

HOGS AND PIGS

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Revisions for 1980 and 1981:

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INVENTORY DOWN 8 PERCENT: Inventory of all hogs and pigs in the U.S. is estimated at 59.7 million head on June 1, 1981, according to the Crop Reporting Board. This is 8 percent below both a year ago and 1979, but 8 percent above June 1, 1978.

--Breeding inventory at 8.36 million head was 12 percent less than a year ago, and 19 percent below two years earlier.

--Market hog inventory, at 51.4 million head was 8 percent less than a year ago, and 6 percent less than in 1979.

Estimates for the 14 Quarterly States account for about 86 percent of the U.S. total inventory. These States, with 51.2 million head, were 7 percent less than last year and 8 percent below 1979, but 8 percent above 1978.

PIG CROP: The December 1980 - May 1981 U.S. pig crop was 47.6 million head, a 9 percent decrease from last year and 6 percent below two years ago.

Sows farrowing during this 6 month period at 6.44 million were 11 percent fewer than last year. Pigs saved per litter at 7.39 topped the previous record high of 7.37 in 1968 and was well above the 1979 and 1980 figures of 7.04 and 7.23 respectively. Extremely favorable weather conditions during this period contributed to the excellent farrowing rate.

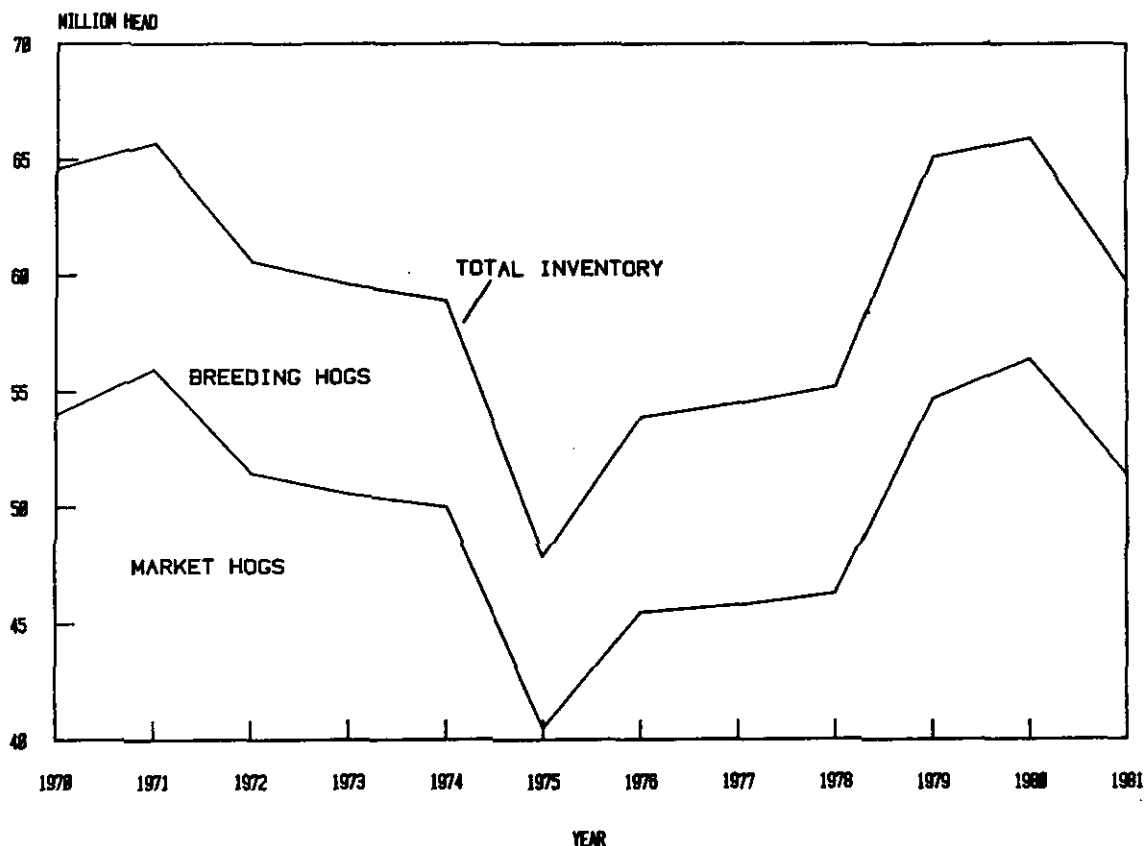
In the 14 Quarterly States, the December-May pig crop was 40.8 million head, 8 percent below last year. The December-February pig crop at 17.6 million head was 10 percent below last year, and the March-May total, at 23.2 million head was down 6 percent from a year earlier.

