INVENTORY DOWN 13 PERCENT: Inventory of all hogs and pigs in the U.S. is estimated at 52.0 million head on June 1, 1982, according to the Crop Reporting Board. This is 13 percent below a year ago and 20 percent below 1980. Total hogs and pigs in the U.S. are the lowest on June 1 since 1975.

-- Breeding inventory, at 7.39 million head, was 12 percent less than a year ago, and 22 percent below two years earlier.

-- Market hog inventory, at 44.6 million head, was 13 percent less than a year ago, and 20 percent less than in 1980.

Estimates for the 10 Quarterly States account for about 79 percent of the U.S. total inventory. These States, with 41.2 million head, were down 11 percent from last year and 16 percent below 1980.

PIG CROP: The December 1981-May 1982 U.S. pig crop was 41.0 million head, a 14 percent decrease from last year and 22 percent below two years ago.

Sows farrowing during this 6-month period at 5.58 million were 13 percent fewer than last year. Pigs saved per litter at 7.34 was below last year's rate of 7.39 but above the 1980 rate of 7.23.

In the 10 Quarterly States, the December-May pig crop was 32.0 million head, 13 percent below last year. The December-February pig crop, at 14.1 million head, was 11 percent below last year. The March-May total, at 17.9 million head, was down 13 percent from a year earlier.

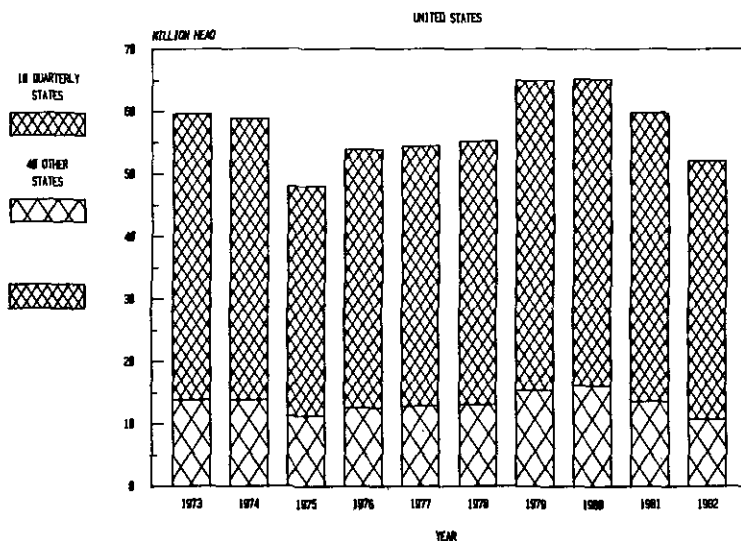
FARROWING INTENTIONS: U.S. producers intend to have 5.64 million sows farrow during the June-November period, a decrease of 10 percent from the same period in 1981 and 17 percent fewer than in 1980.

Intentions in the 10 Quarterly States for June-August are 2.24 million sows, down 9 percent from the corresponding period in 1981. September-November quarter farrowing intentions, at 2.20 million sows, are down 9 percent from the comparable quarter in 1981.

This is the first Hogs and Pigs report reducing coverage of individual State estimates from 23 to 10 States in June, and from 14 to 10 States in March and September. The December report will continue to include estimates for each of the 50 States.

RELIABILITY AND ESTIMATING PROCEDURES: Primary data used in setting these hog estimates were obtained from a sample of farmers across the U.S. using probability surveys. Information was collected by mail, telephone and personal interviews. Since all operations raising hogs were not included in the sample, survey estimates are subject to sampling variability. This variability, as measured by the relative standard error, is about two percent at the U.S. level for hog inventory. This means that chances are approximately 95 out of 100 that survey estimates will be within four percent of the complete coverage value if the same procedures were used to survey all producers. Survey estimates are also subject to non-sampling errors such as omissions, duplications, and mistakes in reporting, recording and processing the data. These errors cannot be measured directly, but they are minimized through rigid quality controls in the data collection process and a careful review of all reported data for consistency and reasonableness.

The sampling variability of survey estimates on intended farrowings is slightly larger than that for inventories. More important, actual farrowings may differ significantly from reported intentions due to unexpected economic and environmental conditions. For second intentions these differences have exceeded four percent for about one-third of the quarterly pig crops during the last eight years. For first intentions these differences have exceeded seven percent for about one-third of the quarterly pig crops during the past eight years.

In setting the inventory estimates, the Crop Reporting Board constructed a U.S. balance sheet using estimates on births, deaths and check data on slaughter, imports and exports. This balance sheet provided an additional check on survey inventory estimates.

