INVENTORY DOWN 1 PERCENT: Inventory of all hogs and pigs in the U.S. on June 1, 1985 is estimated at 52.1 million head, according to the Crop Reporting Board. This is 1 percent below a year ago and 10 percent below June 1, 1983.

-- Breeding inventory, at 7.00 million head, is 5 percent below a year ago and 14 percent below two years ago. This is the smallest June 1 breeding inventory since June 1 U.S. inventory estimates were first established in 1964.

-- Market hog inventory, at 45.1 million head, is 1 percent below a year ago and 10 percent below two years ago.

The 10 Quarterly States, with 41.5 million head on June 1, 1985, are down 1 percent from a year ago and down 9 percent from June 1, 1983. These 10 States account for almost 80 percent of the total U.S. hog and pig inventory.

PIG CROP: The December 1984-May 1985 U.S. pig crop was 42.5 million head, a slight increase from the corresponding period last year but down 10 percent from the comparable period two years ago.

Sows farrowing during this 6-month period, at 5.57 million, were 2 percent less than during the same period last year and 12 percent less than two years ago. Pigs saved per litter was a record high 7.64 compared with 7.44 last year and the previous record high of 7.52 two years ago.

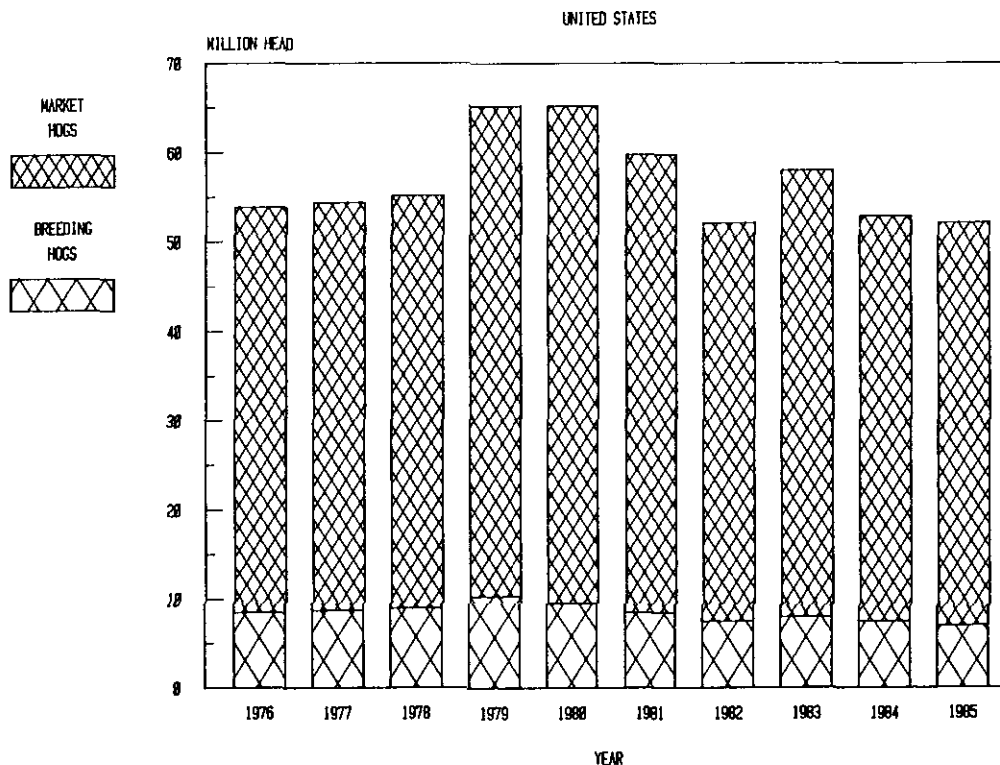
In the 10 Quarterly States, the December-May pig crop was 33.3 million head, 1 percent above last year but 11 percent below two years ago. The December 1984-February 1985 pig crop, at 14.5 million head, was 2 percent above last year but 9 percent below two years ago. The March-May pig crop of 18.8 million head was down slightly from a year ago and down 11 percent from two years ago.

