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INVENTORY UP 1 PERCENT: U.S. inventory of all hogs and pigs was estimated at 55.3 million head on December 1, 1988, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. This was 1 percent above a year ago and 9 percent above December 1, 1986.

- Breeding hog inventory, at 7.04 million, was 2 percent below last year but 6 percent above two years ago.
- Market hog inventory, at 48.3 million, was 2 percent above a year ago and 9 percent above two years ago.

The 10 QUARTERLY STATES, with 43.0 million head on December 1, 1988, were up slightly from a year earlier and up 8 percent from December 1, 1986. These 10 States account for approximately 78 percent of the total U.S. hog and pig inventory.

1988 PIG CROP: The U.S. pig crop for 1988 totaled 92.6 million head, 5 percent above 1987 and 12 percent above the 1986 pig crop.

- December 1987-May 1988 pig crop, estimated at 46.8 million head, was up 8 percent from a year earlier and 16 percent above the comparable period in 1986.
- June-November 1988 pig crop, estimated at 45.7 million head, was 2 percent above last year, and 9 percent above the June-November 1986 pig crop.

A total of 6.00 million sows farrowed during June-November 1988, 3 percent above a year earlier and 11 percent above the June-November 1986 period. The litter size during this period averaged 7.62, compared to the record 7.74 in both 1987 and 1986.

In the 10 QUARTERLY STATES, the June-August 1988 pig crop totaled 18.0 million head, 2 percent above the same quarter a year earlier. For the September-November period, the pig crop of 17.2 million head was 2 percent below the same period in 1987.

FARROWING INTENTIONS: U.S. hog producers intend to have 5.91 million sows farrow during the December 1988-May 1989 period, 2 percent below the actual farrowings during the same period a year ago.

Intentions in the 10 QUARTERLY STATES totaled 2.12 million sows to farrow during December 1988-February 1989. This is unchanged from actual farrowings during the same period a year earlier. The March-May 1989 intentions, at 2.43 million, are 6 percent below the March-May 1988 quarter.

RELIABILITY AND ESTIMATING PROCEDURES: Primary data used in setting these hog estimates were obtained from a sample of farmers across the U.S. using probability surveys. These surveys included information from a list of 76,000 agricultural producers plus additional information from operators of about 9,600 small land area tracts. Information was collected during the first half of December by mail, telephone and personal interviews. Since all operations raising hogs were not included in the sample, survey estimates are subject to sampling variability. This variability, as measured by the relative standard error, is about 1.6 percent at the U.S. level for hog inventory. This means that chances are approximately 95 out of 100 that survey estimates will be within 3.2 percent of the complete coverage value if the same procedures were used to survey all producers. The relative standard errors for the major groupings of breeding and market hogs are 1.8 percent and 1.7 percent, respectively. The relative standard errors for the market hog weight groups range from 1.9 to 2.7 percent.

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Survey estimates are also subject to non-sampling errors such as omissions, duplications, and mistakes in reporting, recording and processing the data. These errors cannot be measured directly, but they are minimized through rigid quality controls in the data collection process and a careful review of all reported data for consistency and reasonableness.

The sampling variability of survey estimates on intended farrowings is slightly larger than that for inventories. More important, actual farrowings may differ significantly from reported intentions due to changes in economic and environmental conditions. For the 10-State December-February second intentions, these differences have exceeded 4 percent in three of the last ten quarterly December-February pig crops. For March-May first intentions, these differences have exceeded 6 percent in four of the last ten quarterly March-May pig crops.

In setting the inventory estimates, the Agricultural Statistics Board constructed a U.S. balance sheet using estimates on births, deaths and check data on slaughter, imports and exports. The balance sheet provided an additional check on survey inventory estimates.

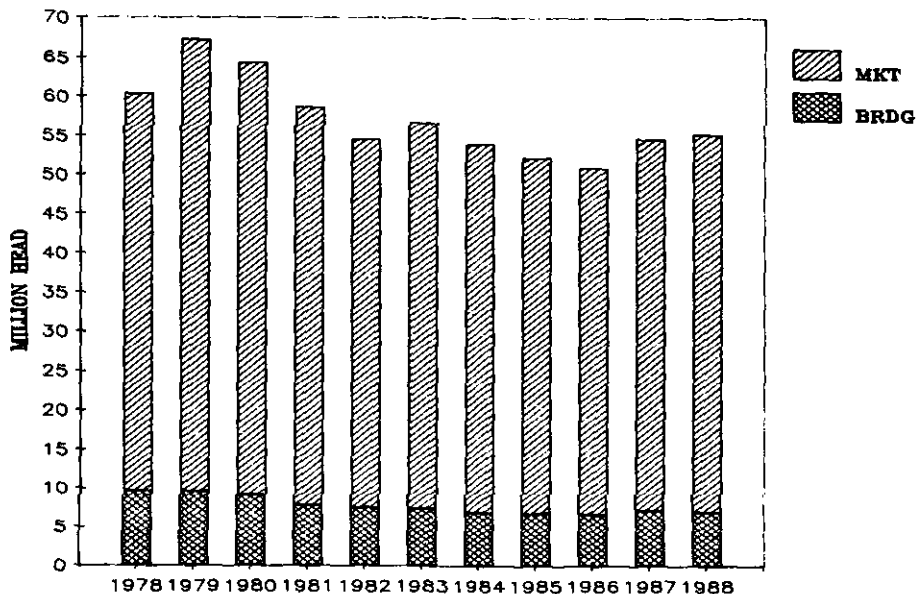

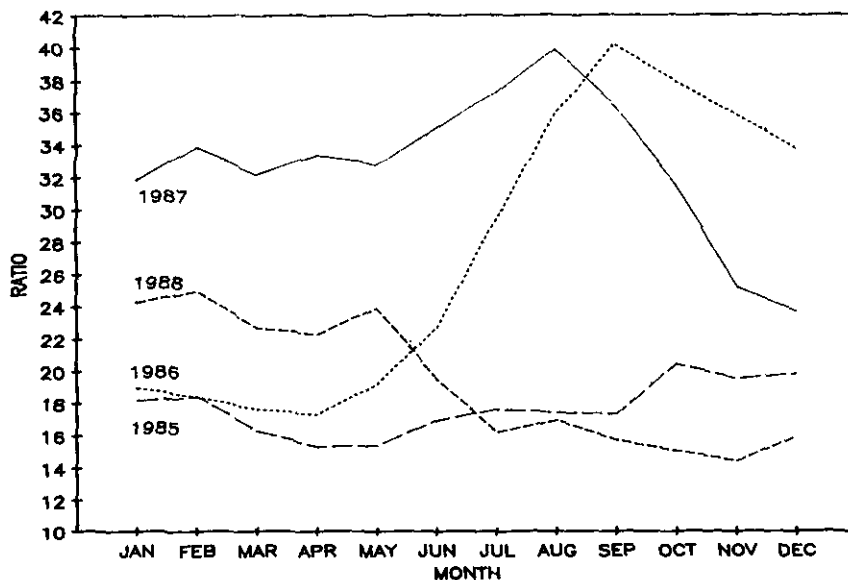
