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INVENTORY of all hogs and pigs in the U.S. on September 1, 1990, is estimated at 56.3 million head, according to the Agricultural Statistics Board. This estimate is 2 percent below September 1, 1989 but 4 percent above the June 1, 1990 inventory which was revised downward by 240 thousand head.

- Breeding inventory at 6.86 million head is down slightly from September 1, 1989, and down 4 percent from June 1, 1990.
- Market hog inventory at 49.4 million head is 3 percent below September 1, 1989, but 5 percent above June 1, 1990.

Inventory of all hogs and pigs on September 1, 1990, in the 10 Quarterly estimating States is estimated at 44.4 million head, down 2 percent from last year and 1 percent below September 1, 1988.

- Breeding inventory, at 5.34 million head, is slightly above a year ago and 2 percent below two years earlier.
- Market hog inventory, at 39.1 million head, is down 2 percent from last year and 1 percent below 1988.

FIG CROP: The June-August 1990 U.S. pig crop was 22.9 million head, 2 percent less than 1989. Sows farrowing during this period totaled 2.91 million head, 3 percent below a year earlier. Pigs saved per litter was 7.88 compared to 7.79 during the same period in 1989.

The 10 State June-August 1990 pig crop was 17.9 million head, down 1 percent from last year virtually unchanged from two years ago. There were 2.27 million sows that farrowed during June-August, down 2 percent from a year earlier and 4 percent less than the same period two years ago.

Sows farrowing during June-August 1990 in the 10 States averaged a record high 7.91 pigs per litter compared with 7.82 last year and 7.63 during the comparable period two years ago.

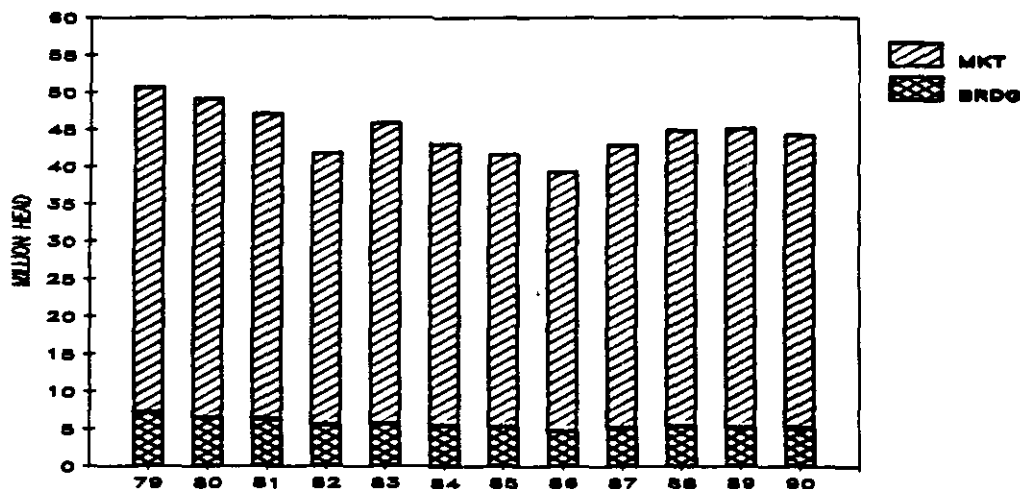
FARROWING INTENTIONS: U.S. hog producers intend to have 2.85 million sows farrow during the September-November quarter, 2 percent more than the actual farrowings during the same period last year but 4 percent below 1988.

U.S. farrowing intentions for the December 1990-February 1991 quarter, at 2.63 million sows, is 2 percent above 1990 but down 3 percent from the 1989 period.

Hog producers in the 10 Quarterly States intend to have 2.25 million sows farrow during September-November of this year. This is up 3 percent from the actual farrowings during the comparable period in 1989, but 2 percent below 1988.

The 10 State farrowing intentions for the December 1990-February 1991 quarter are 2.07 million head, 3 percent above a year earlier, but 2 percent fewer than 1989.