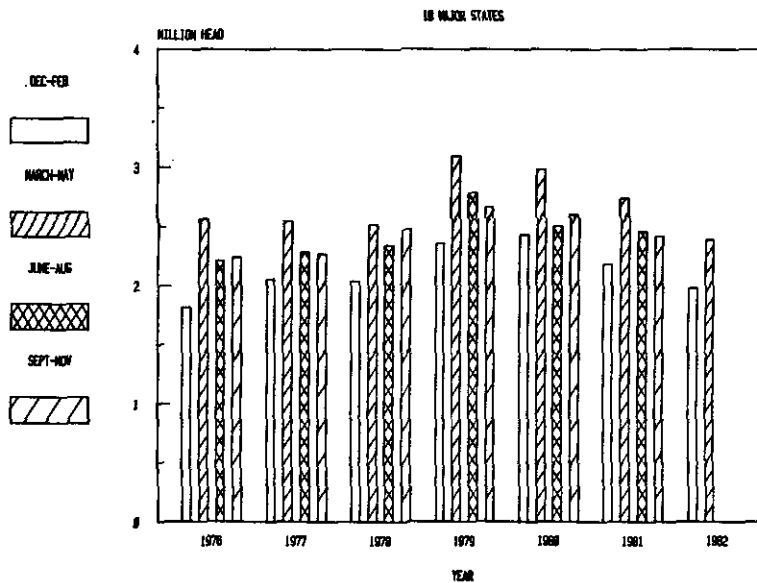

