INVENTORY DOWN 9 PERCENT: U.S. inventory of all hogs and pigs is estimated at 58.7 million head on December 1, 1981, according to the Crop Reporting Board. This is 9 percent below a year ago and 13 percent less than December 1, 1979.

--Breeding hog inventory at 7.84 million is 14 percent below last year and down 19 percent from two years ago.

--Market hog inventory at 50.8 million is 8 percent below a year earlier and 12 percent less than two years ago.

The 14 QUARTERLY STATES, with 50.8 million head on December 1, are down 7 percent from a year earlier and 11 percent less than December 1, 1979. These 14 States account for approximately 87 percent of the total U.S. hog and pig inventory.

1981 PIG CROP: The U.S. pig crop for 1981 totaled 93.8 million head, 8 percent below 1980 and 9 percent below the 1979 pig crop.

--December 1980 - May 1981 pig crop, estimated at 47.6 million head, is down 9 percent from a year earlier period and 6 percent below the comparable period two years ago.

--June-November 1981 pig crop, estimated at 46.2 million head, is 6 percent fewer than a year ago and 11 percent below the June-November 1979 crop.

A total of 6.26 million sows farrowed during June-November 1981, 8 percent fewer than a year earlier. The litter size during this period averaged 7.38 compared with 7.21 a year earlier.

In the 14 QUARTERLY STATES, The June-August 1981 pig crop totaled 20.2 million head, 1 percent below the same quarter a year ago. For the September-November period, the pig crop of 19.8 million head decreased 7 percent from the same period during 1980.

FARROWING INTENTIONS: U.S. hog producers intend to have 5.76 million sows farrowed during the December 1981 - May 1982 period, 11 percent below a year ago and 20 percent fewer than two years ago.

Intentions in the 14 QUARTERLY STATES totaled 2.28 million sows to farrow during December 1981 - February 1982 period, 6 percent fewer than the same period last year. The March - May 1982 intentions, at 2.73 million, are 11 percent below the March - May 1981 quarter.

RELIABILITY AND ESTIMATING PROCEDURES: Primary data used in setting these hog estimates were obtained from a sample of farmers across the U.S. using probability surveys. Information was collected by mail, telephone and personal interviews. Since all operations raising hogs were not included in the sample, survey estimates are subject to sampling variability. This variability, as measured by the relative standard error, is about two percent at the U.S. level for hog inventory. This means that chances are approximately 95 out of 100 that survey estimates will be within four percent of the complete coverage value if the same procedures were used to survey all producers. Survey estimates are also subject to non-sampling errors such as omissions, duplications, and mistakes in reporting, recording and processing the data. These errors cannot be measured directly, but they are minimized through rigid quality controls in the data collection process and a careful review of all reported data for consistency and reasonableness.

The sampling variability of survey estimates on intended farrowings is slightly larger than that for inventories. More important, actual farrowings may differ significantly from reported intentions due to unexpected economic and environmental conditions. For second intentions these differences have exceeded four percent for about one-third of the quarterly pig crops during the last eight years. For first intentions these differences have exceeded seven percent for about one-third of the quarterly pig crops during the past eight years.

In setting the inventory estimates, the Crop Reporting Board constructed a U.S. balance sheet using estimates on births, deaths and check data on slaughter, imports and exports. This balance sheet provided an additional check on survey inventory estimates.

