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Inventory of all hogs and pigs in the U.S. on June 1, 1988 is estimated at 56.2 million head, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. This is 8 percent above a year ago and 15 percent above June 1, 1986. This is the highest June 1 inventory since 1983.

-- Breeding inventory, at 7.53 million head, is 7 percent above last year and 17 percent above two years ago.

-- Market hog inventory, at 48.7 million head, is 8 percent above a year ago and 15 percent above two years ago.

The 10 Quarterly States, with 44.0 million head on June 1, 1988, are up 8 percent from last year and up 16 percent from two years ago.

PIG CROP

The December 1987-May 1988 U.S. pig crop was 46.6 million head, 8 percent above last year and 15 percent above two years ago.

Sows farrowing during this 6 month period, at 6.0 million, were 8 percent more than the previous year and 14 percent above two years ago. Pigs saved per litter was 7.77 compared with 7.79 record litter rate last year and 7.70 two years ago.

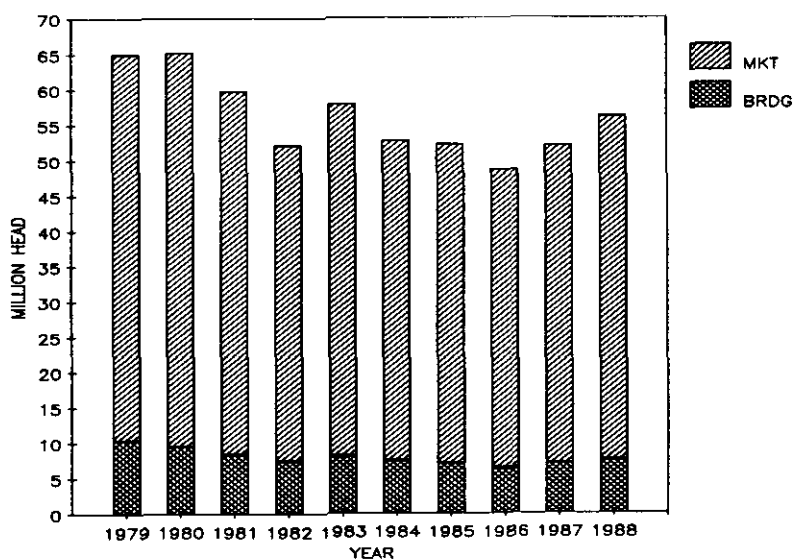
In the 10 Quarterly States, the December-May pig crop was 36.3 million head, 9 percent above last year and 16 percent above two years ago. The December 1987-February 1988 pig crop, at 16.3 million head, was up 10 percent from a year ago and 15 percent above two years ago. The March-May pig crop of 20.0 million head was 7 percent above last year and 18 percent above two years ago.

FARROWING INTENTIONS

U.S. hog producers intend to farrow 6.20 million sows during the June-November period, an increase of 7 percent from the same period in 1987 and 14 percent above two years ago. These intentions do not reflect conditions after the June 1 survey date.

Intentions in the 10 Quarterly States for June-November are 4.79 million head, up 6 percent from the corresponding period last year and 14 percent above two years ago. June-August intended farrowings, at 2.39 million head, are up 6 percent from the comparable quarter in 1987. The September-November intended farrowings, at 2.40 million head, are also up 6 percent from last year.

RELIABILITY AND ESTIMATING PROCEDURES: Primary data used in setting these hog estimates were obtained from a sample of farmers across the U.S. using probability surveys. These surveys collected information as of June 1 from about 71,000 operators sampled from a list of agricultural producers plus additional data from operators of more than 15,000 small land area tracts. Information was collected during the first half of June by mail, telephone, and personal interviews. Since all operations raising hogs were not included in the sample, survey estimates are subject to sampling variability. This variability, as measured by the relative standard error, is slightly less than one and one-half percent at the U.S. level for hog inventory. This means that chances are approximately 95 out of 100 that survey estimates will be within three percent of the complete coverage value if the same procedures were used to survey all producers. The relative standard errors for the major groupings of market and breeding hogs were 1.5 and 1.6 percent, respectively. The relative standard error for the market hog weight groups ranged from 1.8 to 2.3 percent.

Survey estimates are also subject to non-sampling errors such as omissions, duplications, and mistakes in reporting, recording, and processing the data. These errors cannot be measured directly, but they are minimized through rigid quality controls in the data collection process and a careful review of all reported data for consistency and reasonableness.

The sampling variability of survey estimates on intended farrowings is slightly larger than that for inventories. More important, actual farrowings may differ significantly from reported intentions due to unexpected economic and environmental conditions. For June-August second intentions in the 10 quarterly States, these differences have exceeded two percent in three of the last ten years. For September-November first intentions in the 10 quarterly States as of June 1, these differences have exceeded six percent in four of the last ten years.

In setting the inventory estimates, the Agricultural Statistics Board constructed a U.S. balance sheet using estimates on births, deaths, and check data on slaughter, imports, and exports. This balance sheet provided an additional check on survey inventory estimates.

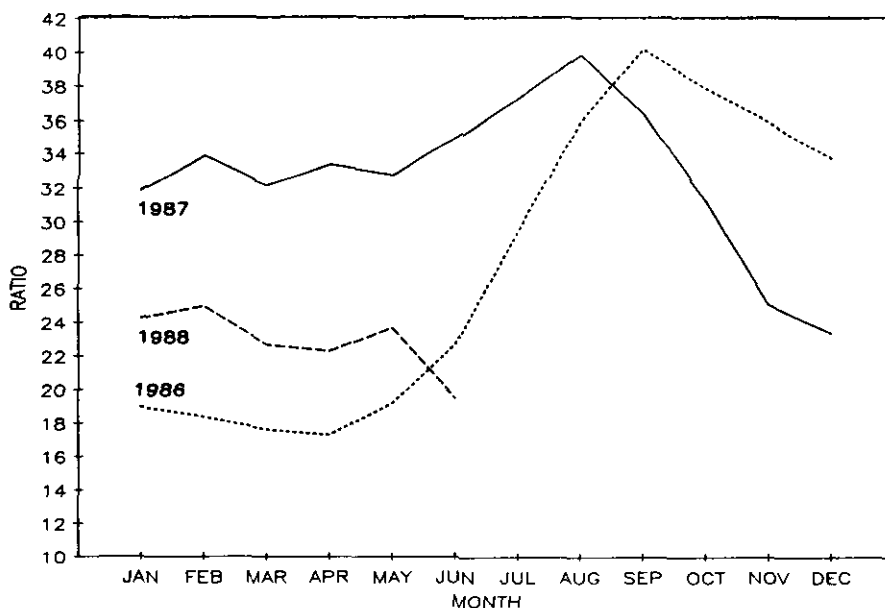
