INVENTORY 1 PERCENT HIGHER: Inventory of hogs and pigs on June 1, 1980 in the U.S. was estimated at 65.9 million head, 1 percent above last year, 19 percent larger than 1978 and the largest June 1 inventory of record, according to the Crop Reporting Board.

-- Breeding inventory, at 9.53 million head, was 8 percent less than a year ago, but 7 percent above two years earlier.

-- Market hog inventory, at 56.4 million head, was 3 percent larger than 1979 and 22 percent greater than 1978.

The 14 Quarterly States estimate was about 84 percent of the U.S. total inventory. These States, with 55.1 million head, were 1 percent below last year, but 17 percent above two years ago.

PIG CROP (DECEMBER 1979-MAY 1980): The December 1979-May 1980 U.S. pig crop was 53.0 million head, a 5 percent increase from last year and 25 percent more than two years ago.

Sows farrowed during this 6-month period at 7.33 million were 2 percent more than those farrowed last year. Pigs saved per litter at 7.23 were well above the 1978 and 1979 levels of 7.04 and 7.05, respectively.

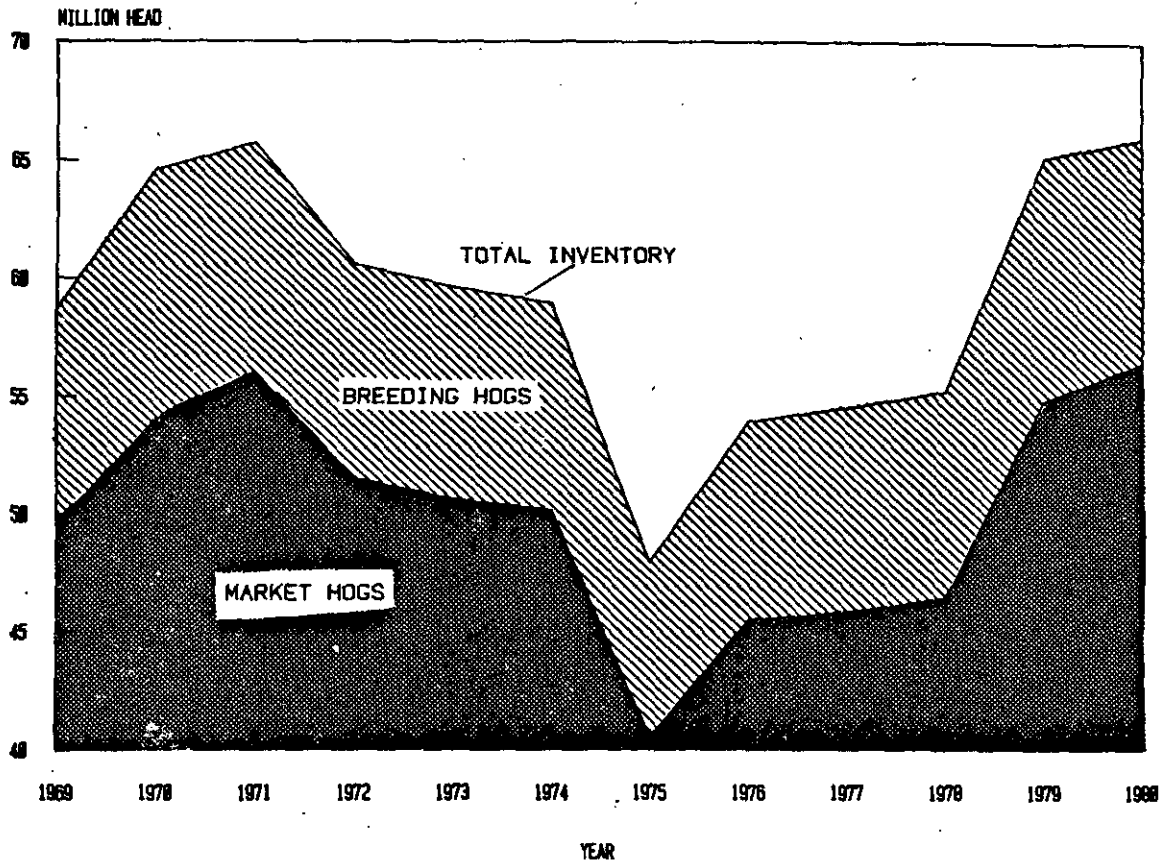
In the 14 Quarterly States, the December-May pig crop was 44.5 million head, 3 percent above last year. The December-February pig crop at 19.7 million head was 8 percent greater than last year, but the March-May total, at 24.9 million head, was down 1 percent from the year earlier period.