FARROWING INTENTIONS: U.S. producers intend to have 6.05 million sows farrow during the June-November period, a decrease of 11 percent from the same period in 1980 and 17 percent fewer than in 1979.

Intentions in the 14 Quarterly States for June-August are 2.64 million sows, down 7 percent from the corresponding period in 1980 but 1 percent above the March 1, 1981, intentions estimate. September-November quarter farrowing intentions at 2.60 million sows are 11 percent below the comparable quarter in 1980.

RELIABILITY AND ESTIMATING PROCEDURES: Primary data used in setting these hog estimates were obtained from a sample of farmers across the U.S. using probability surveys. Information was collected by mail, telephone and personal interviews. Since all operations raising hogs were not included in the sample, survey estimates are subject to sampling variability. This variability, as measured by the relative standard error, is about two percent at the U.S. level for hog inventory. This means that chances are approximately 95 out of 100 that survey estimates will be within four percent of the complete coverage value if the same procedures were used to survey all producers. Survey estimates are also subject to non-sampling errors such as omissions, duplications, and mistakes in reporting, recording and processing the data. These errors cannot be measured directly, but they are minimized through rigid quality controls in the data collection process and a careful review of all reported data for consistency and reasonableness.

The sampling variability of survey estimates on intended farrowings is slightly larger than that for inventories. More important, actual farrowings may differ significantly from reported intentions due to unexpected economic and environmental conditions. These differences have exceeded four percent for about one-third of the quarterly pig crops during the last seven years.

In setting the inventory estimates, the Crop Reporting Board constructed a U.S. balance sheet using estimates on births, deaths and check data on slaughter, imports and exports. This balance sheet provided an additional check on survey inventory estimates.

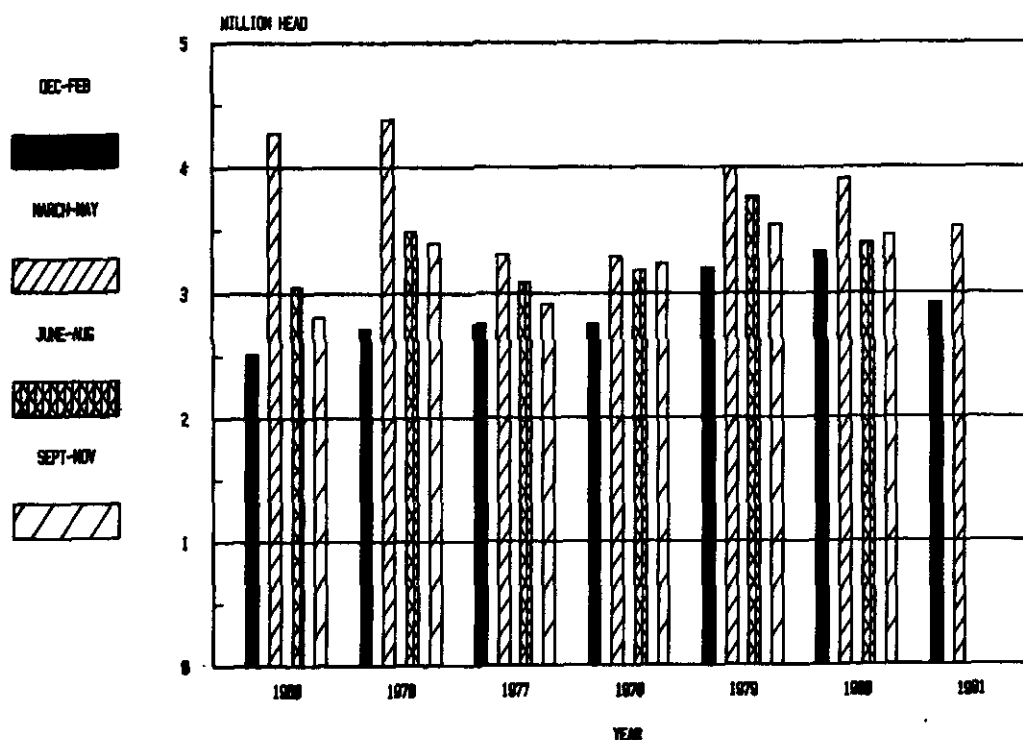