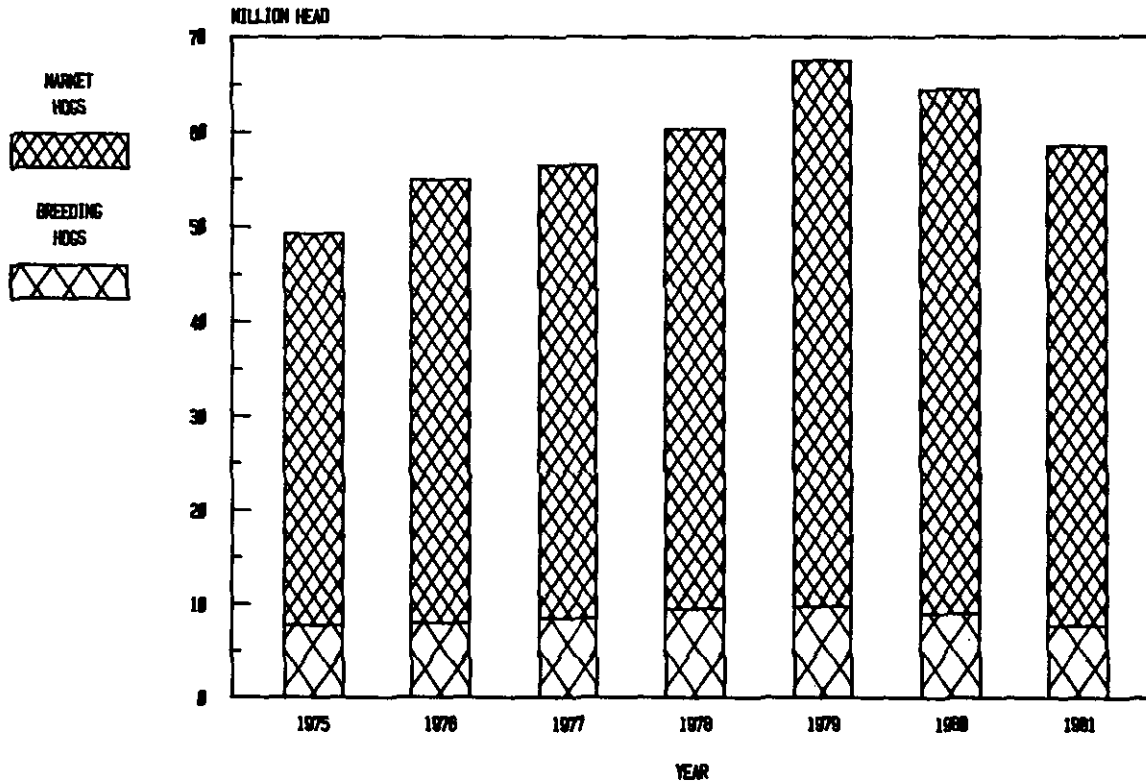