RELIABILITY AND ESTIMATING PROCEDURES: Primary data used in setting these hog estimates were obtained from a sample of producers across the U.S. using probability surveys. These surveys included information from about 46,000 operators sampled from a list of agricultural producers plus additional data from operators of 9,000 small land area tracts. Information was collected during the first half of September by mail, telephone, and personal interviews. Since all operations raising hogs were not included in the sample, survey estimates are subject to sampling variability. This variability, as measured by the relative standard error, is less than one and three-quarters percent at the U.S. level for the all hog inventory. This means that chances are approximately 95 out of 100 that survey estimates will be within three and one-half percent of the value developed by all possible samples selected from the same population and surveyed using the same procedures. The relative standard errors for the major groupings of breeding and market hogs are 2.1 and 1.9 percent, respectively. The relative standard errors for the market hog weight groups range from 1.9 to 2.6 percent.

Survey estimates are also subject to non-sampling errors such as omissions, duplications, and mistakes in reporting, recording, and processing the data. These errors cannot be measured directly, but they are minimized through rigid quality controls in the data collection process and a careful review of all reported data for consistency and reasonableness.

The sampling variability of survey estimates on intended farrowings is slightly larger than that for inventories. More important, actual farrowings may differ significantly from reported intentions due to unexpected economic and environmental conditions. For the 10-State September-November second intentions, these differences have exceeded six percent in two of the last ten years. For December-February first intentions as of September 1, these differences have exceeded eight percent in one of the last ten years.

In setting the inventory estimates, the Agricultural Statistics Board constructed a balance sheet using estimates on births, deaths and check data on slaughter, imports, and exports. This balance sheet provided an additional check on survey inventory estimates.