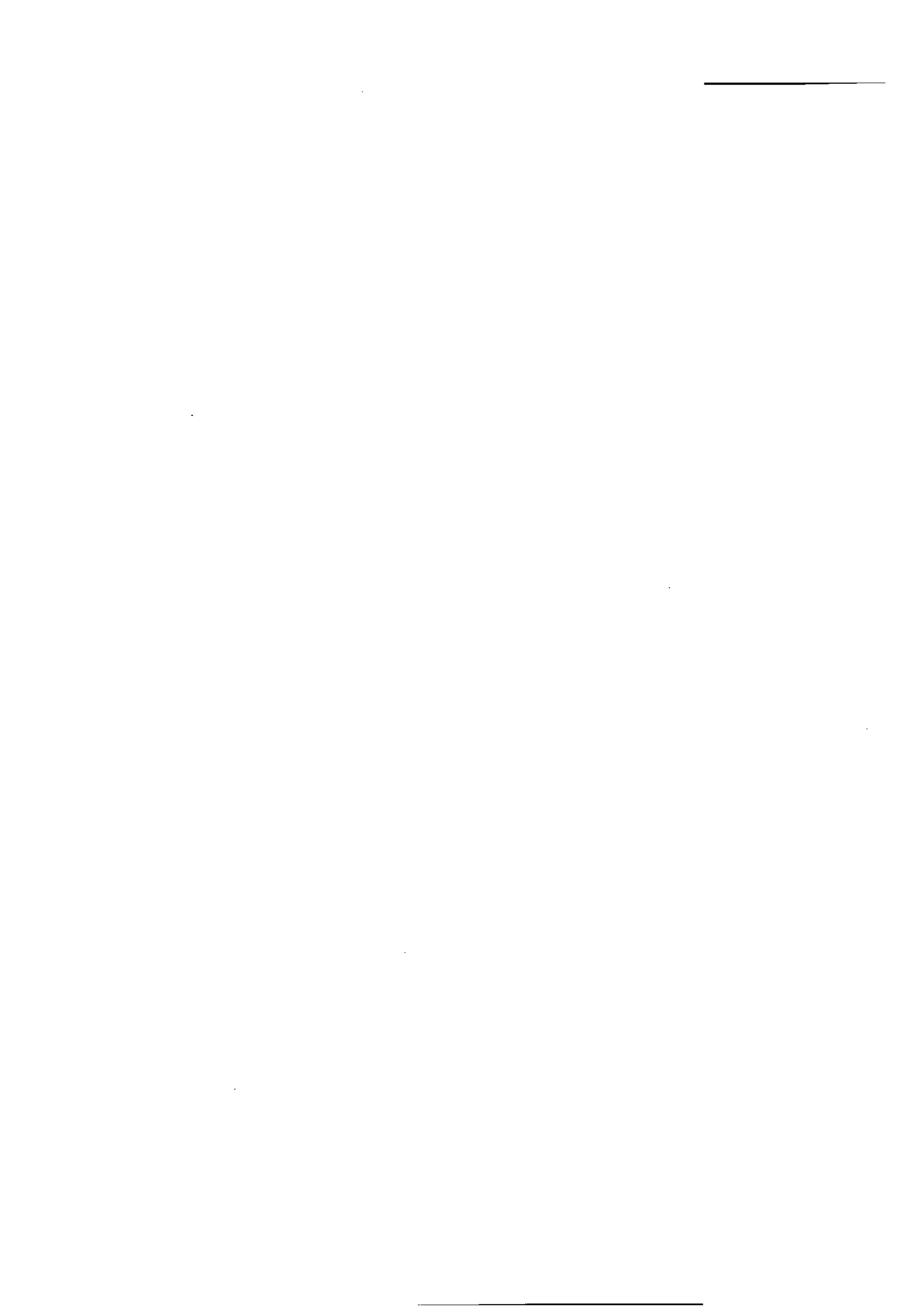

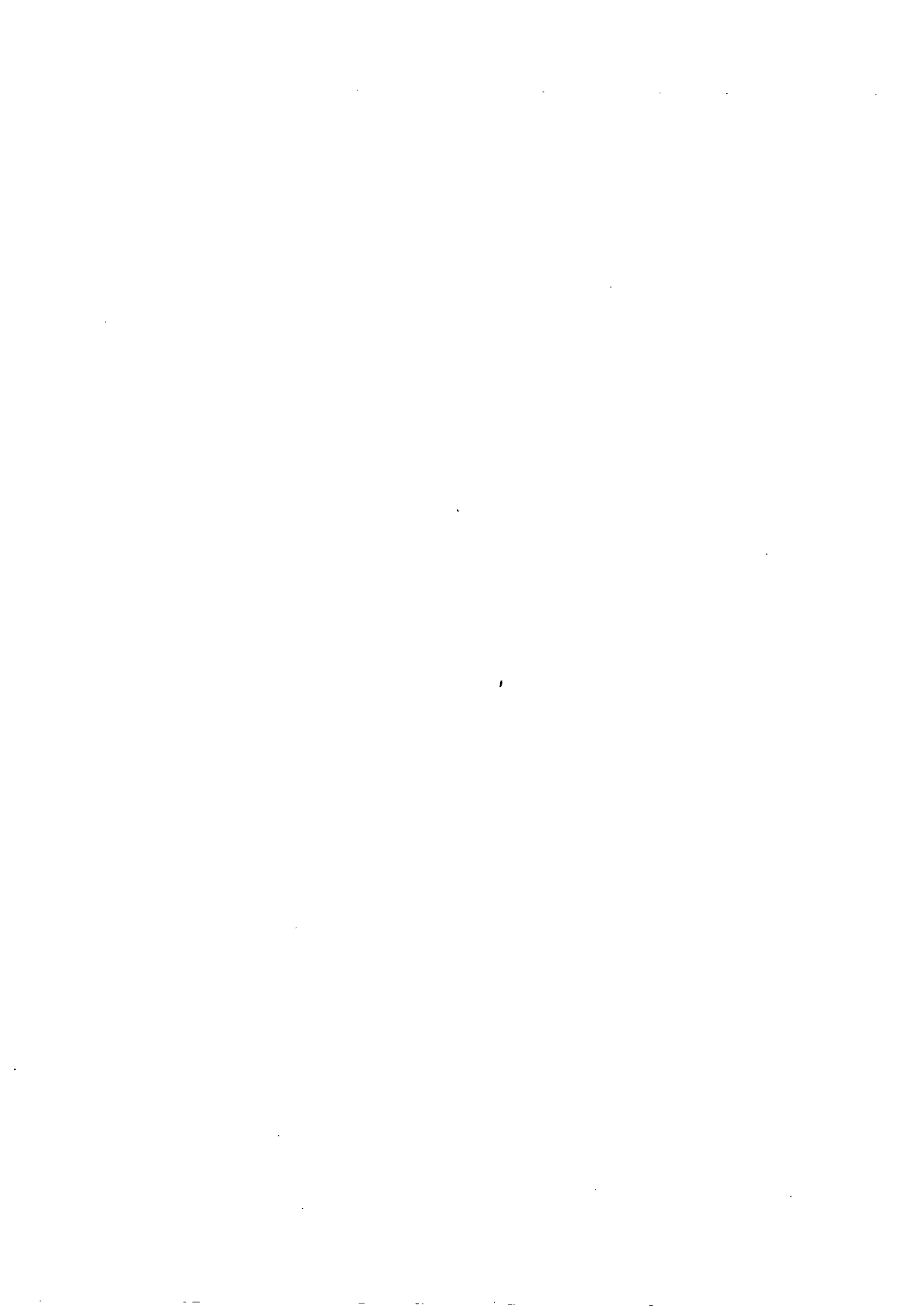
