

1984 PIG CROP: The U.S. pig crop for 1984 totaled 86.5 million head, 7 percent below 1983 but 2 percent above the 1982 pig crop.

- December 1983-May 1984 pig crop, estimated at 42.3 million head, is down 11 percent from a year earlier but 2 percent above the comparable period 2 years ago.
- June-November 1984 pig crop, estimated at 44.2 million head, is 3 percent below a year ago, but 1 percent above the June-November 1982 crop.

A total of 5.86 million sows farrowed during June-November 1984, 5 percent below a year earlier. The litter size during this period averaged a record 7.54, up from the 7.41 a year earlier.

In the 10 QUARTERLY STATES, the June-August 1984 pig crop totaled 17.2 million head, 4 percent below the same quarter a year ago. For the September-November period, the pig crop of 17.4 million head is 1 percent below the same period in 1983.

FARROWING INTENTIONS: U.S. hog producers intend to have 5.39 million sows farrow during the December 1984-May 1985 period, 5 percent below a year ago.

Intentions in the 10 QUARTERLY STATES totaled 1.94 million sows to farrow during December 1984-February 1985, 1 percent less than the same period last year. The March-May 1985 intentions, at 2.35 million, are 5 percent below the March-May 1984 quarter.

RELIABILITY AND ESTIMATING PROCEDURES: Primary data used in setting these hog estimates were obtained from a sample of farmers across the U.S. using probability surveys. Information was collected by mail, telephone and personal interviews. Since all operations raising hogs were not included in the sample, survey estimates are subject to sampling variability. This variability, as measured by the relative standard error, is about two percent at the U.S. level for hog inventory. This means that chances are approximately 95 out of 100 that survey estimates will be within four percent of the complete coverage value if the same procedures were used to survey all producers. Survey estimates are also subject to non-sampling errors such as omissions, duplications, and mistakes in reporting, recording and processing the data. These errors cannot be measured directly, but they are minimized through rigid quality controls in the data collection process and a careful review of all reported data for consistency and reasonableness.

The sampling variability of survey estimates on intended farrowings is slightly larger than that for inventories. More important, actual farrowings may differ significantly from reported intentions due to changes in economic and environmental conditions. For second intentions these differences have exceeded four percent for about one-third of the quarterly pig crops during the last ten years. For first intentions these differences have exceeded seven percent for about one-fourth of the quarterly pig crops during the past 10 years.

In setting the inventory estimates, the Crop Reporting Board constructed a U.S. balance sheet using estimates on births, deaths and check data on slaughter, imports and exports. This balance sheet provided an additional check on survey inventory estimates.

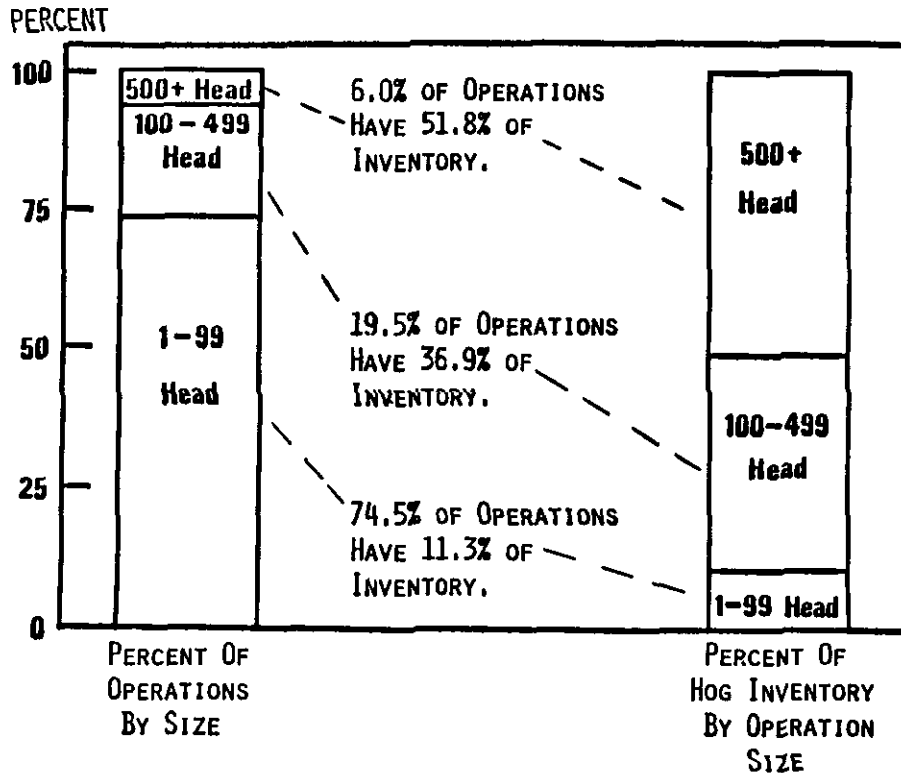