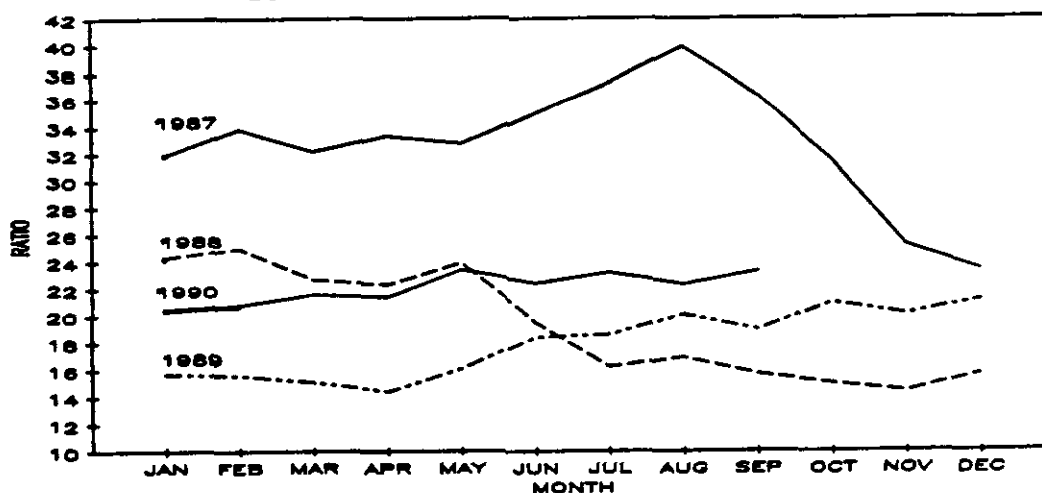

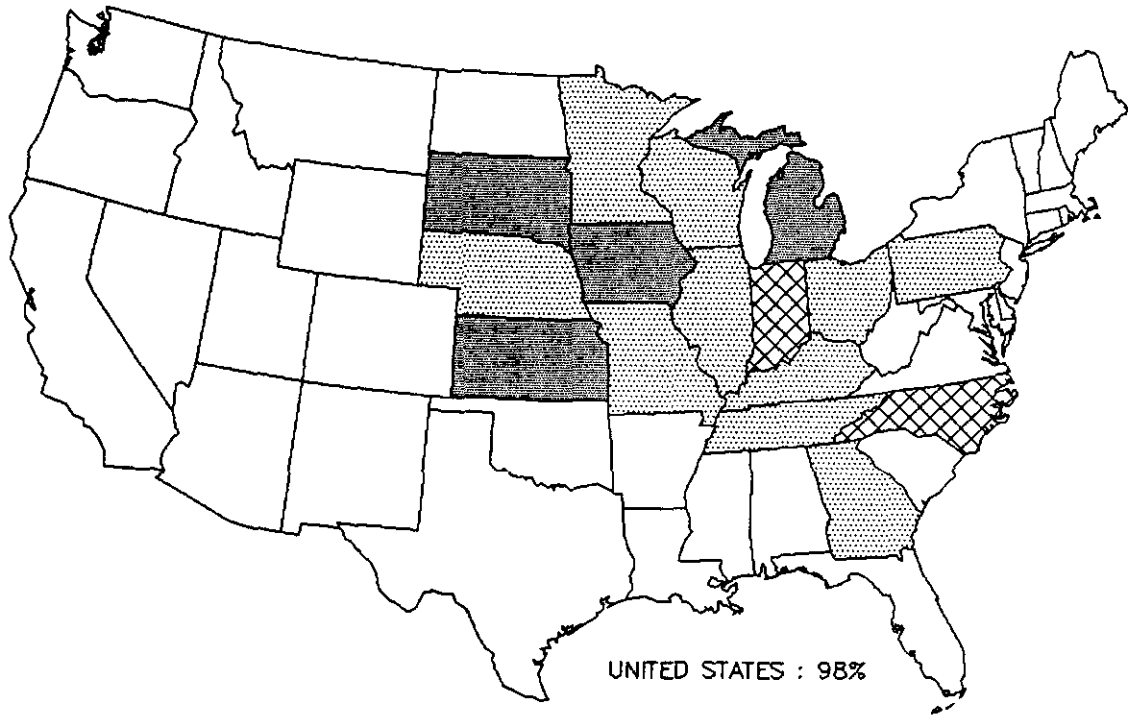

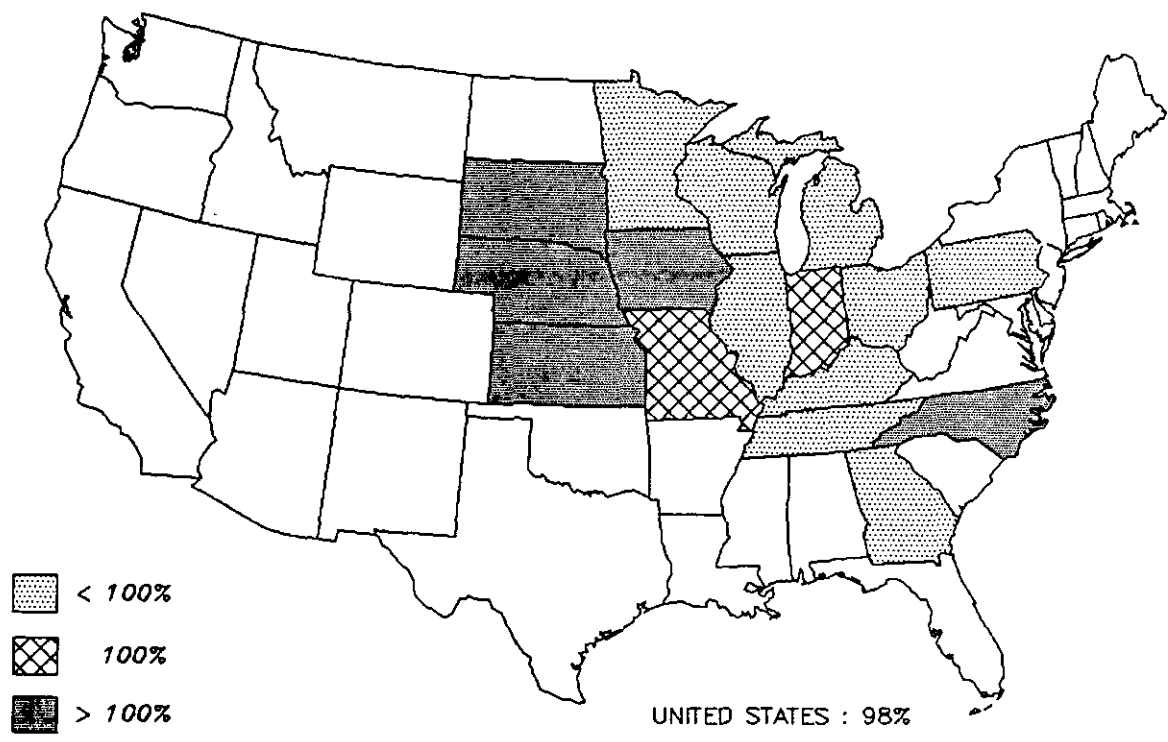