FARROWING INTENTIONS: U.S. hog producers intend to have 5.61 million sows farrow during the June-November period, a decrease of 4 percent from the same period in 1984 and 9 percent below 1983.

Intentions in the 10 Quarterly States for June-November are 4.38 million head, down 4 percent from the corresponding period last year and down 9 percent from two years ago. June-August intended farrowings, at 2.15 million sows, are down 5 percent from the comparable quarter in 1984, while September-November intended farrowings, at 2.23 million sows, are down 4 percent from last year.

RELIABILITY AND ESTIMATING PROCEDURES: Primary data used in setting these hog estimates were obtained from a sample of farmers across the U.S. using probability surveys. Information was collected by mail, telephone, and personal interviews. Since all operations raising hogs were not included in the sample, survey estimates are subject to sampling variability. This variability, as measured by the relative standard error, is about two percent at the U.S. level for hog inventory. This means that chances are approximately 95 out of 100 that survey estimates will be within four percent of the complete coverage value if the same procedures were used to survey all producers. Survey estimates are also subject to non-sampling errors such as omissions, duplications, and mistakes in reporting, recording and processing the data. These errors cannot be measured directly, but they are minimized through rigid quality controls in the data collection process and a careful review of all reported data for consistency and reasonableness.

The sampling variability of survey estimates on intended farrowings is slightly larger than that for inventories. More important, actual farrowings may differ significantly from reported intentions due to unexpected economic and environmental conditions. For June-August second intentions in the 10 quarterly States, these differences have exceeded three percent in three of the last ten years. For September-November first intentions in the 10 quarterly States as of June 1, these differences have exceeded six percent in four of the last ten years.

In setting the inventory estimates, the Crop Reporting Board constructed a U.S. balance sheet using estimates on births, deaths and check data on slaughter, imports, and exports. This balance sheet provided an additional check on survey inventory estimates.

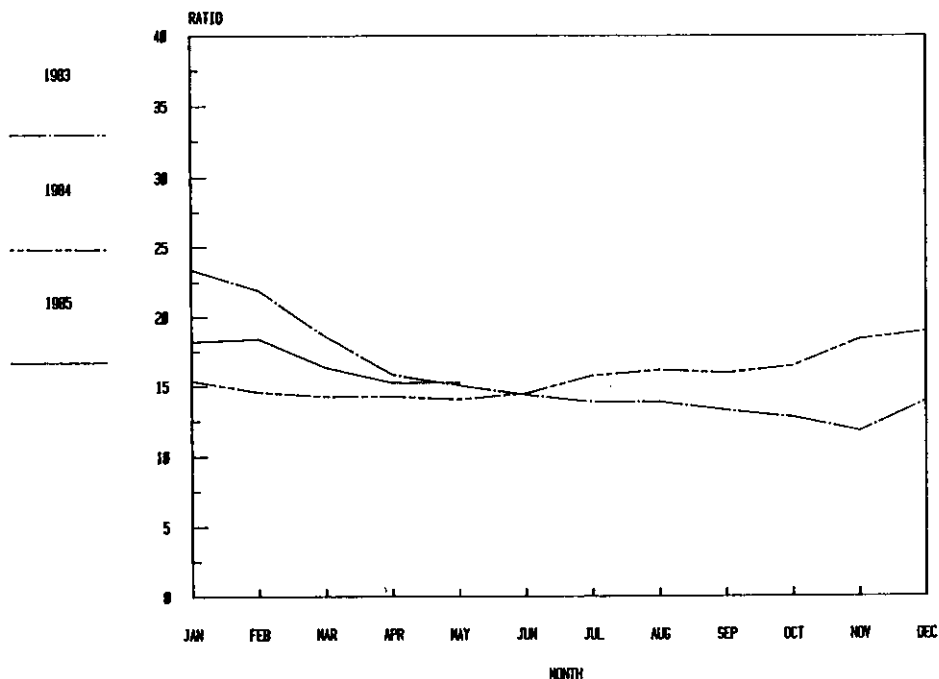