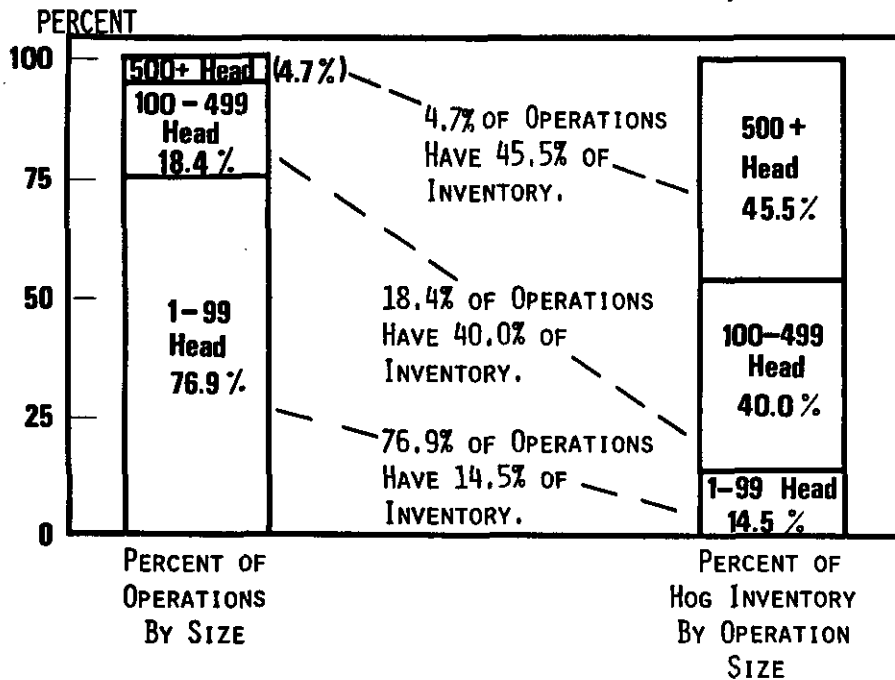

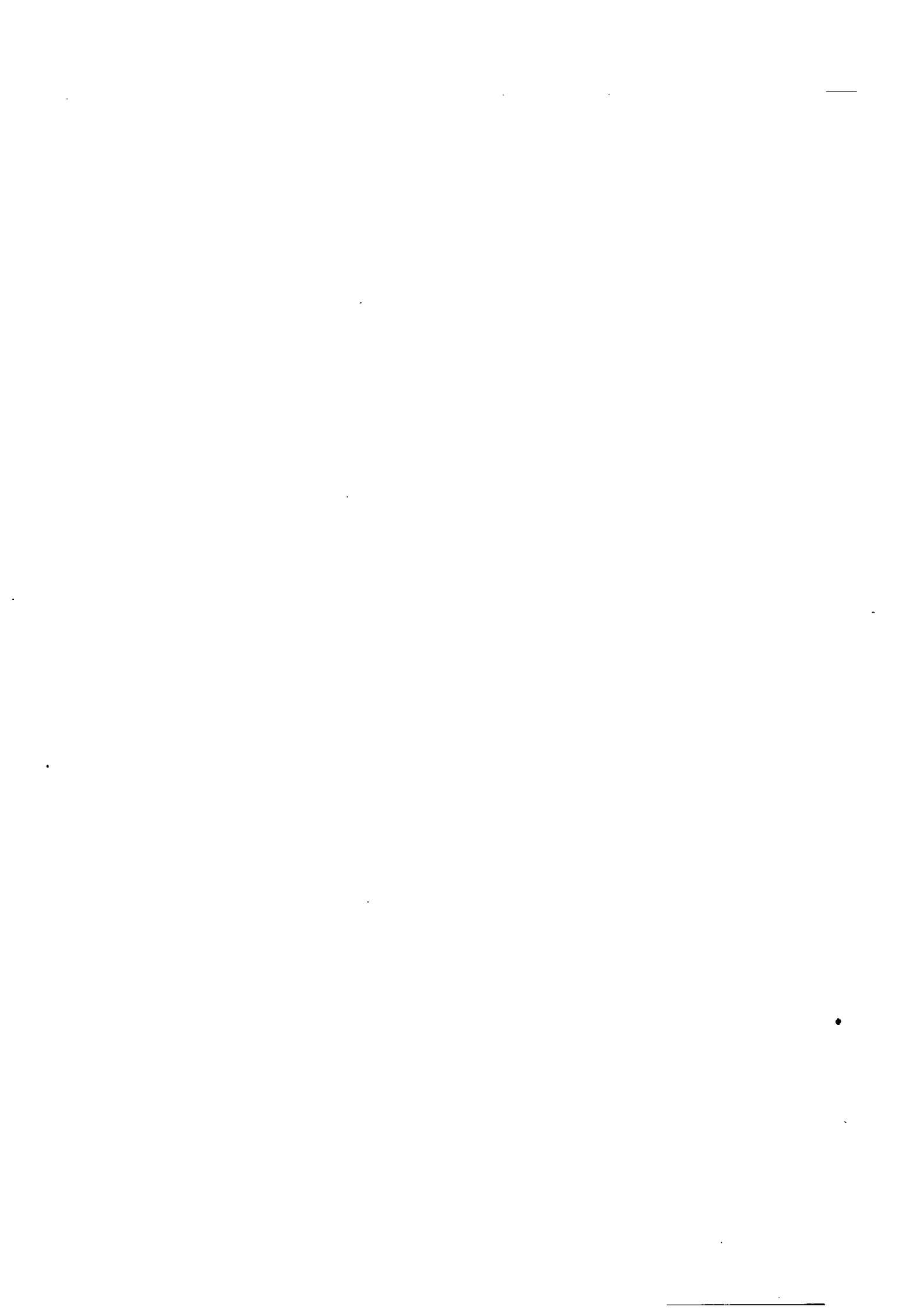
