogs and pigs on U. S. farms June 1, 1974 are estimated at 59.4 million, 1 percent less than a year earlier and 2 percent below June 1, 1972, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

- Number kept for breeding at 8.9 million is down 2 percent
- Market hogs and pigs, at 50.5 million, is down 1 percent
- By weight groups, market hogs and pigs on June 1, 1974 and the comparison with a year earlier:
 - Less than 60 pounds - 23.9 million, down 3 percent
 - 60-119 pounds - 12.2 million, up 1 percent
 - 120-179 pounds - 7.8 million, down 4 percent
 - 180-219 pounds - 5.0 million, up 3 percent
 - 220 pounds and over - 1.7 million, up 31 percent

The 14 Quarterly States had 51.1 million, down 1 percent from a year earlier, accounting for 86 percent of all hogs and pigs in the U. S. inventory.

DECEMBER - MAY PIG CROP

At 45.1 million, the pig crop from December 1973 through May 1974 was down 2 percent from a year earlier and down 5 percent from two years ago.

The 6.4 million sows farrowed during this period was down 1 percent from the same period a year earlier. Average litter size during December 1973-May 1974 was 7.07 pigs compared with 7.15 a year ago.

The pig crop in the 14 Quarterly States for December 1973 - February 1974 was 15.6 million, down 3 percent. For March-May 1974, it was 23.1 million, down 3 percent.

FARROWING INTENTIONS

Hogs producers intend to farrow 5.8 million sows during June - November 1974, 2 percent below that period last year and down 3 percent from 1972.

These intentions, and allowances for projected litter size indicate a pig crop of 41.5 million, down 1 percent from a year earlier.

Intentions in the 14 Quarterly States are for 2.5 million sows to farrow June-August 1974, down 2 percent. September through November 1974 intentions in the Quarterly States are also down 2 percent at 2.5 million sows.