FARROWING INTENTIONS: U.S. producers intend to have 6.72 million sows farrow during the June-November period, a decrease of 8 percent from the same period in 1979 but 5 percent above 1978.

Intentions in the 14 Quarterly States for June-August are 2.89 million sows, down 9 percent from the corresponding period in 1979 and 6 percent below the March 1, 1980 intentions. For the September-November quarter in these States the farrowing intentions at 2.73 million sows are 10 percent below the comparable quarter in 1979.

RELIABILITY AND ESTIMATING PROCEDURES: Primary data used in setting these hog estimates were obtained from a sample of farmers across the U.S. using probability surveys. Information was collected by mail, telephone and personal interviews. Since all operations raising hogs were not included in the sample, survey estimates are subject to sampling variability. This variability, as measured by the relative standard error, is about two percent at the U.S. level for hog inventory. This means that chances are approximately 95 out of 100 that survey estimates will be within four percent of the complete coverage value if the same procedures were used to survey all producers. Survey estimates are also subject to non-sampling errors such as omissions, duplications, and mistakes in reporting, recording and processing the data. These errors cannot be measured directly, but they are minimized through rigid quality controls in the data collection process and a careful review of all reported data for consistency and reasonableness.

The sampling variability of survey estimates on intended farrowings is slightly larger than that for inventories. More important, actual farrowings may differ significantly from reported intentions due to unexpected economic and environmental conditions. These differences have exceeded four percent for about one-third of the quarterly pig crops during the last six years.

In setting the inventory estimates, the Crop Reporting Board constructed a U.S. balance sheet using estimates on births, deaths and check data on slaughter, imports and exports. This balance sheet provided an additional check on survey inventory estimates.

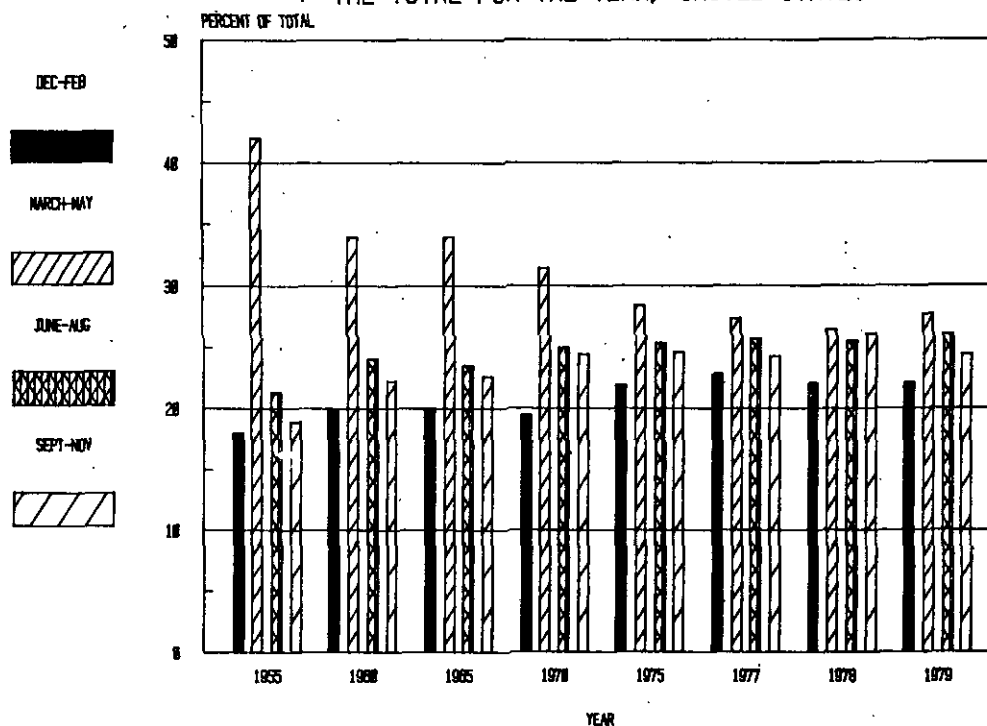
